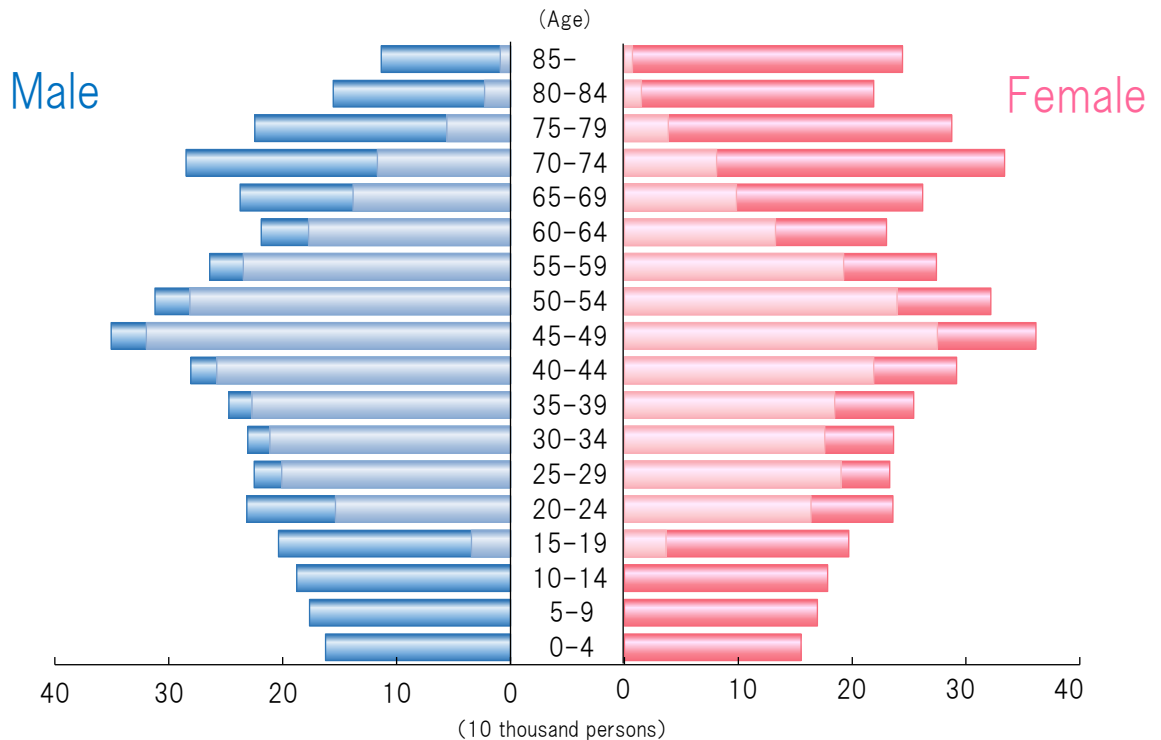
# Notes

3. Unless otherwise indicated, "year" refers to the calendar year, and "fiscal year" refers to the 12 months from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
4. General explanations of tables and the sources of information are given in the headnote.
5. Figures may not add up to the totals because of rounding to the nearest unit.
6. The metric system of weights and measures is used throughout the handbook. Ton refers to metric ton, unless otherwise noted.
7. OPG is an abbreviation of Osaka Prefectural Government.

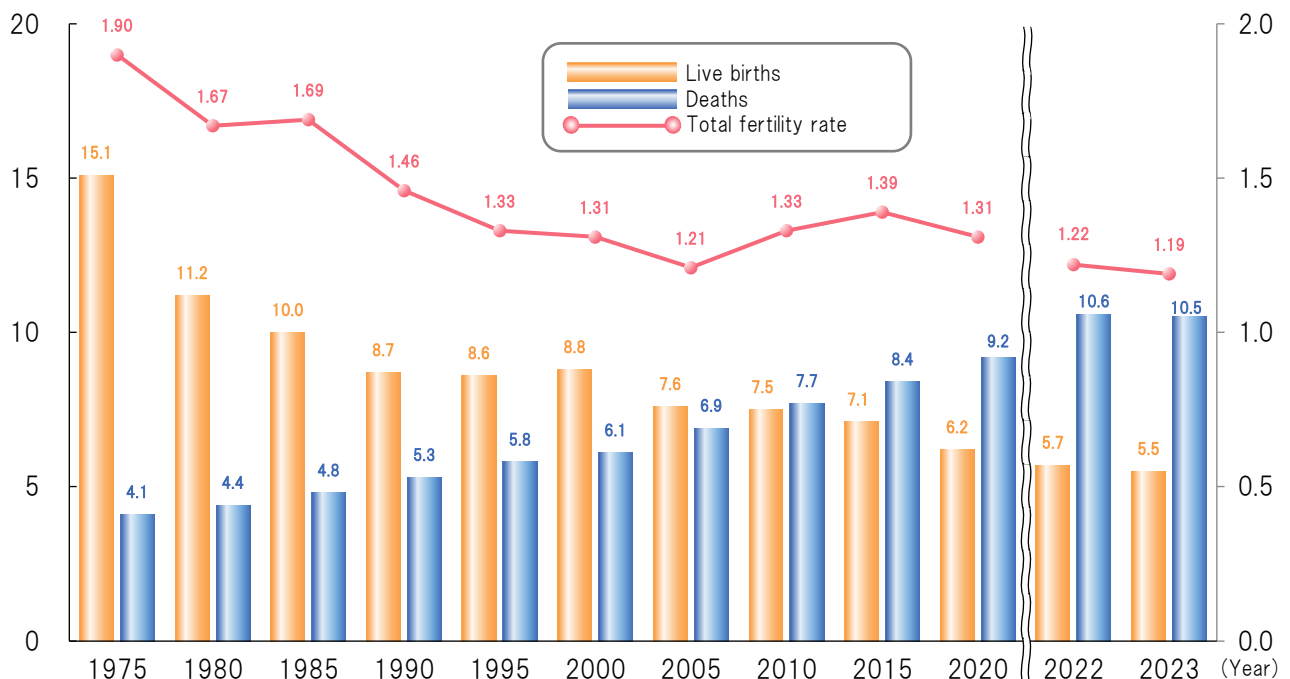

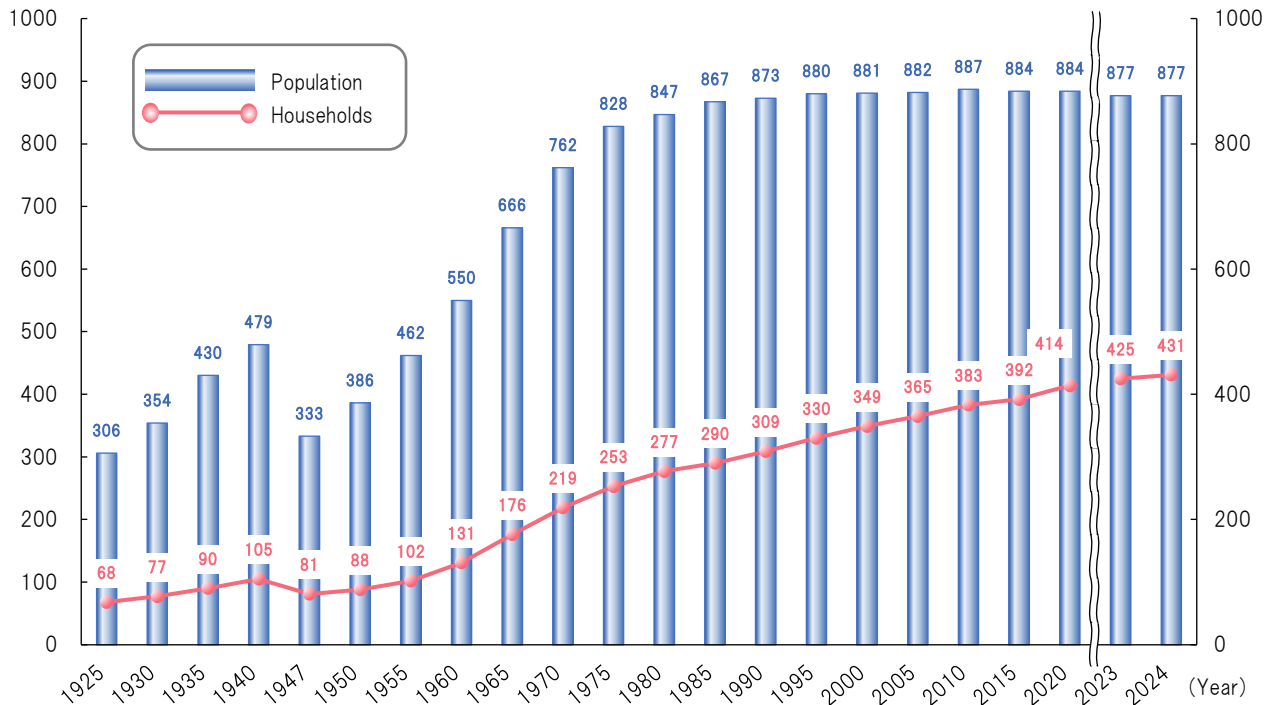

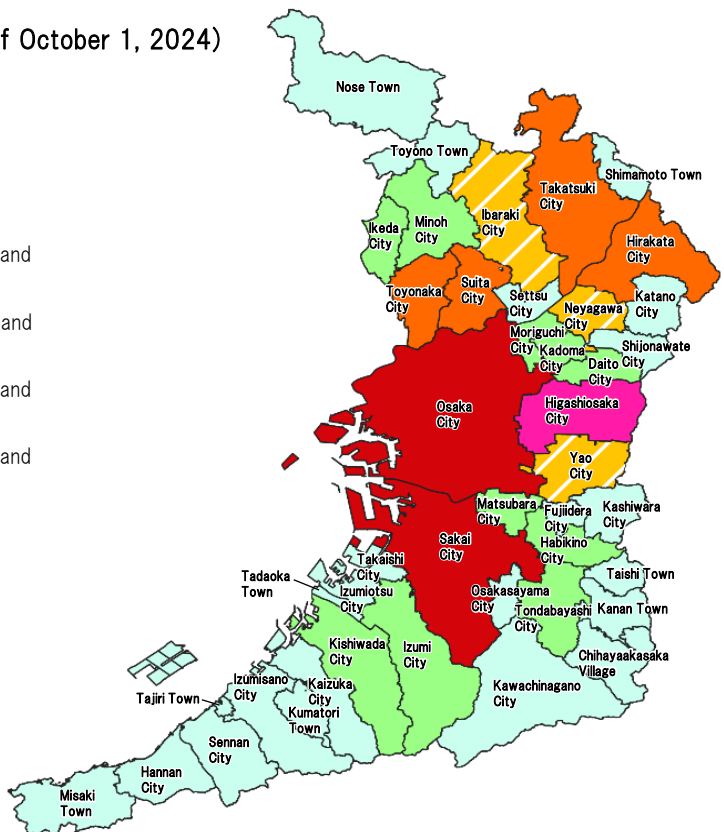
# Regional Population in Osaka (As of October 1, 2024)

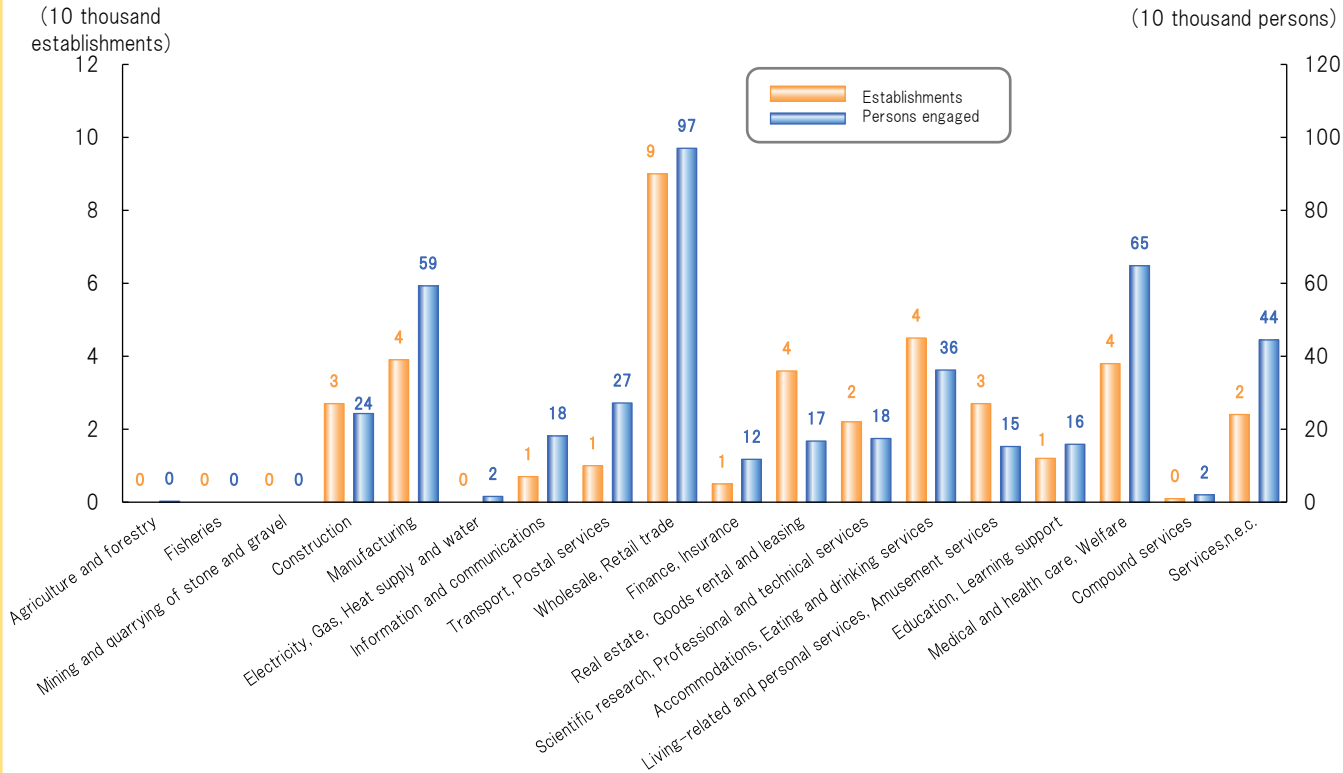

## Privately-Owned Establishments and Persons Engaged by Industry Category (As of June 1, 2021)

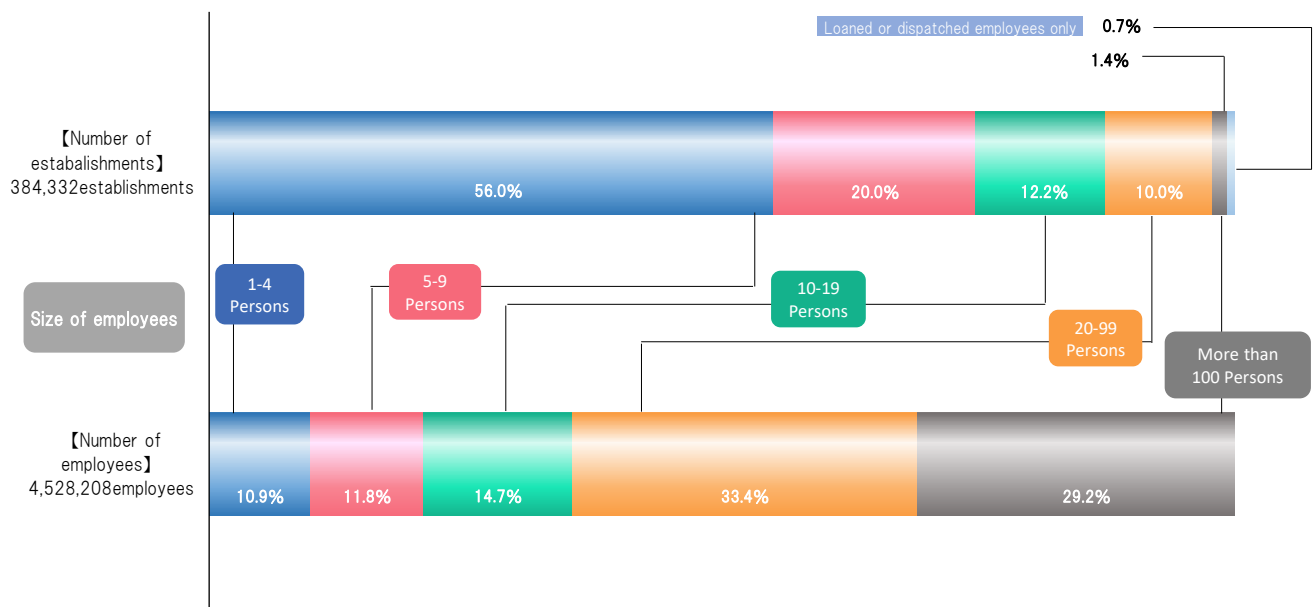

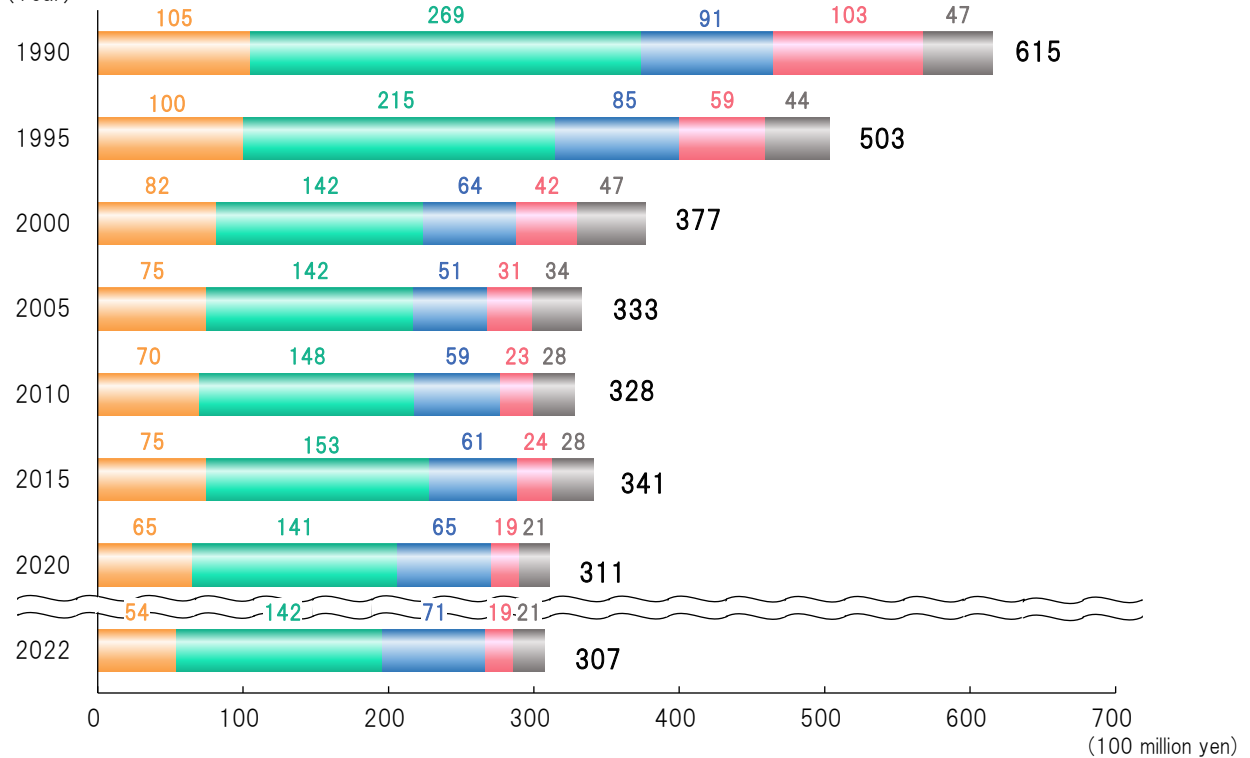

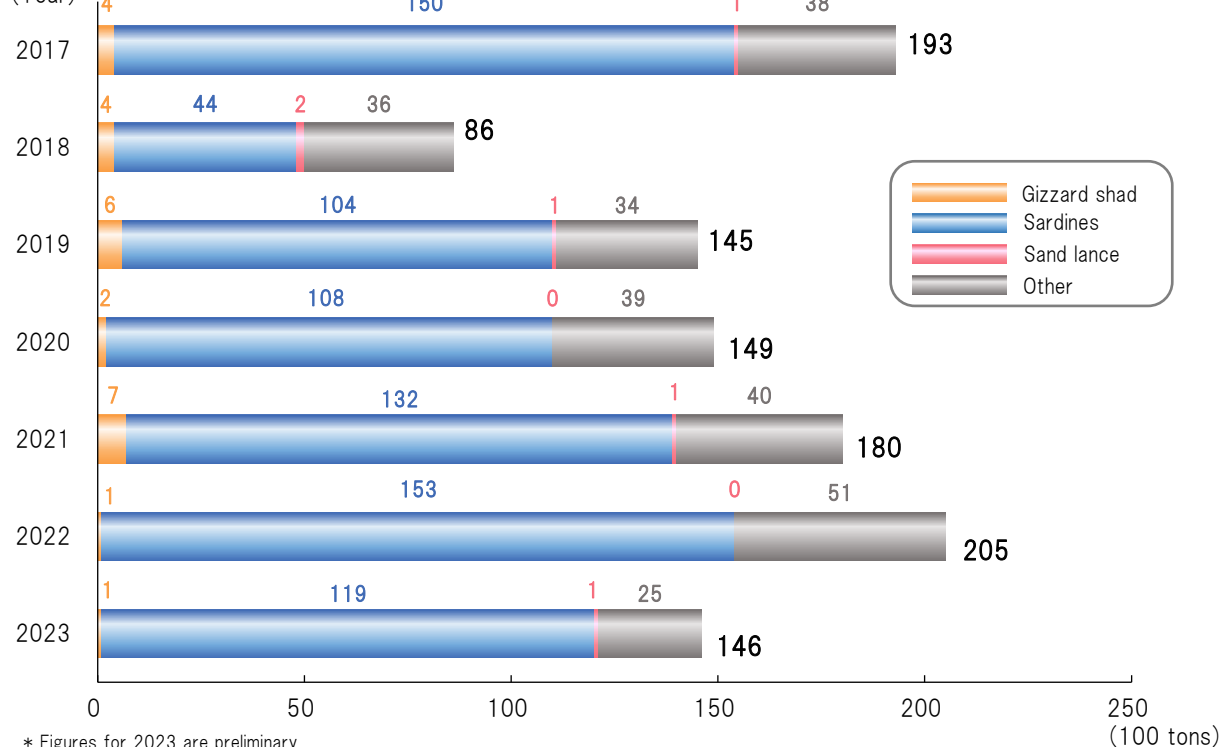

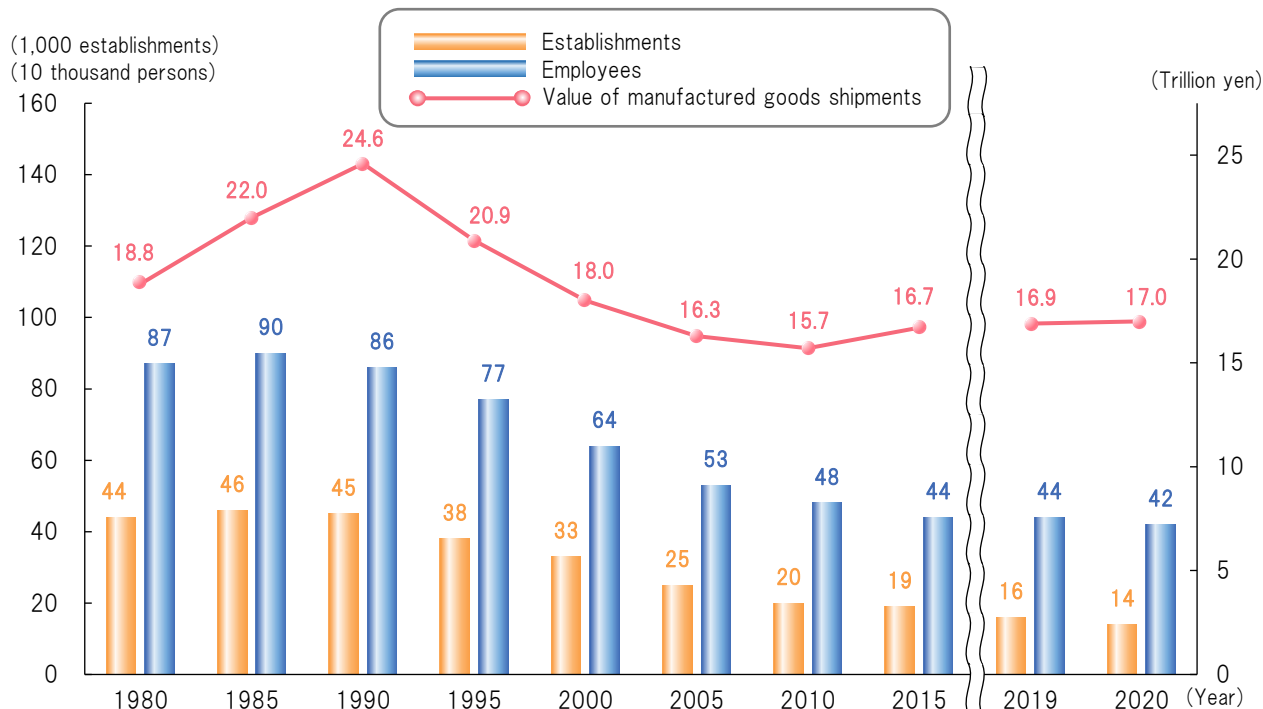

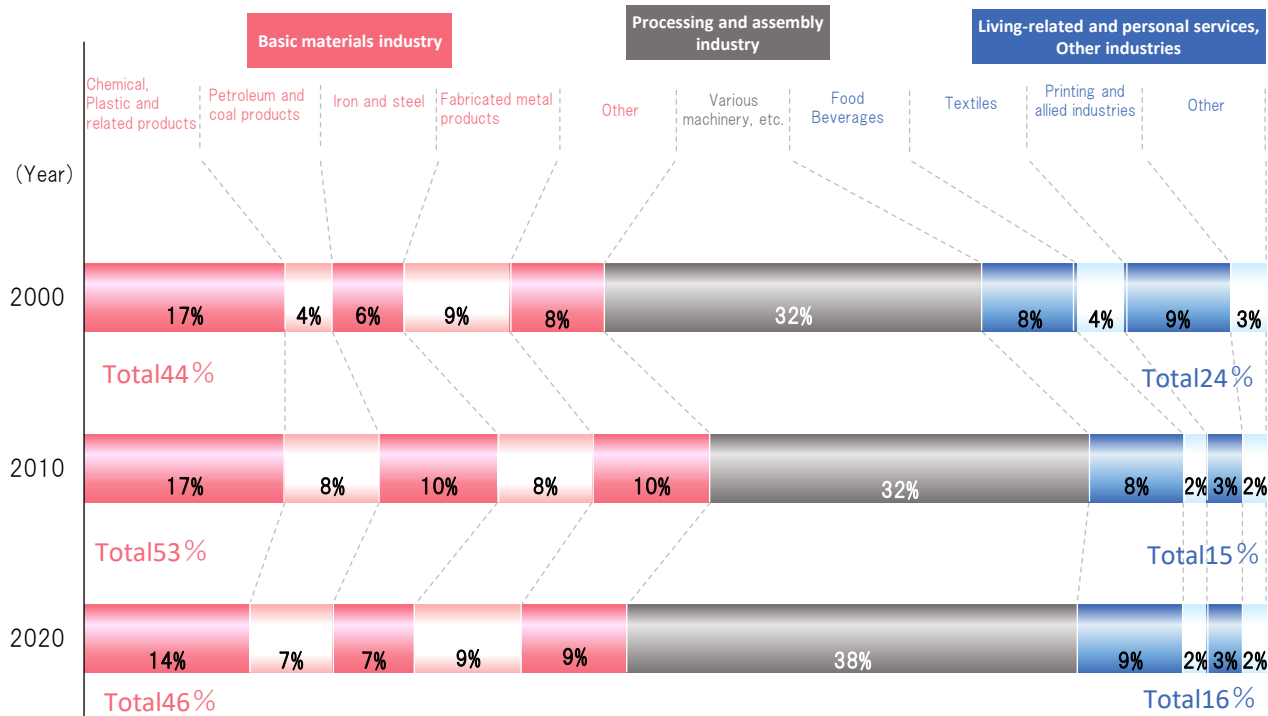

## Composition Ratio of Value of Manufactured Goods Shipments by Industry (Four or More Employees)

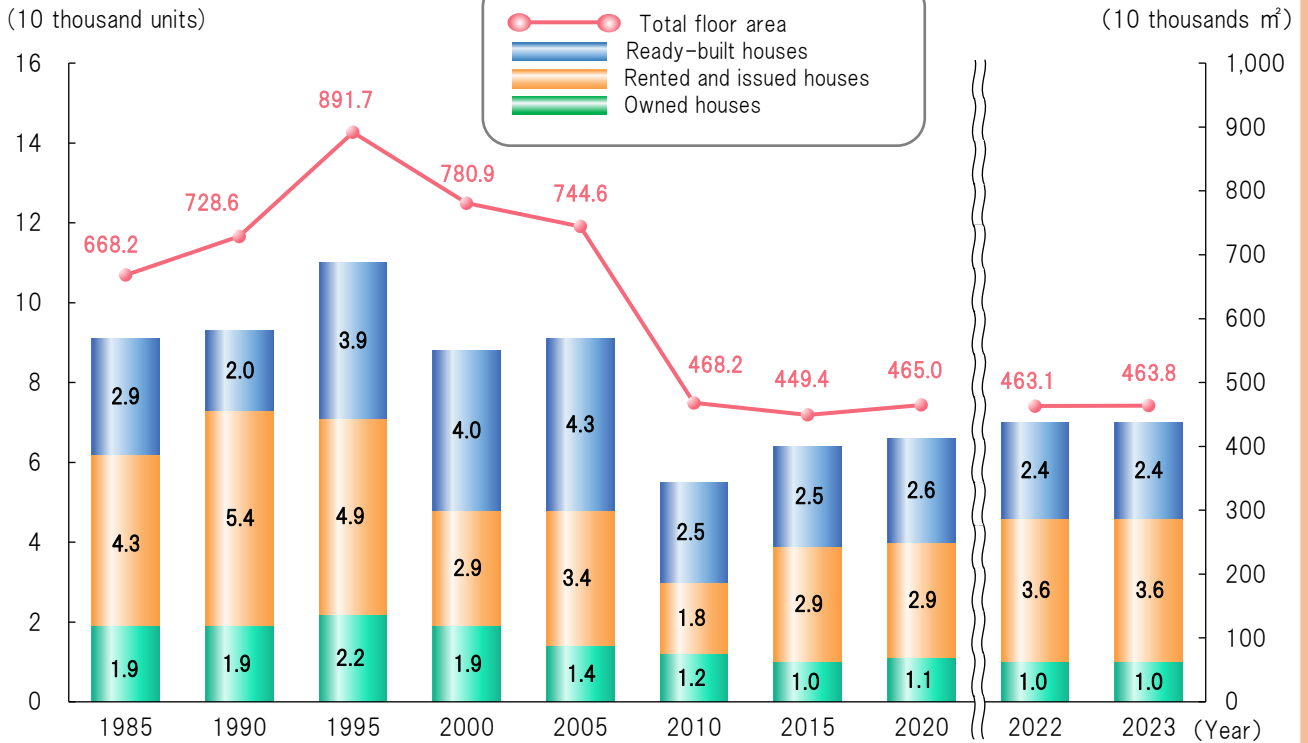

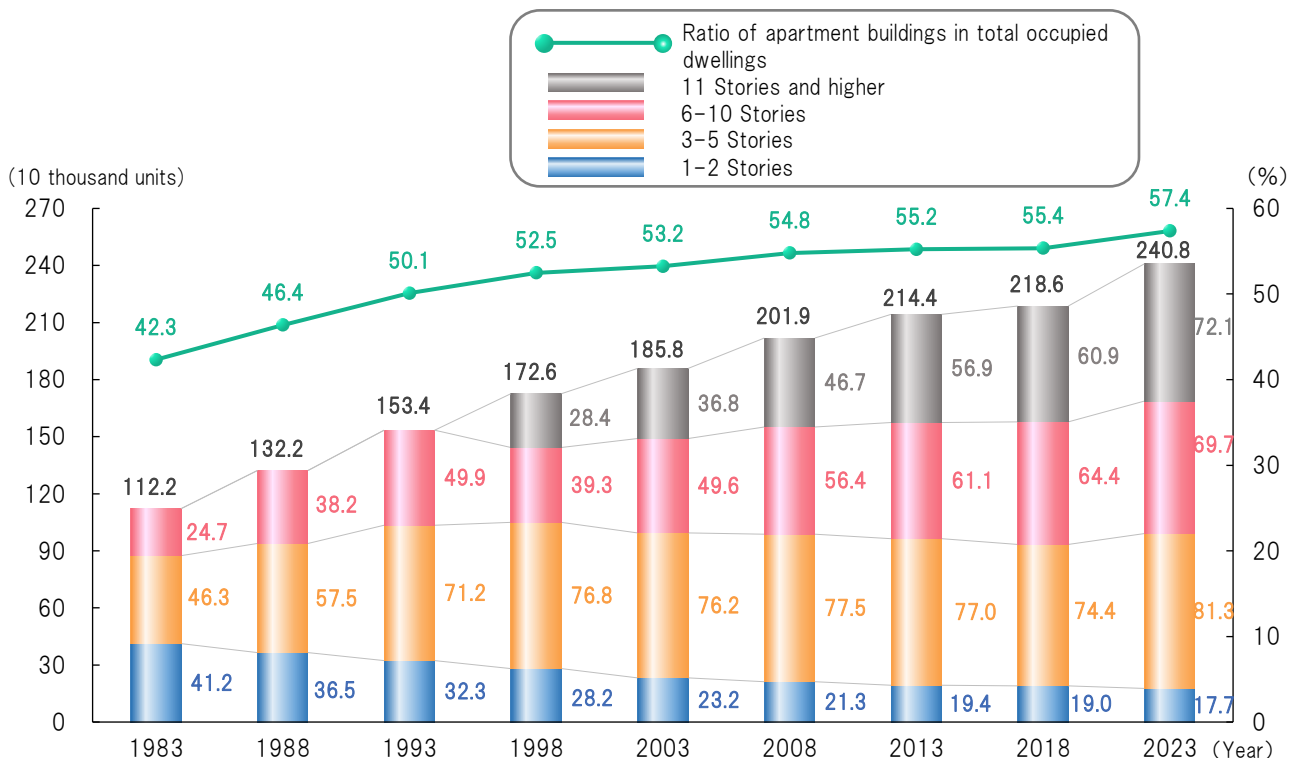

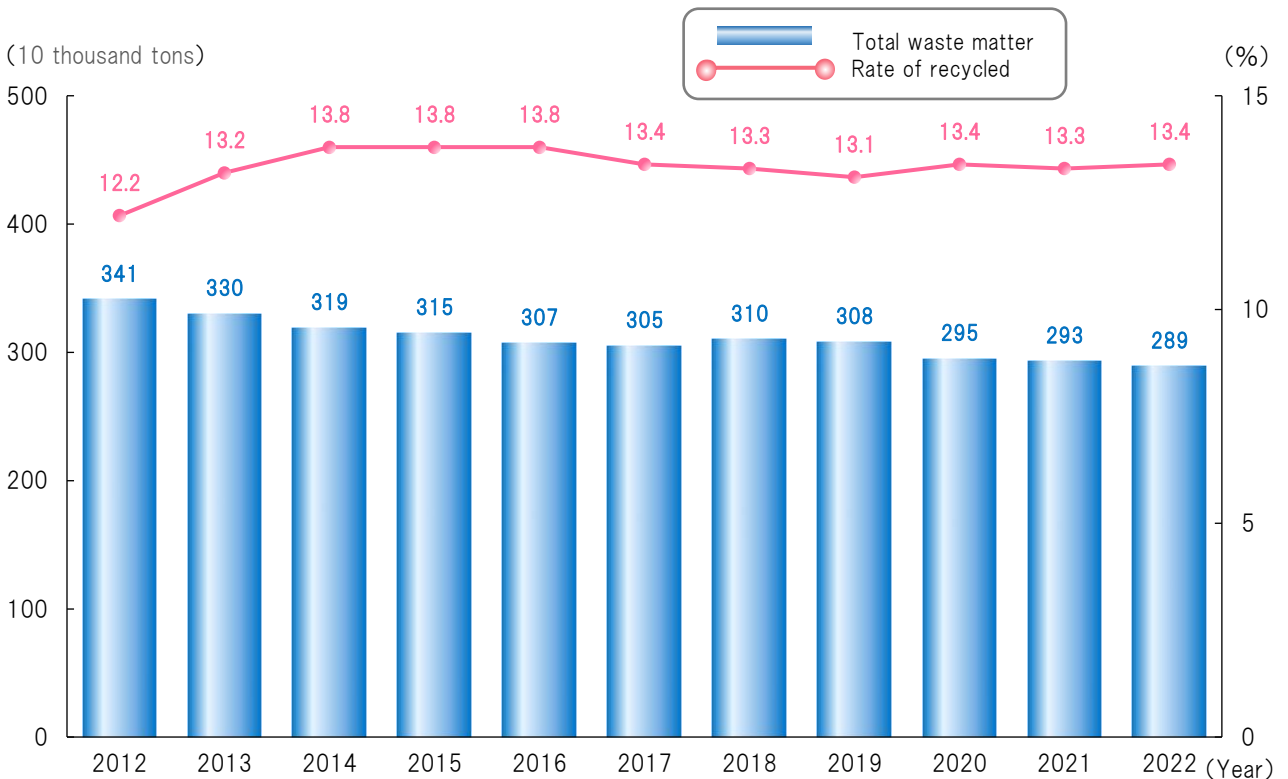

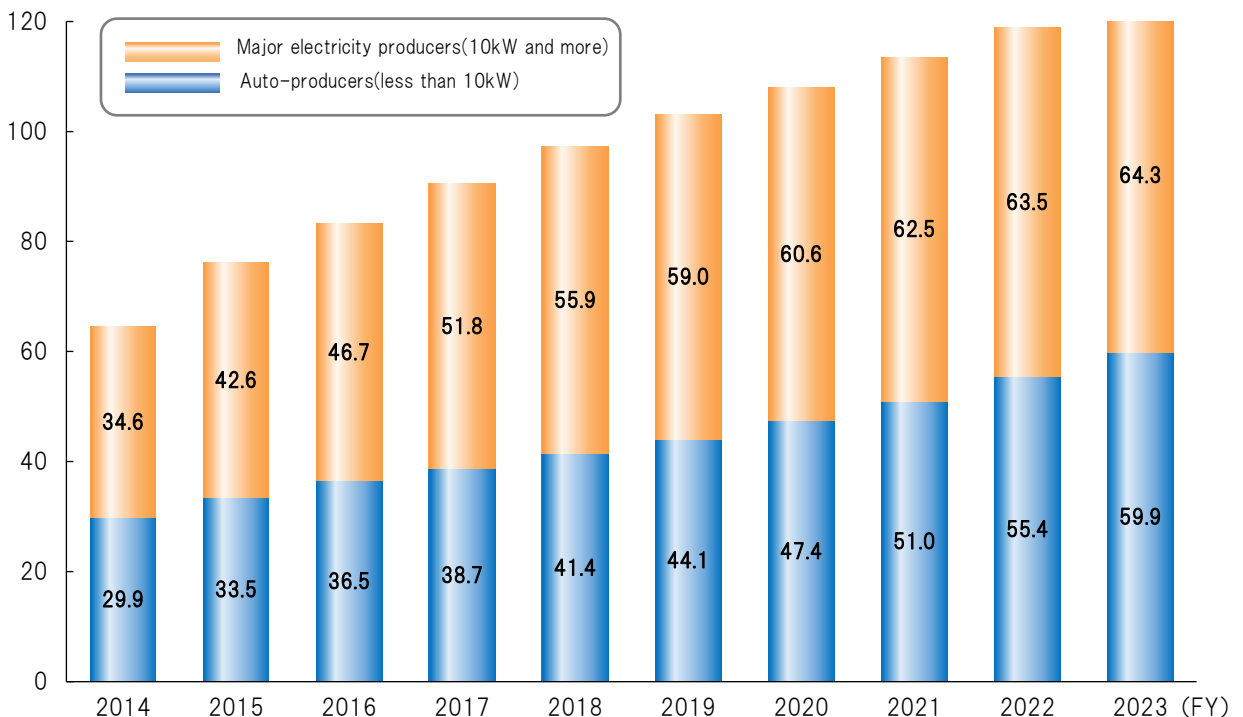

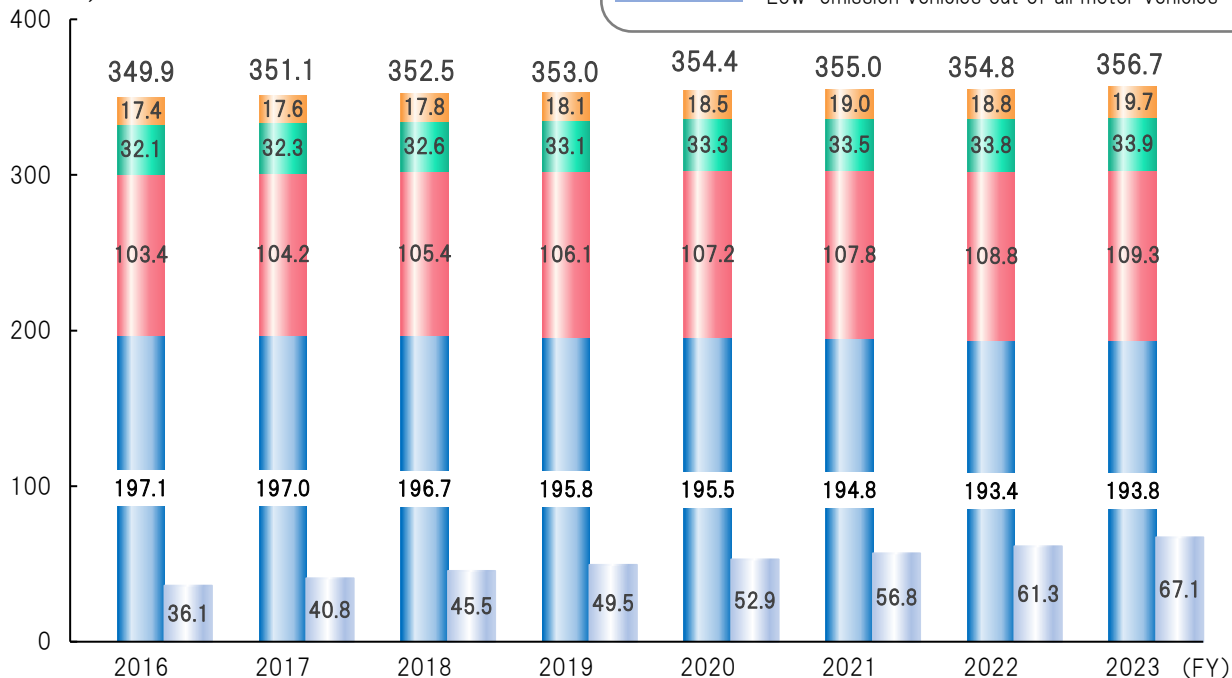

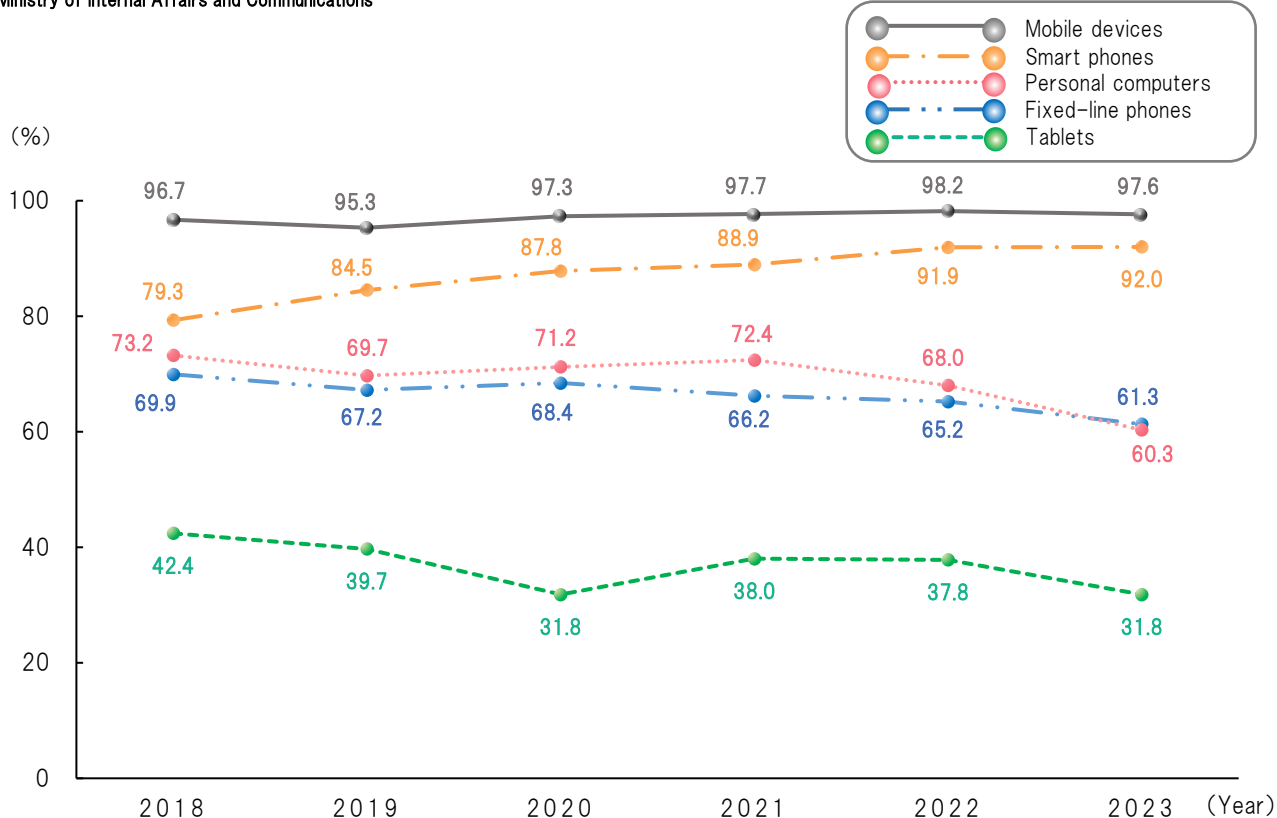

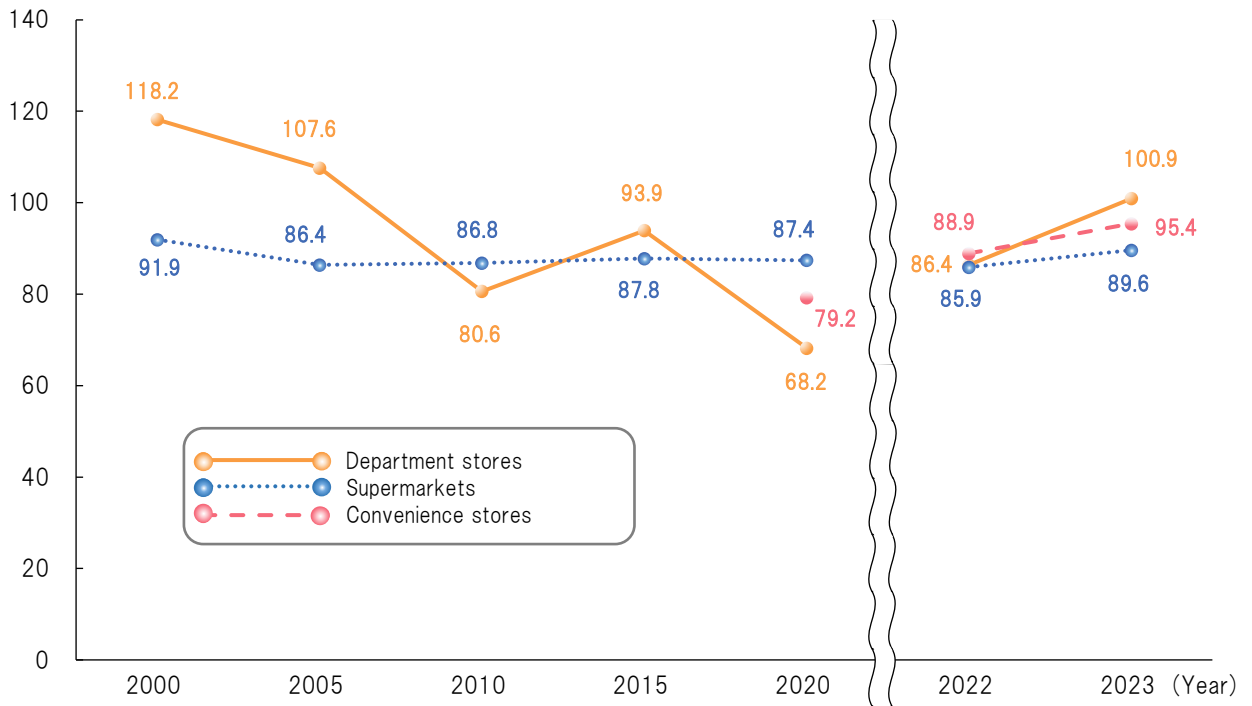

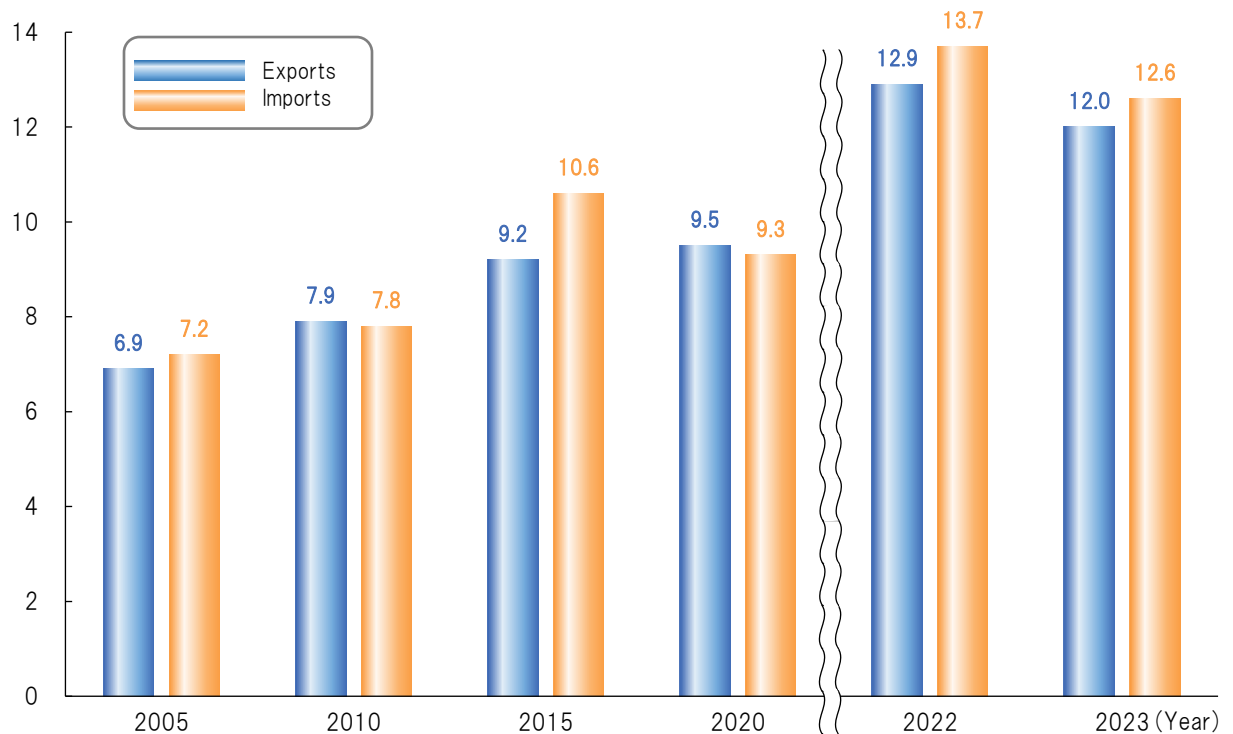

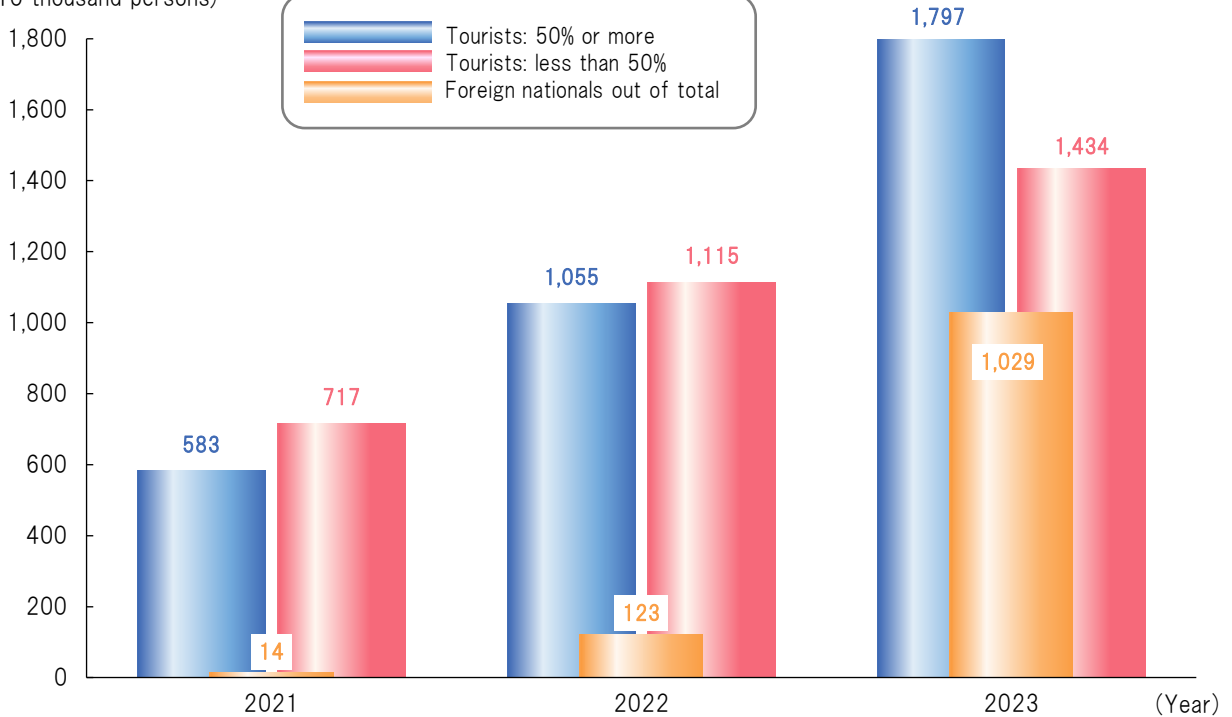

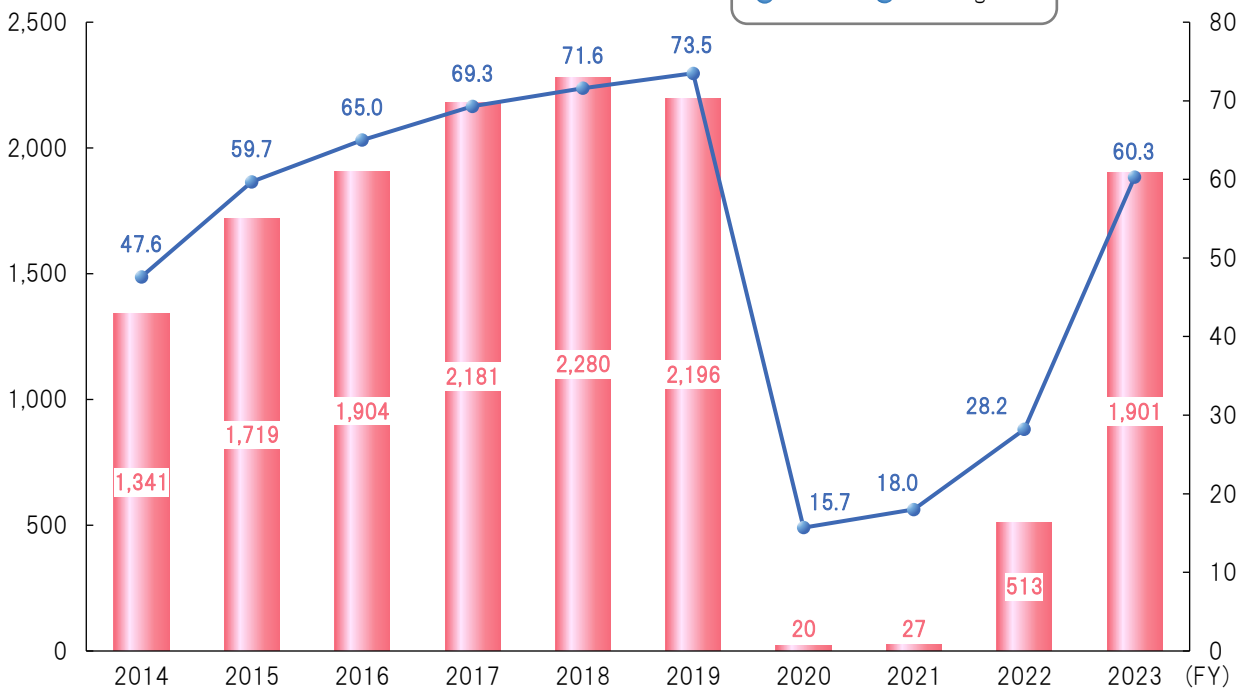


## Number of Landings and Passengers on International Flights at Kansai International Airport

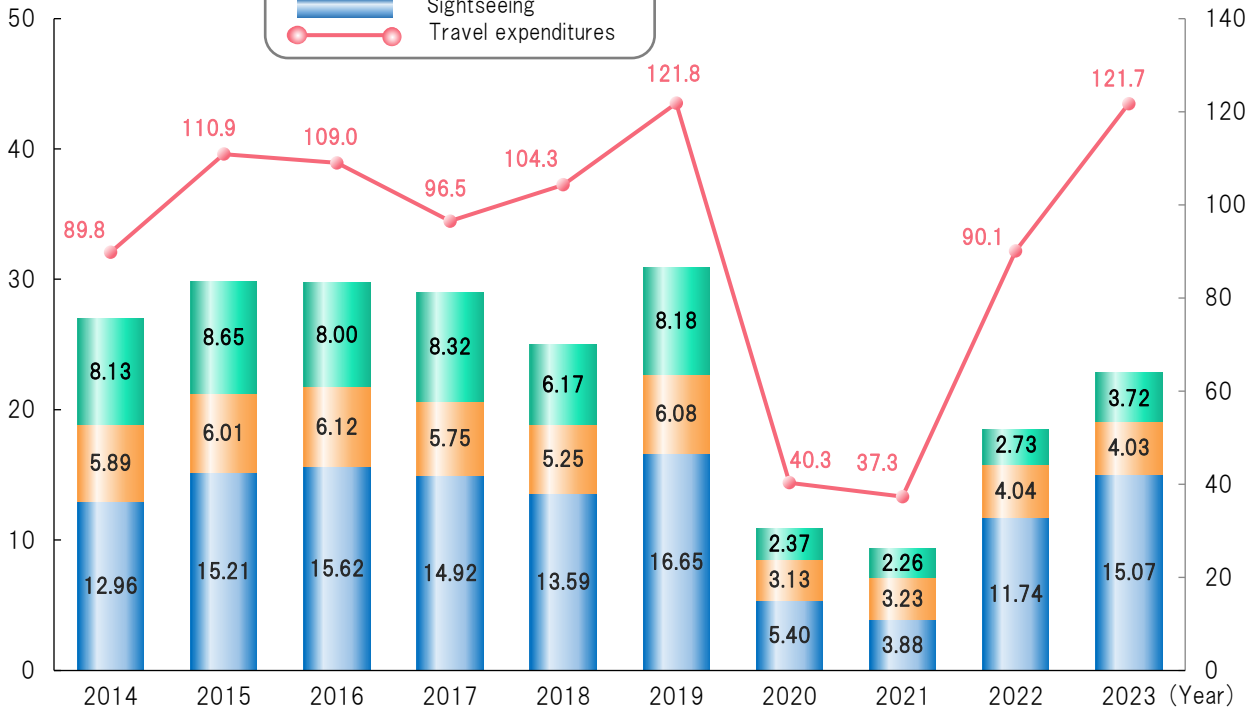
# Number of Travelers by Purpose and Travel Expenditures (Domestic Travels)

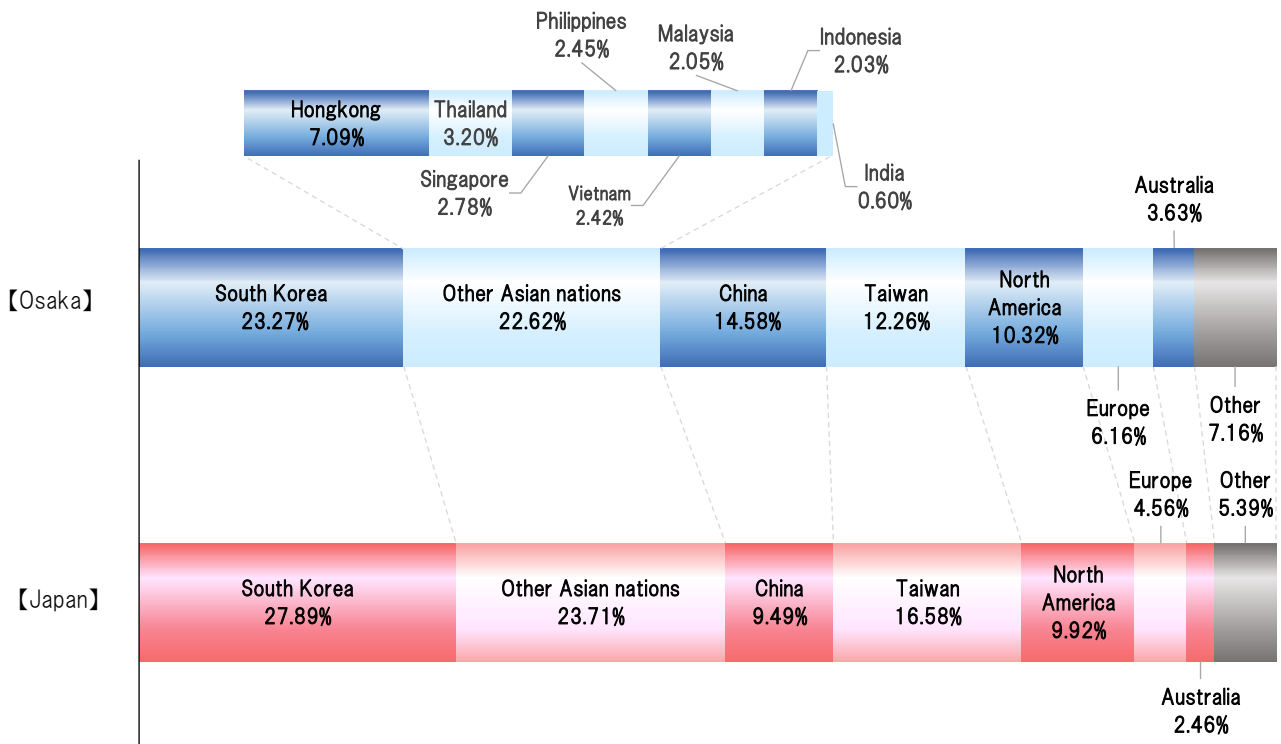

# Visitor Arrivals by Nationality (2023)

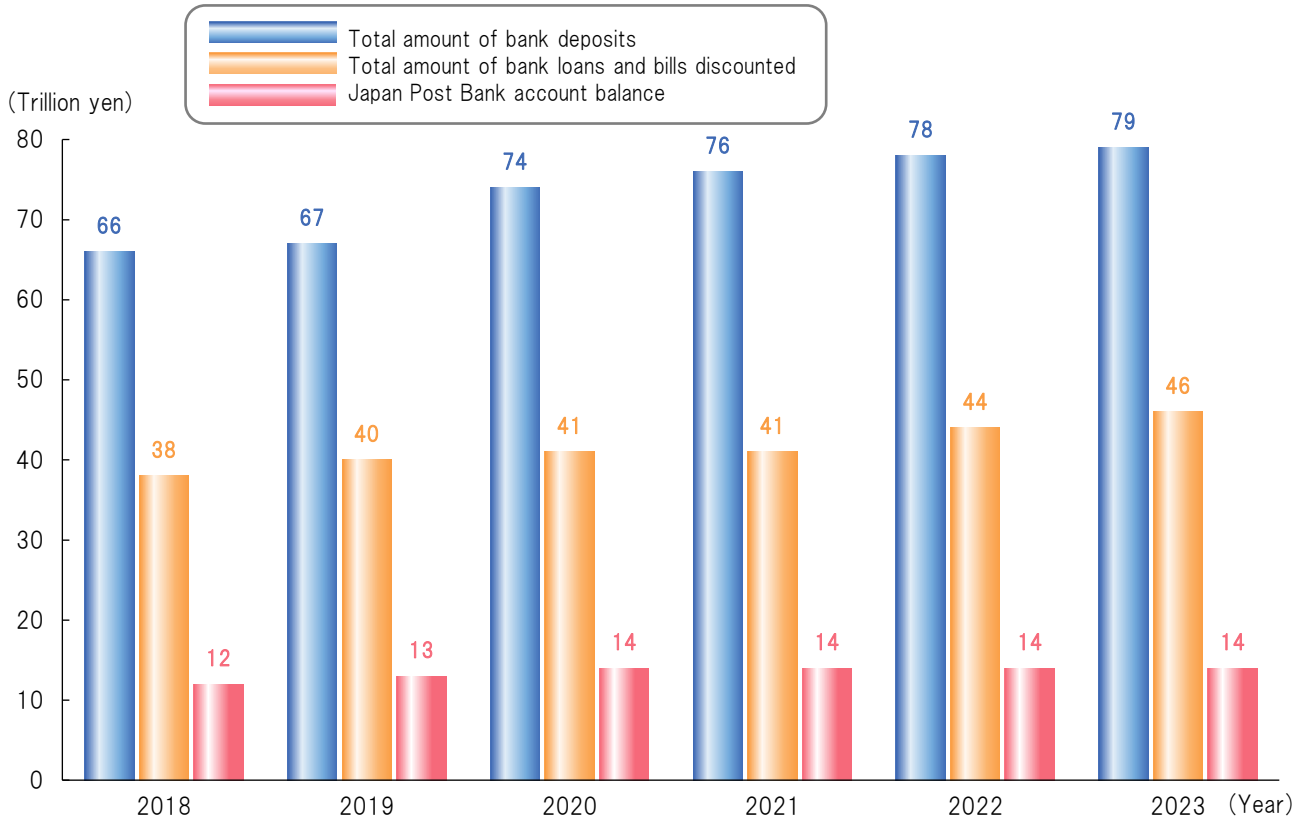

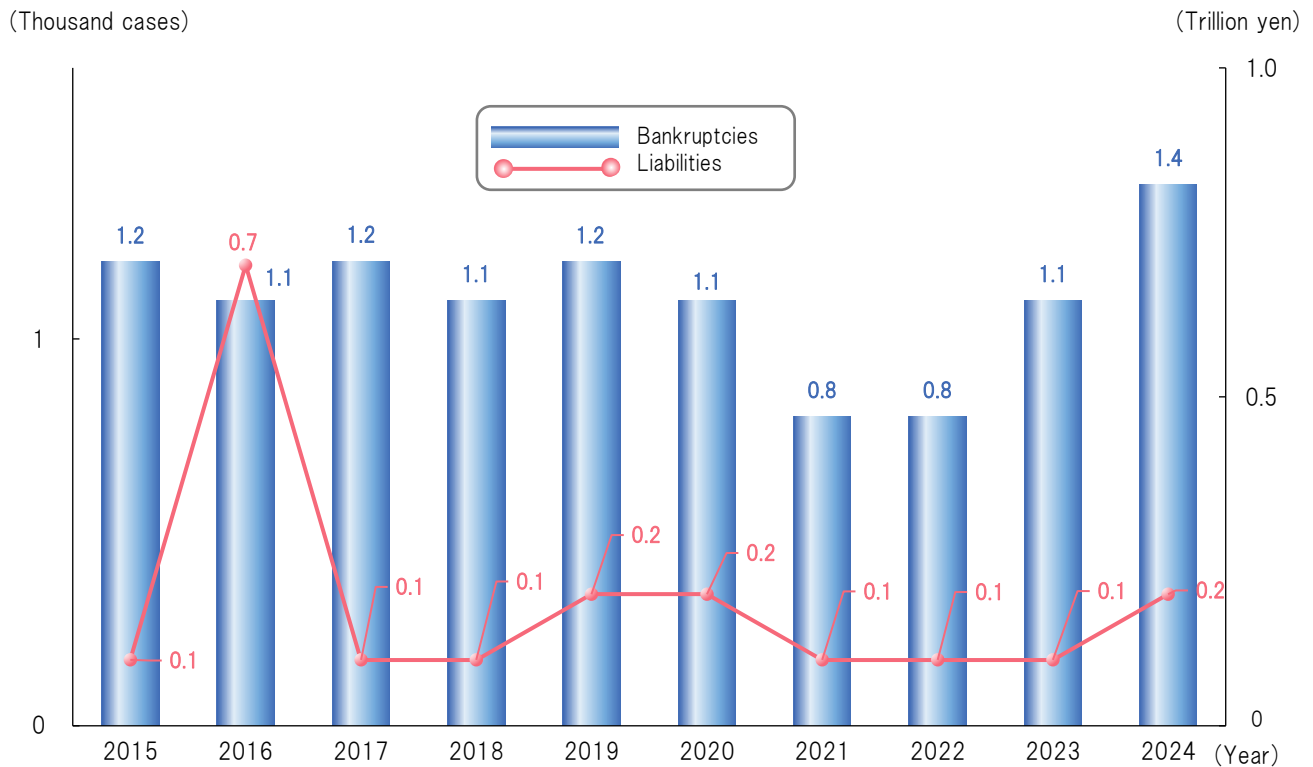

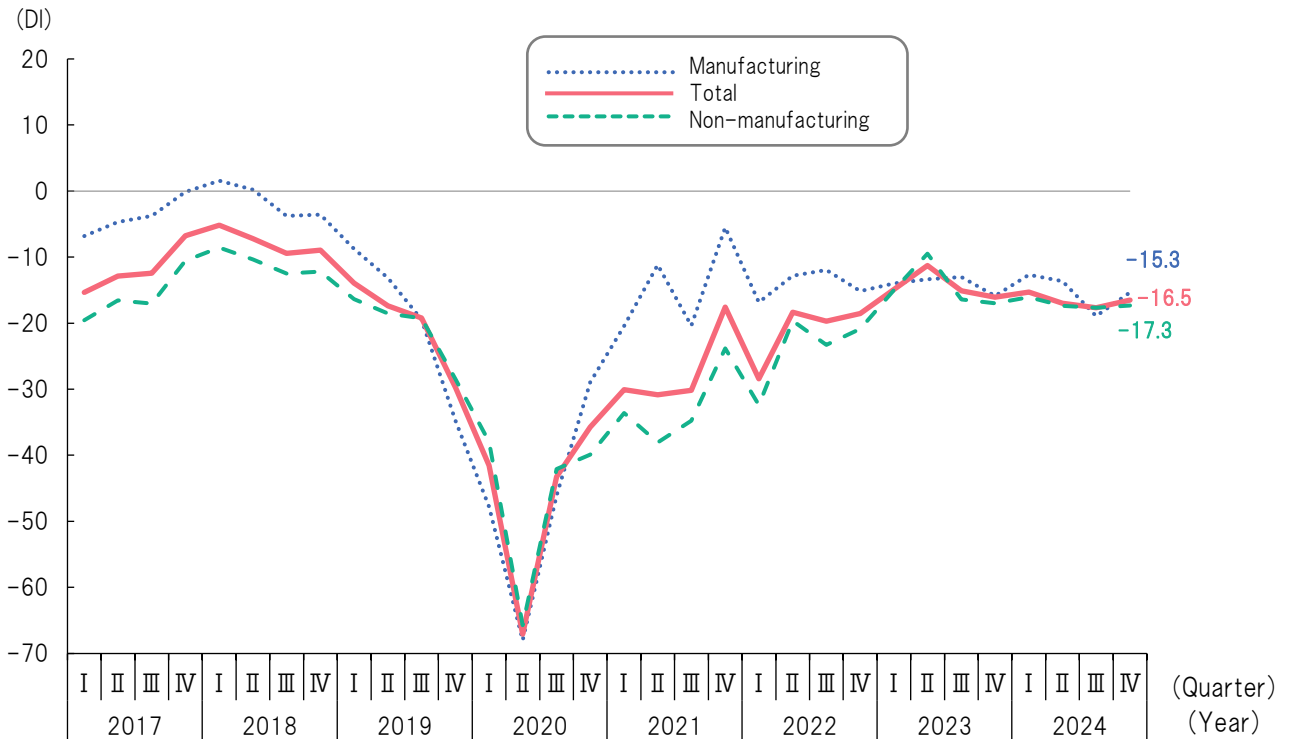

(Period-Over-Period, Seasonally Adjusted, By Manufacturer or Non-Manufacturer)

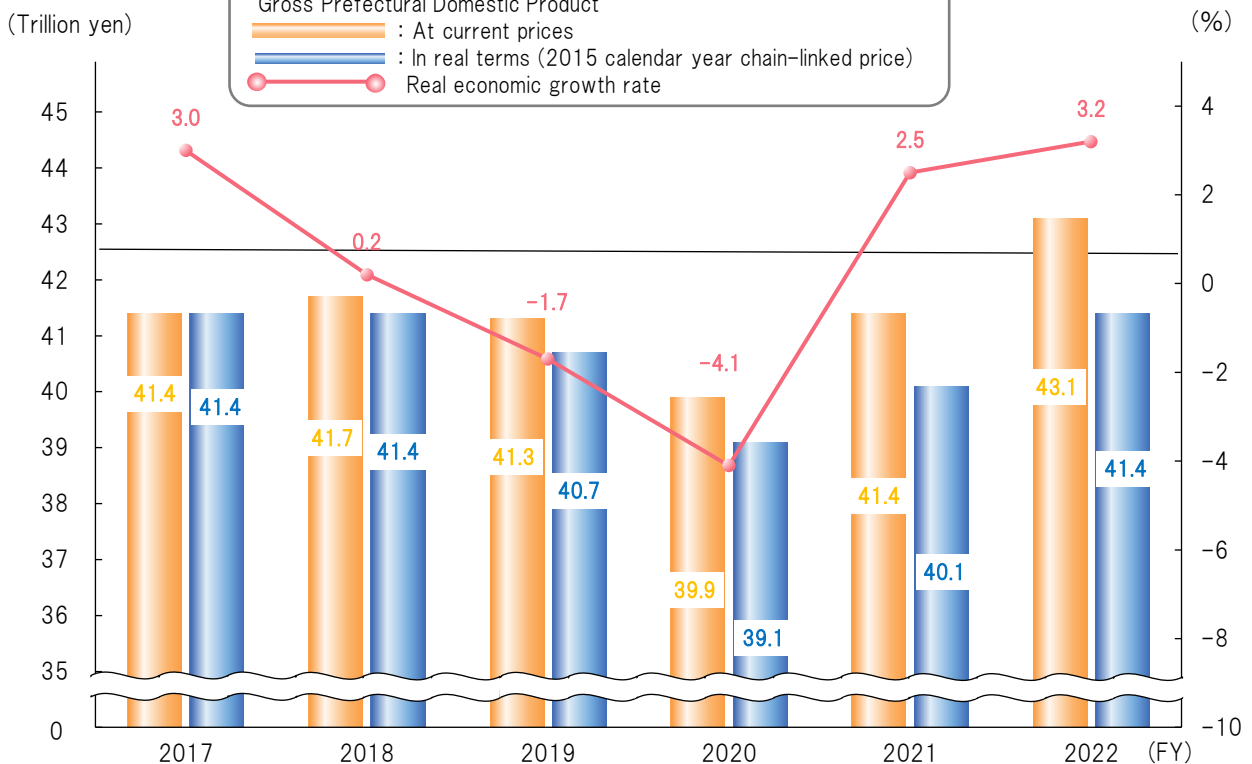

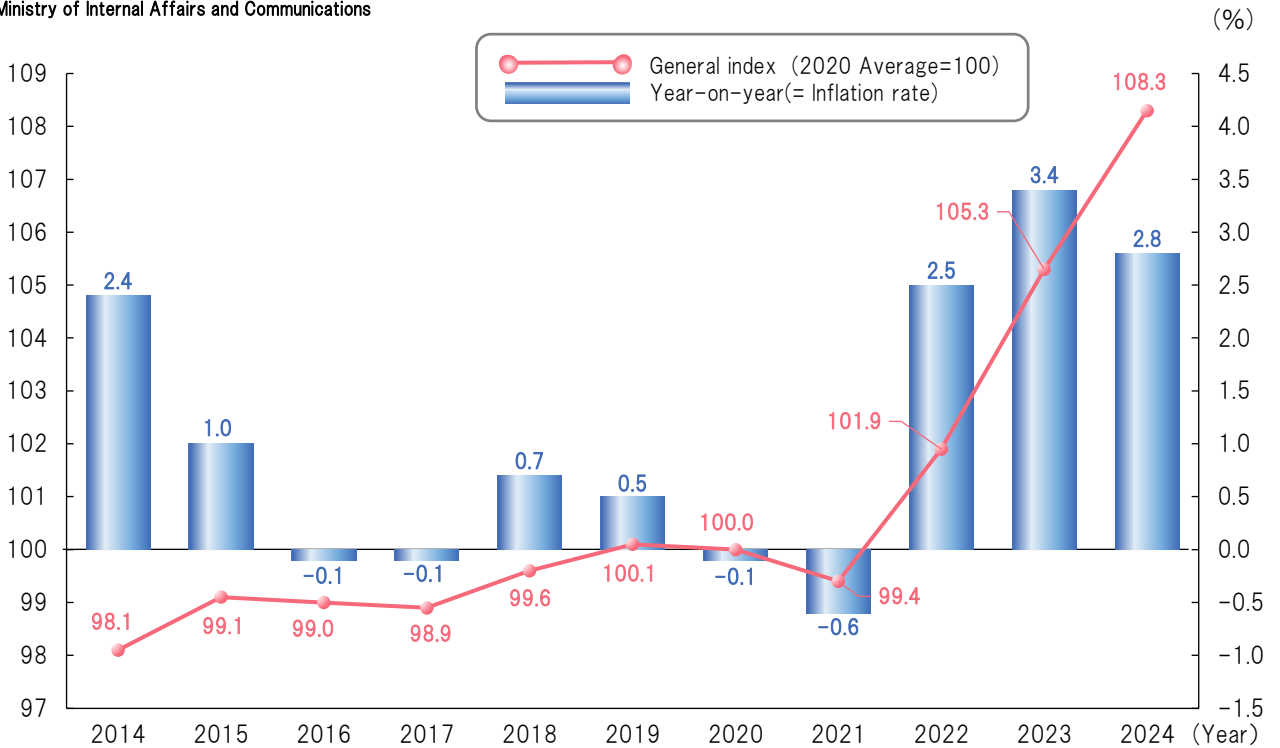

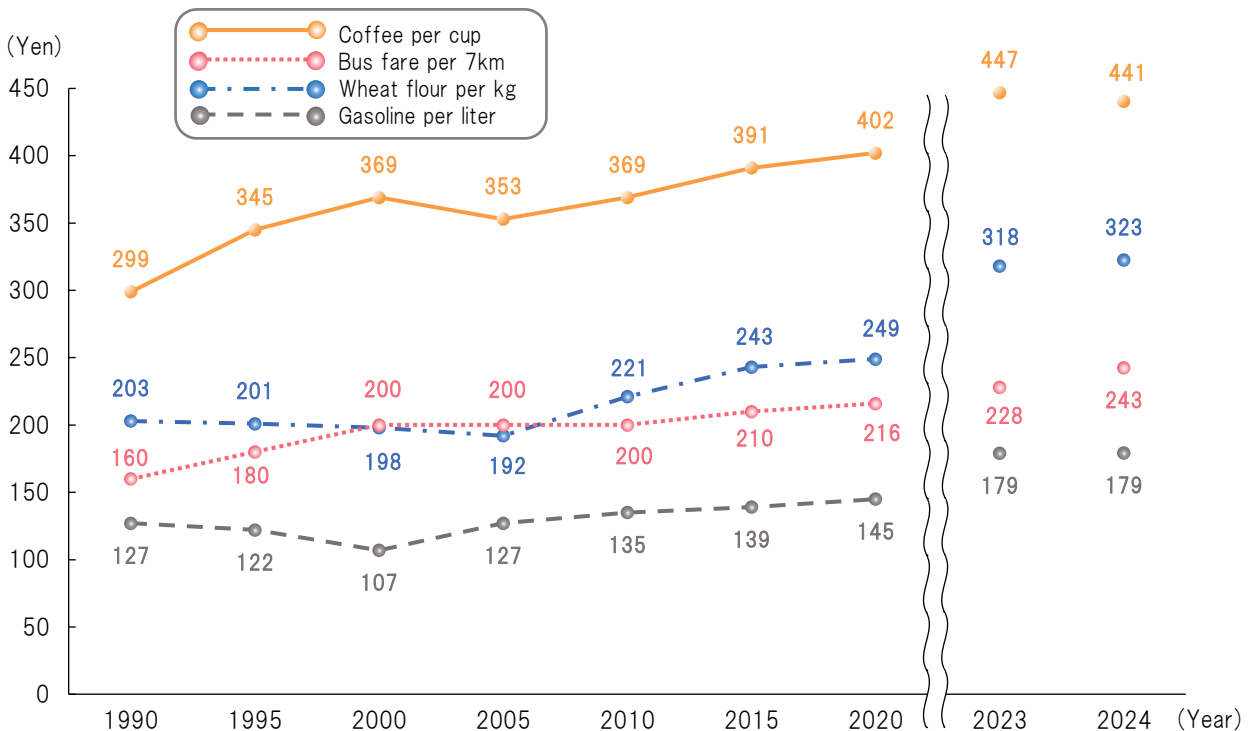

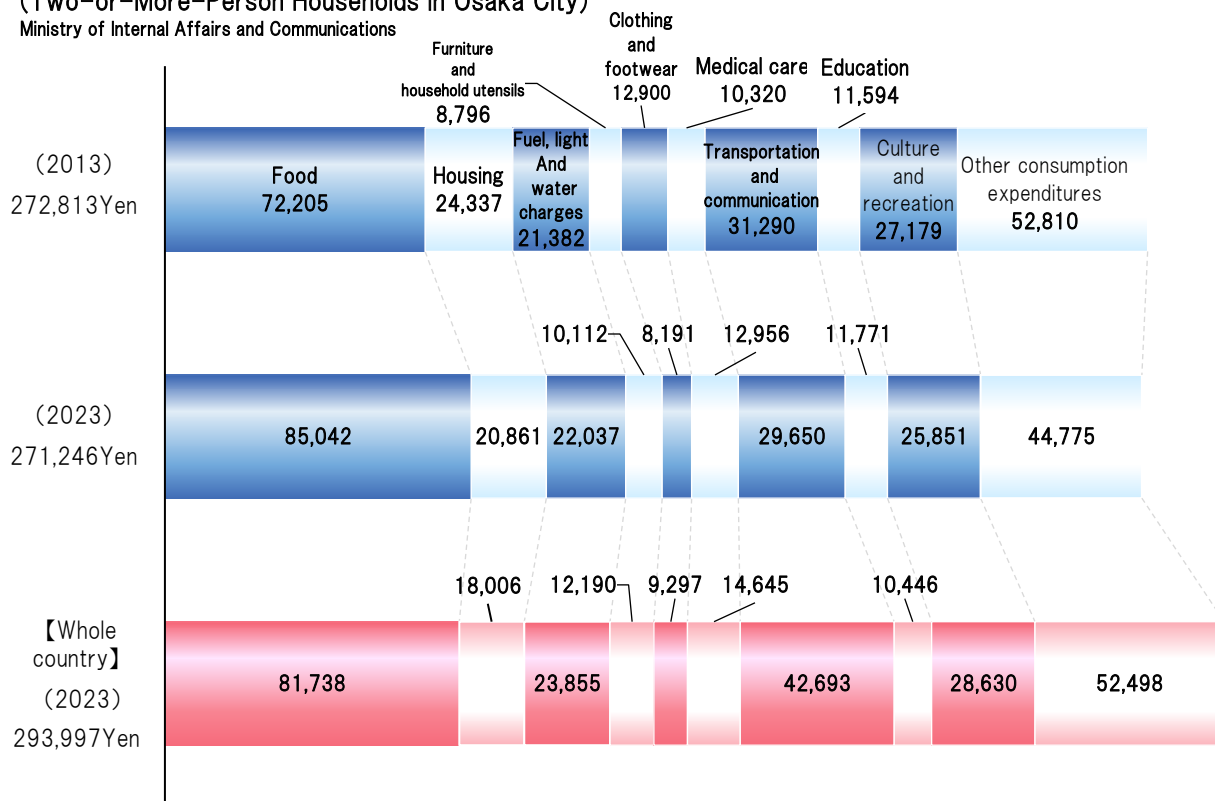

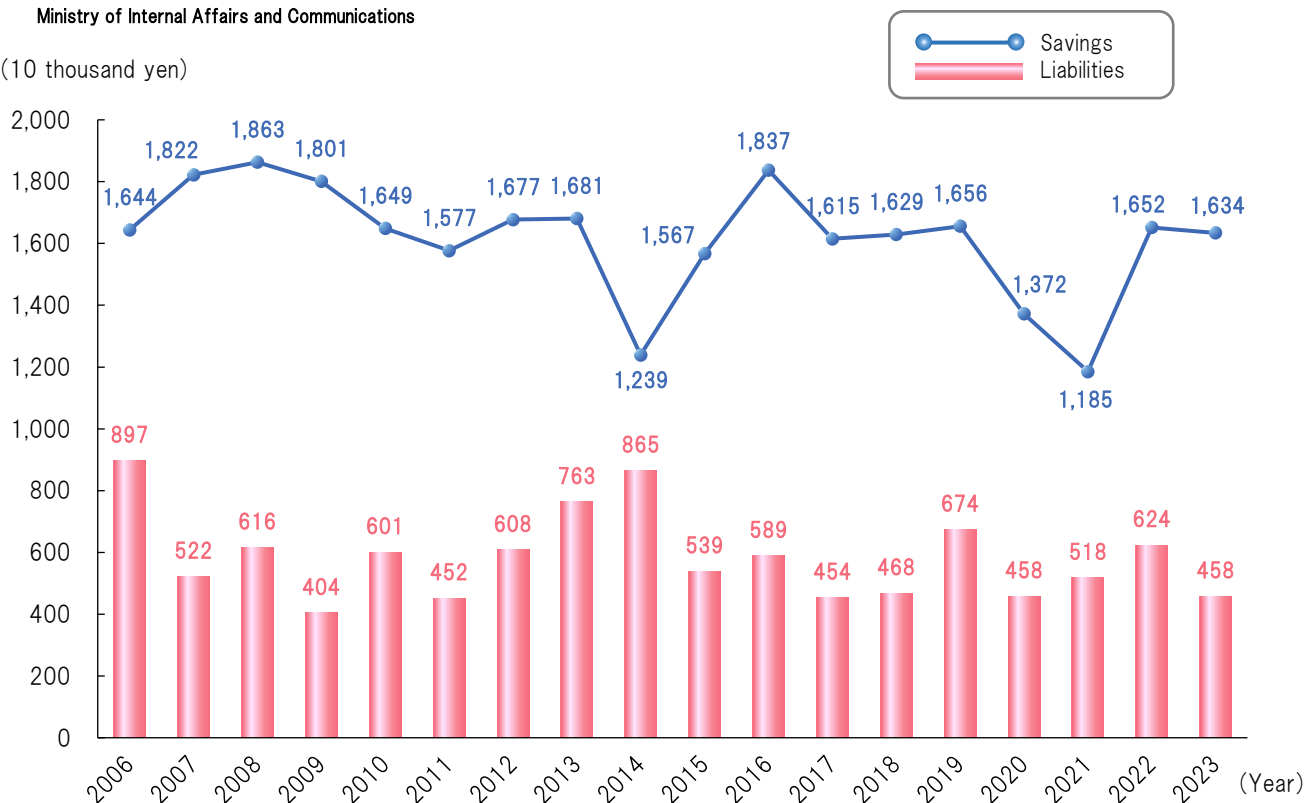

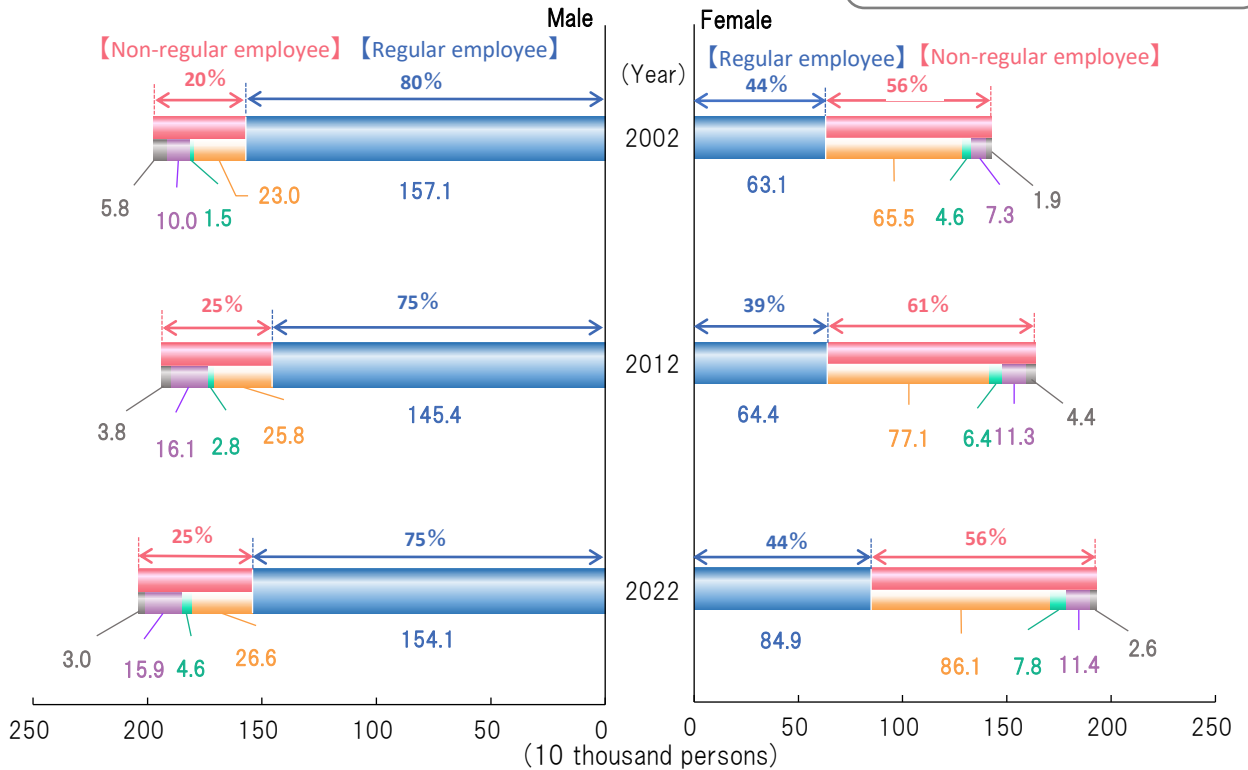

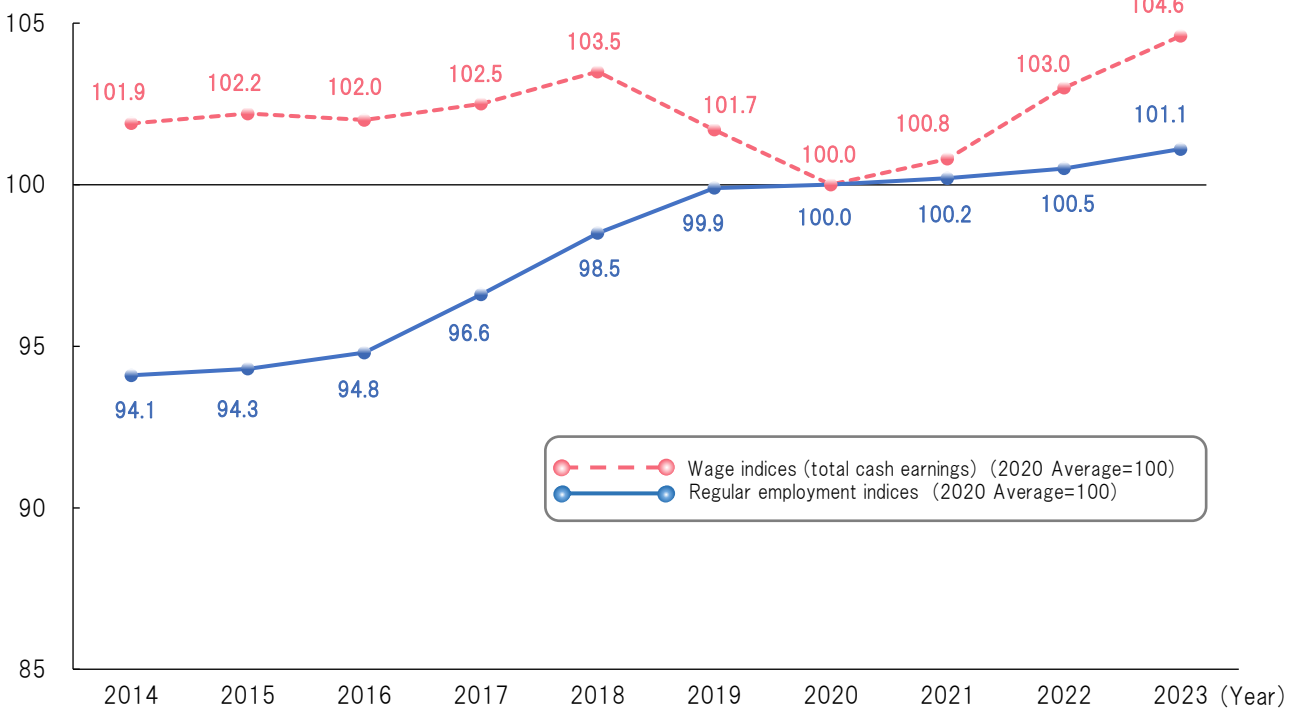

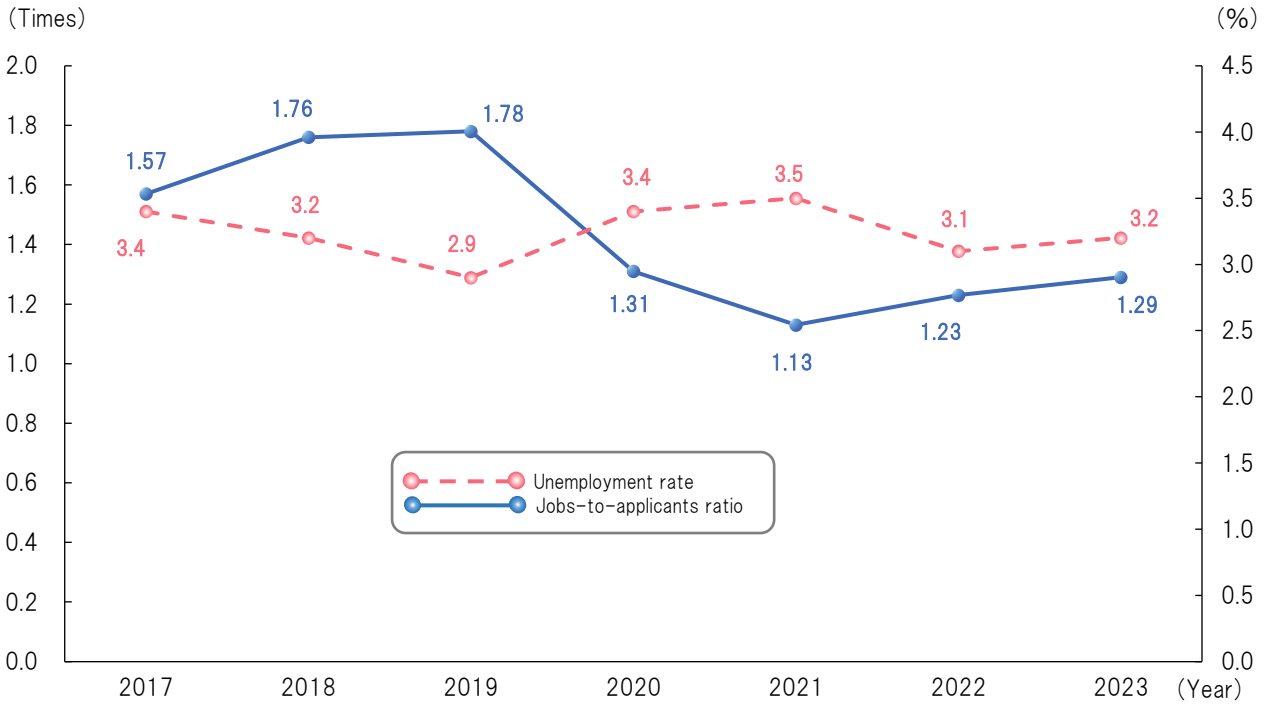

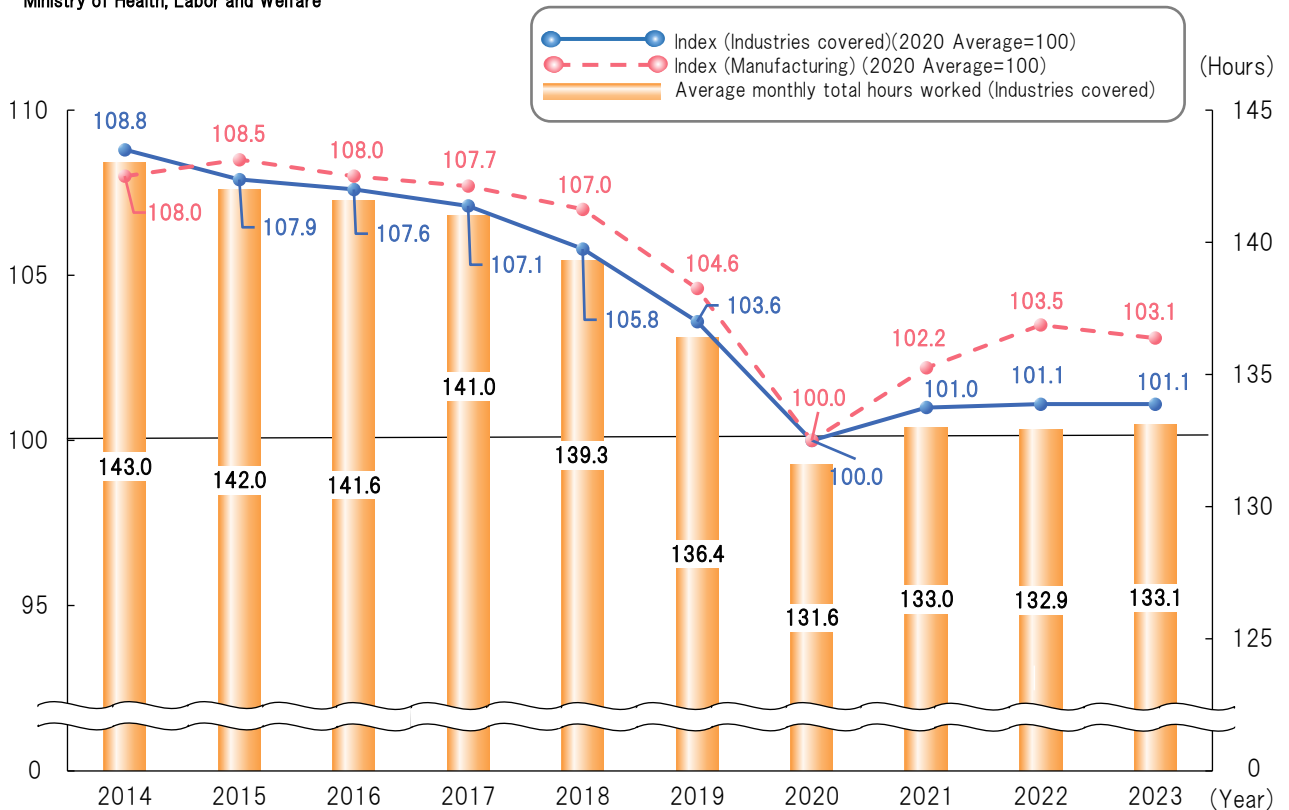

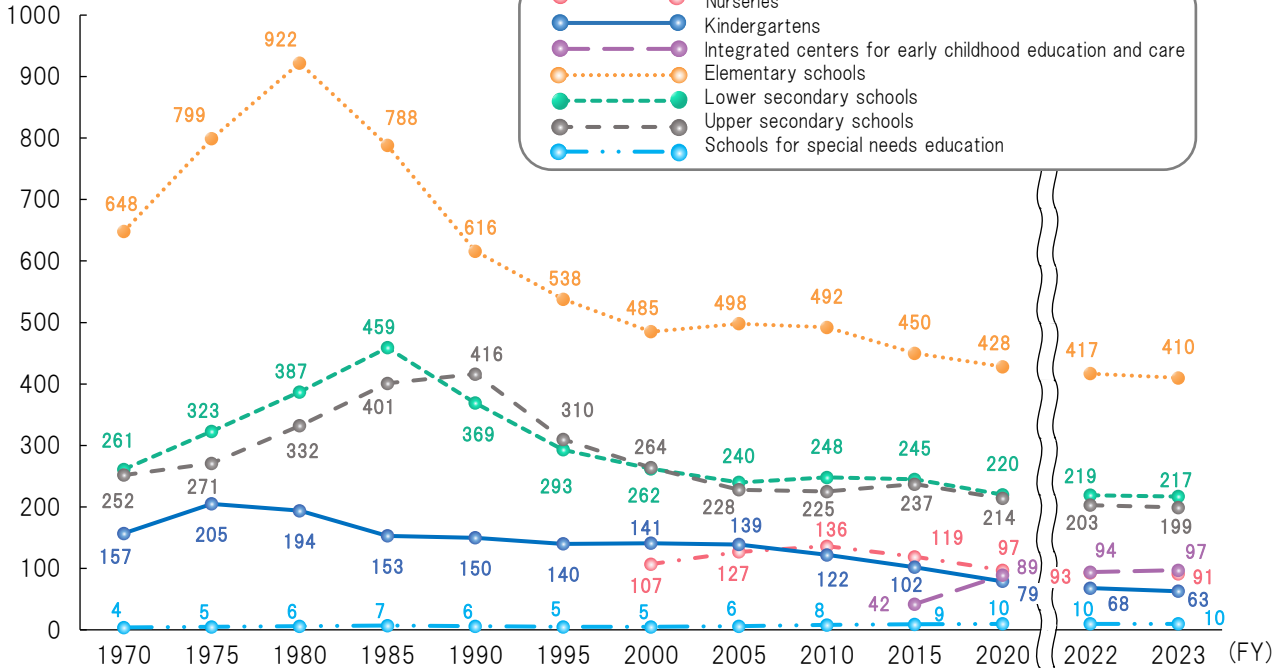

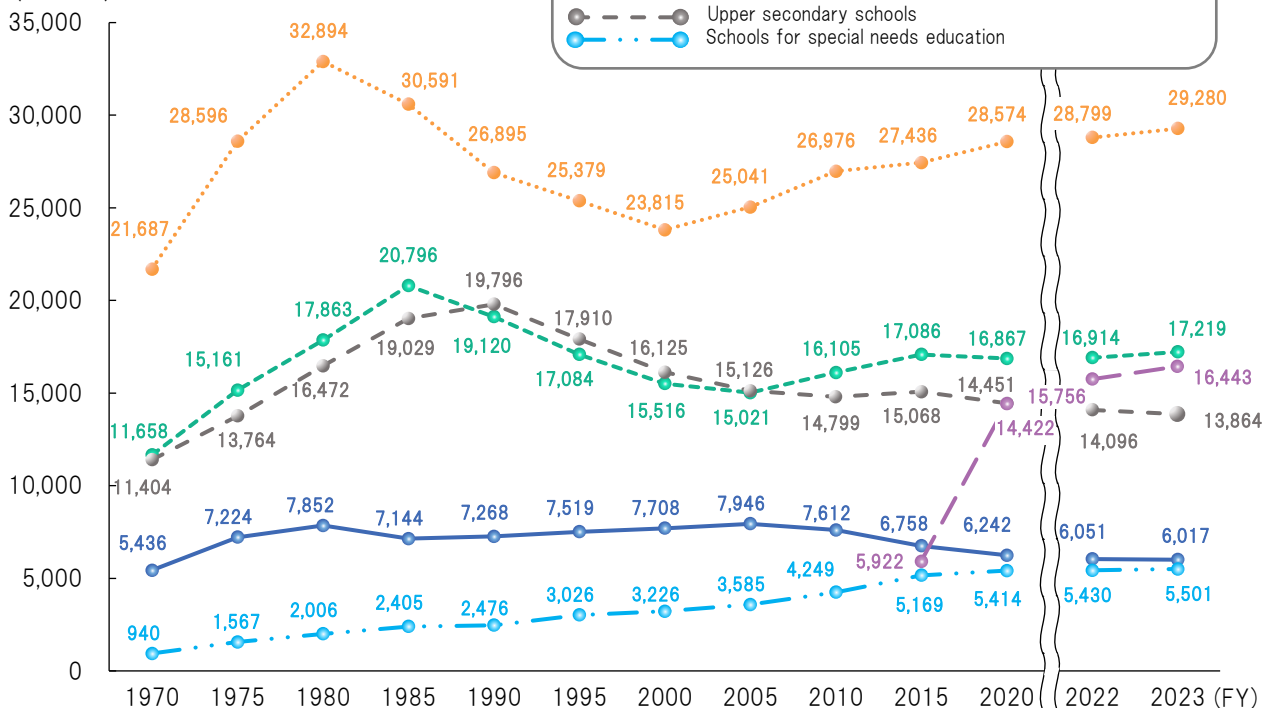

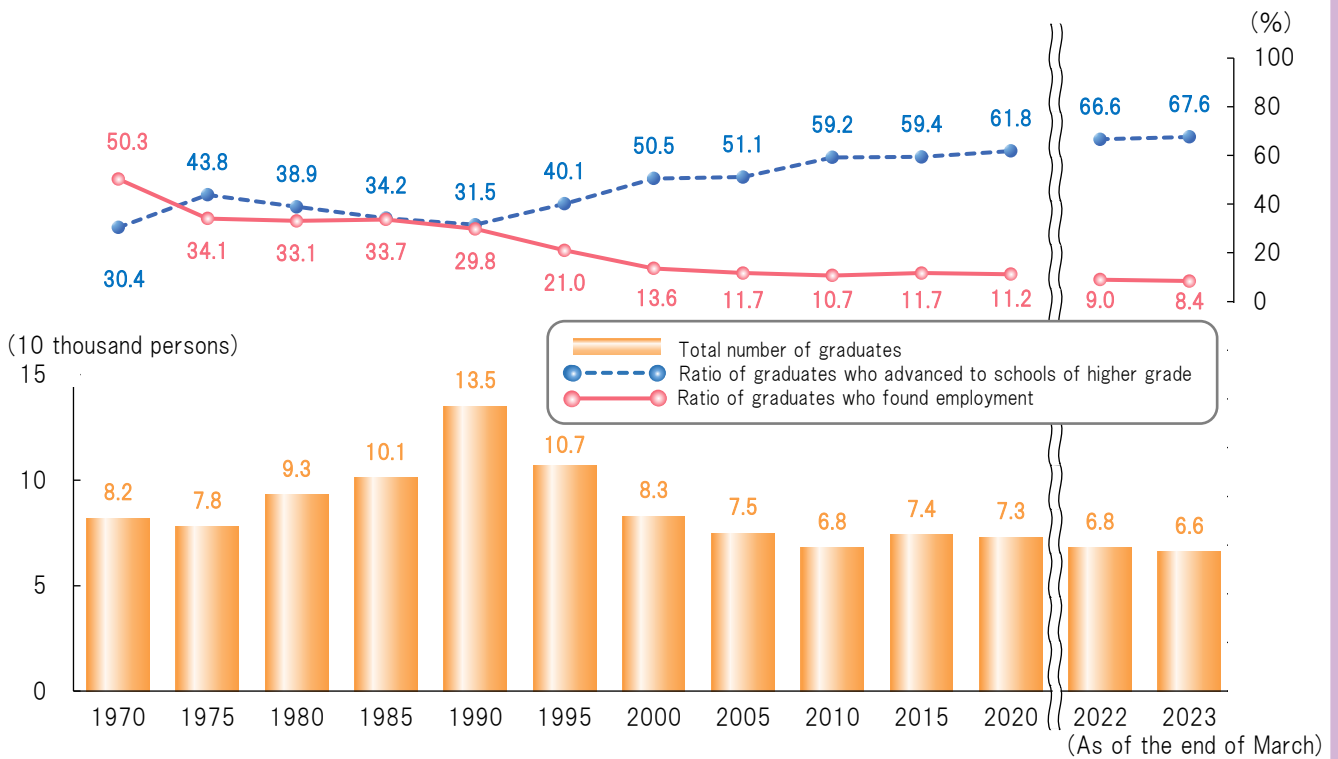

# Number of Upper Secondary School Graduates, Ratio of Graduates Who Advanced to Schools of Higher Grade and Who Found Employment

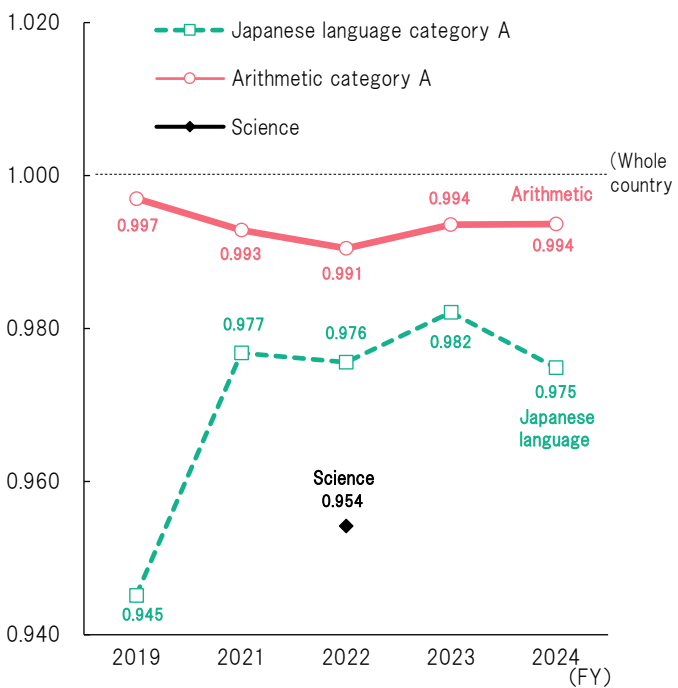

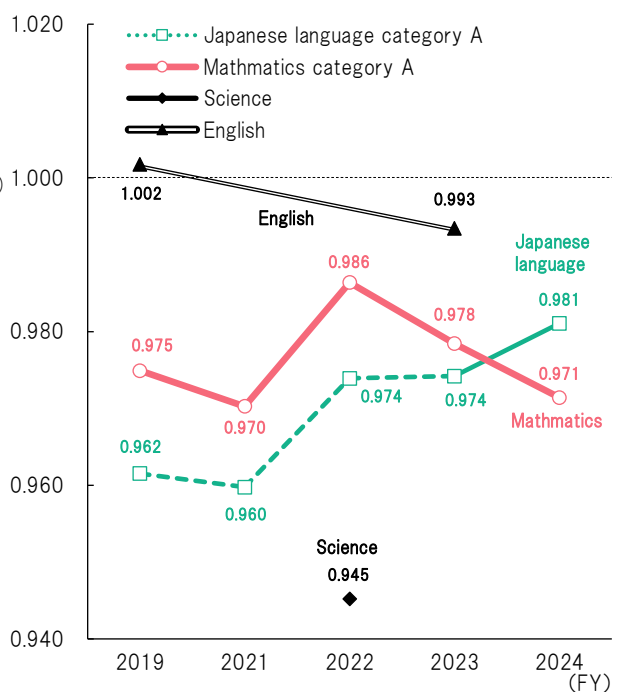
## Academic Ability of Students

Elementary school children's grades compared to the whole country by subjects (categories)



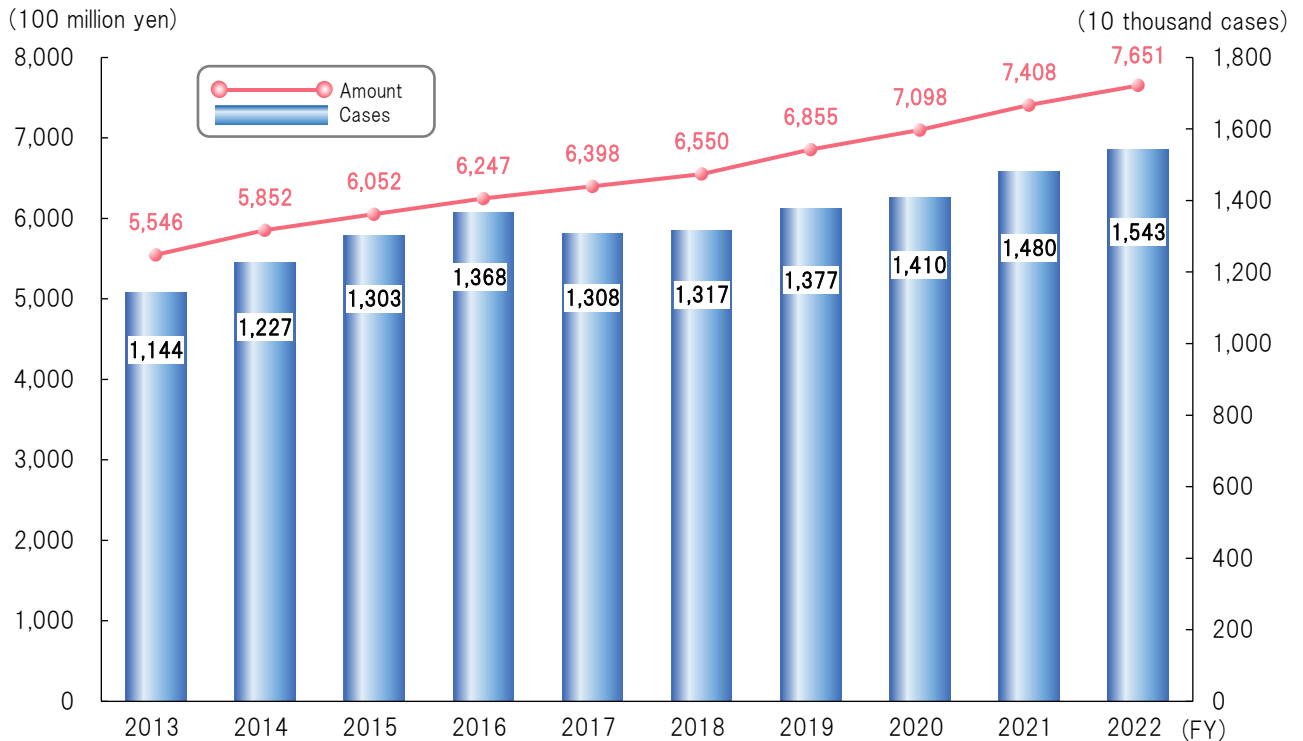

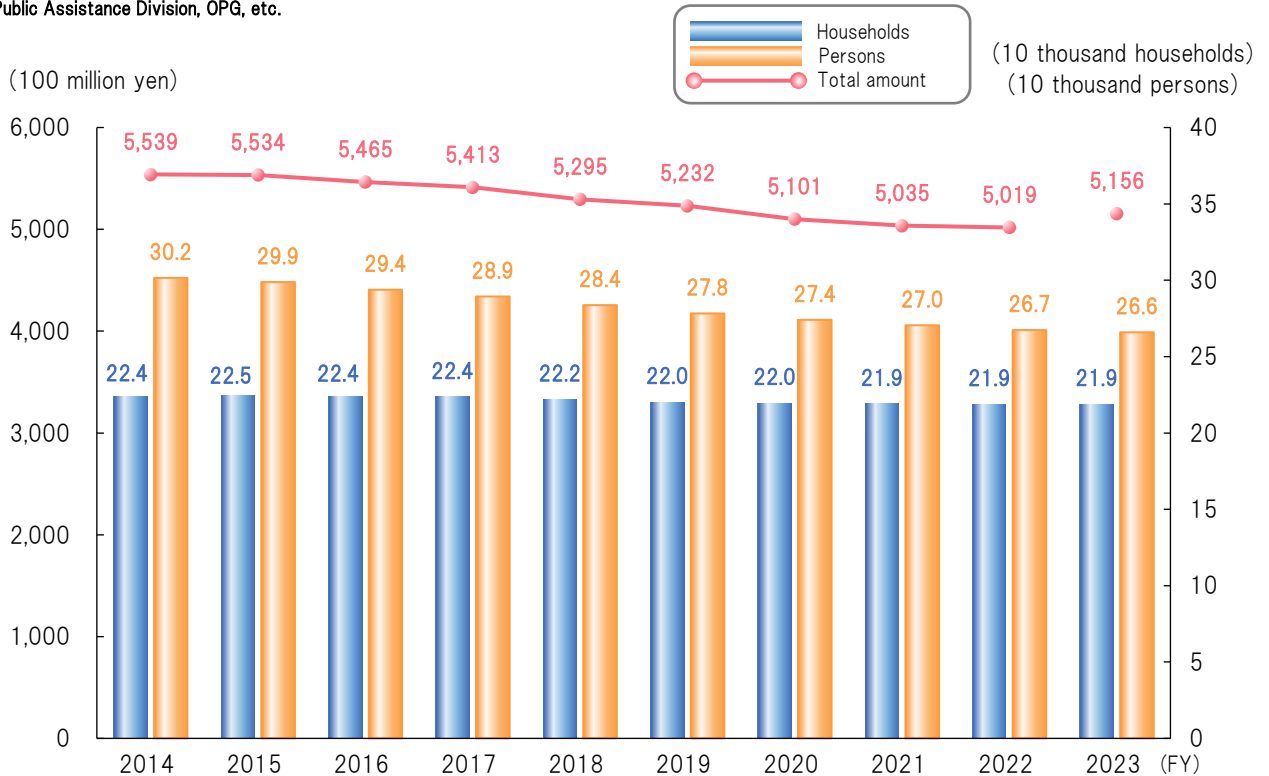

## Number of Households and Persons Receiving Public Livelihood Assistance, Total Amount of Received Aid.

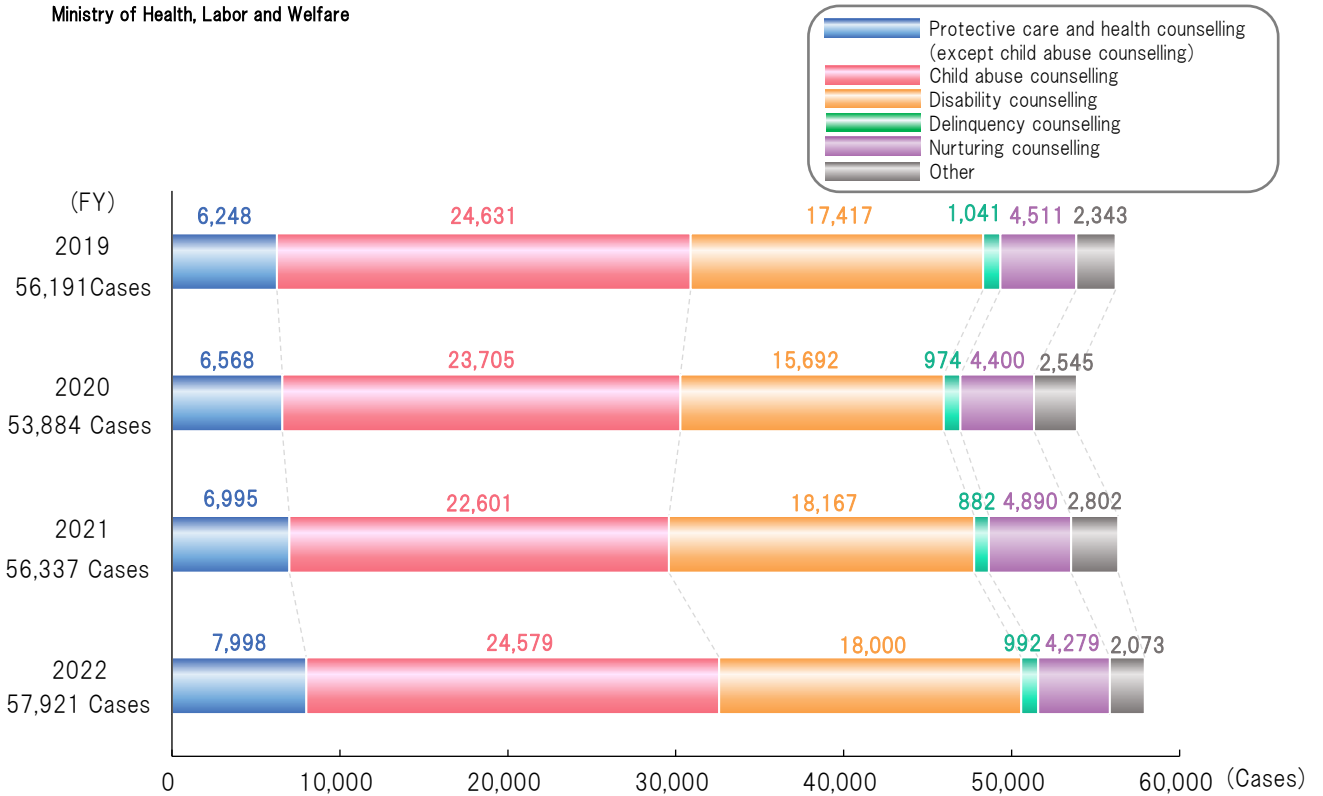

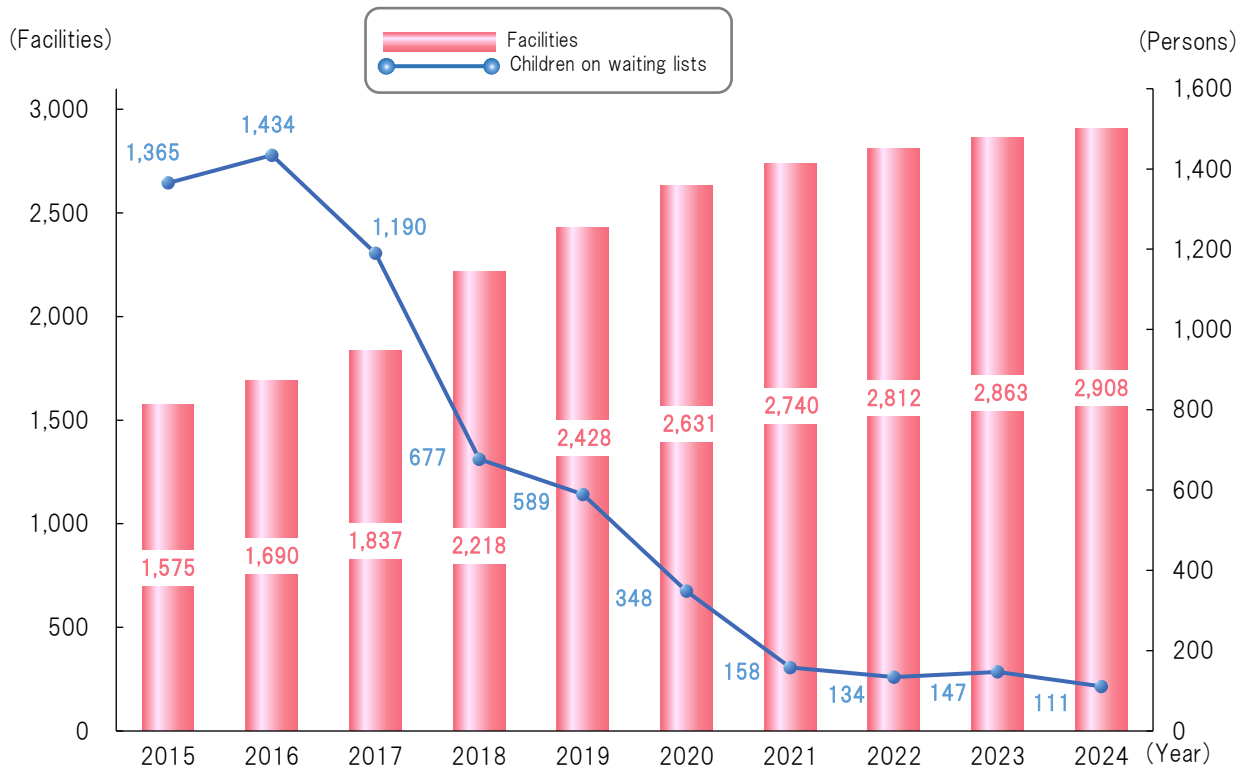

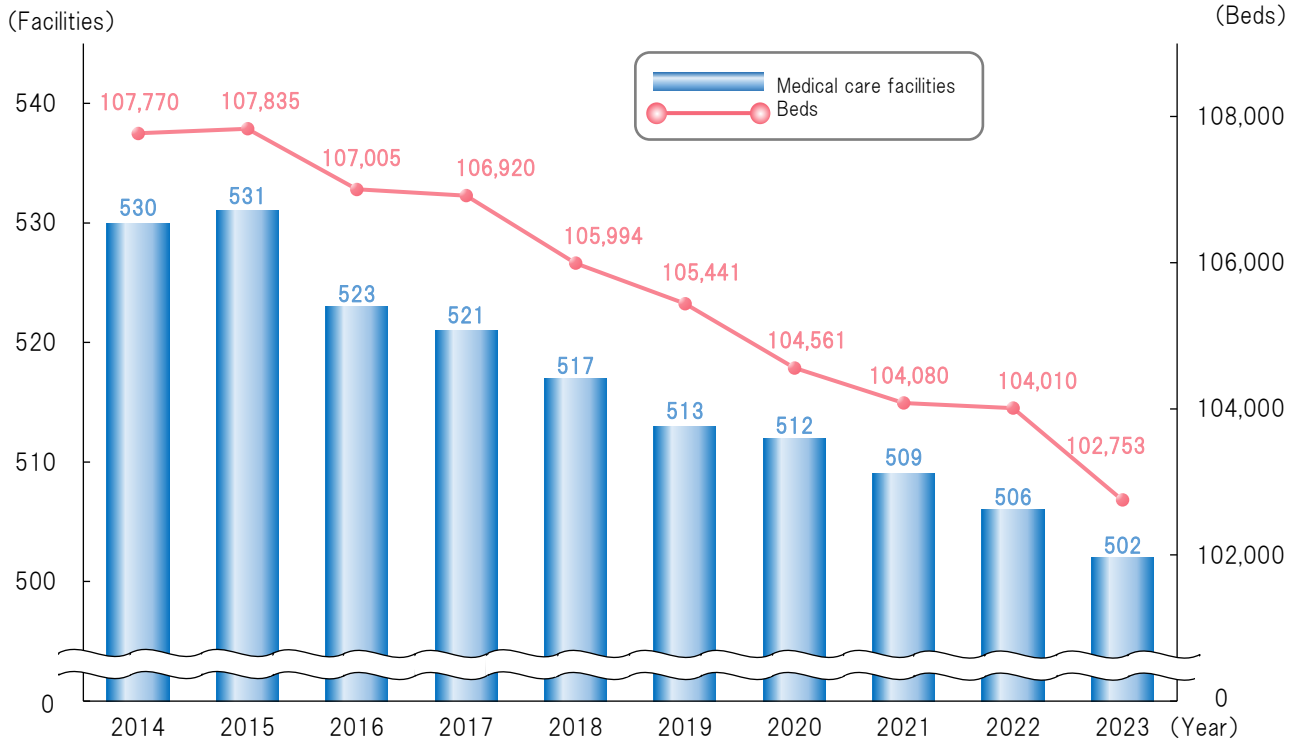

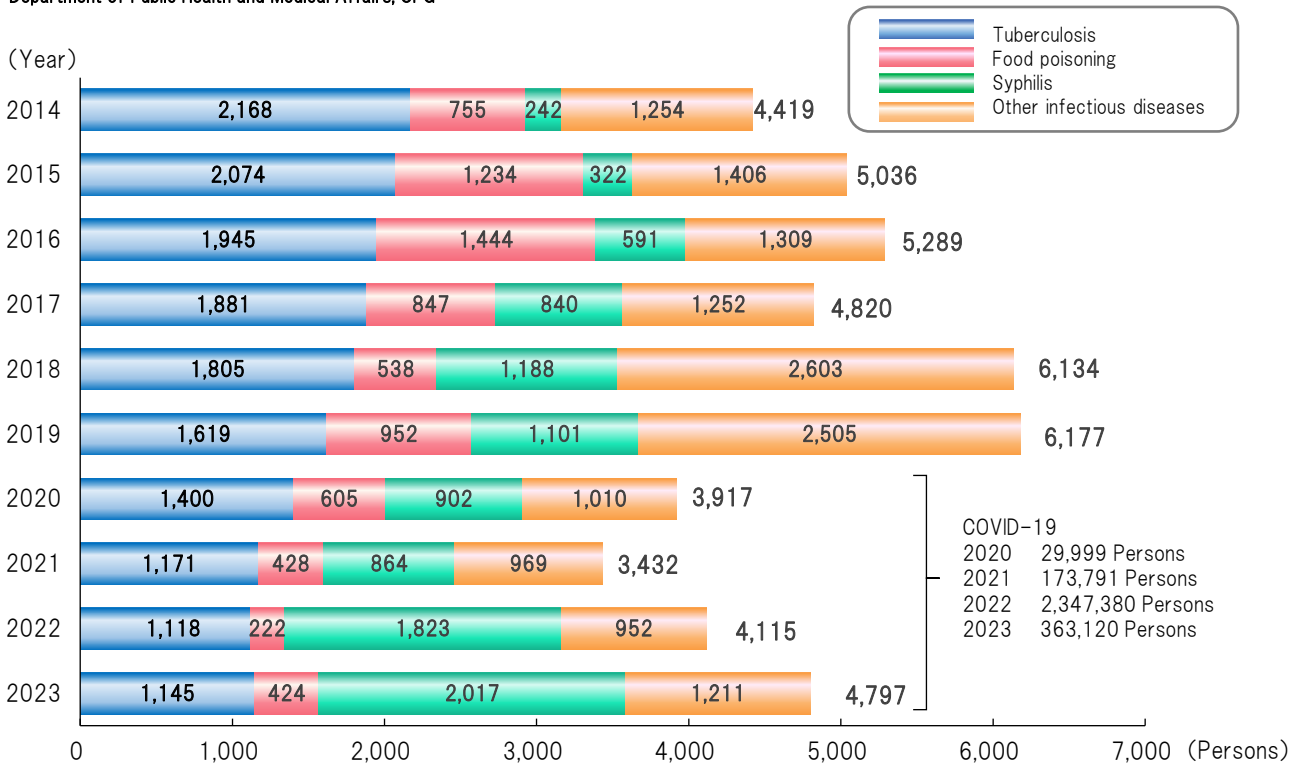

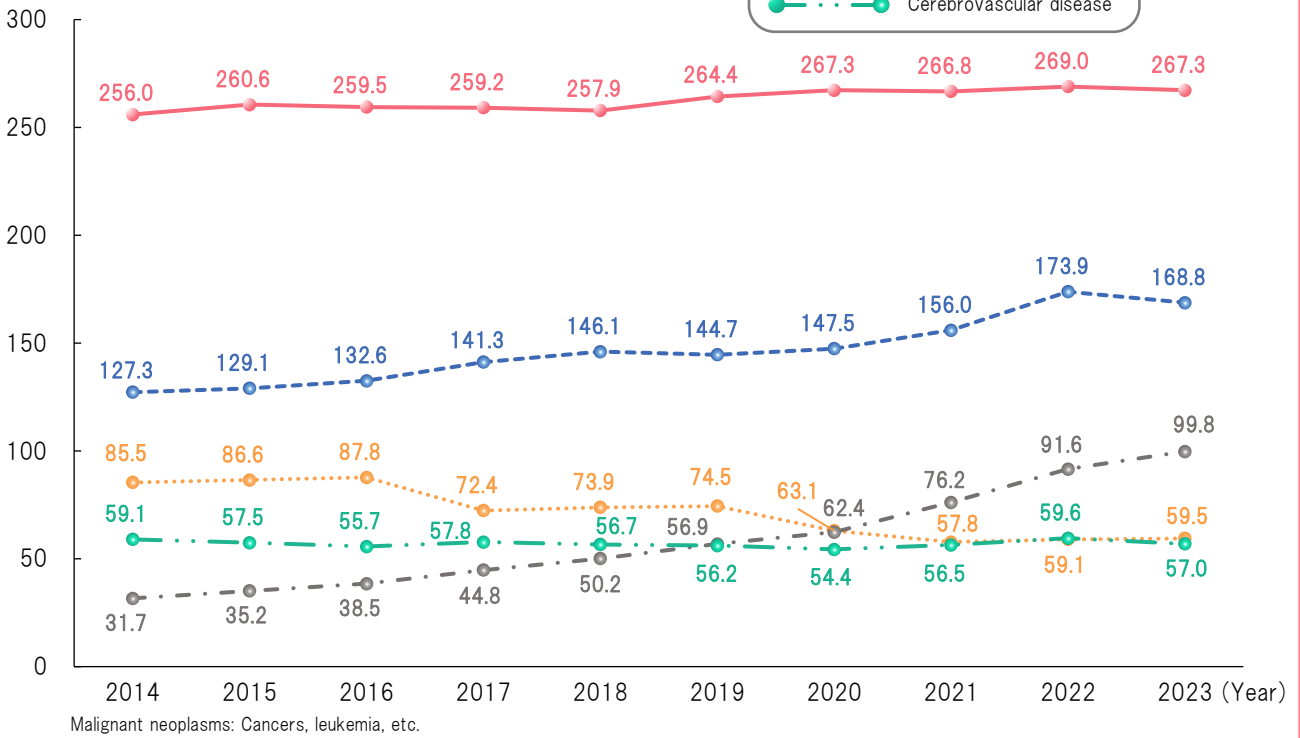

# Number of Deaths by Major Causes

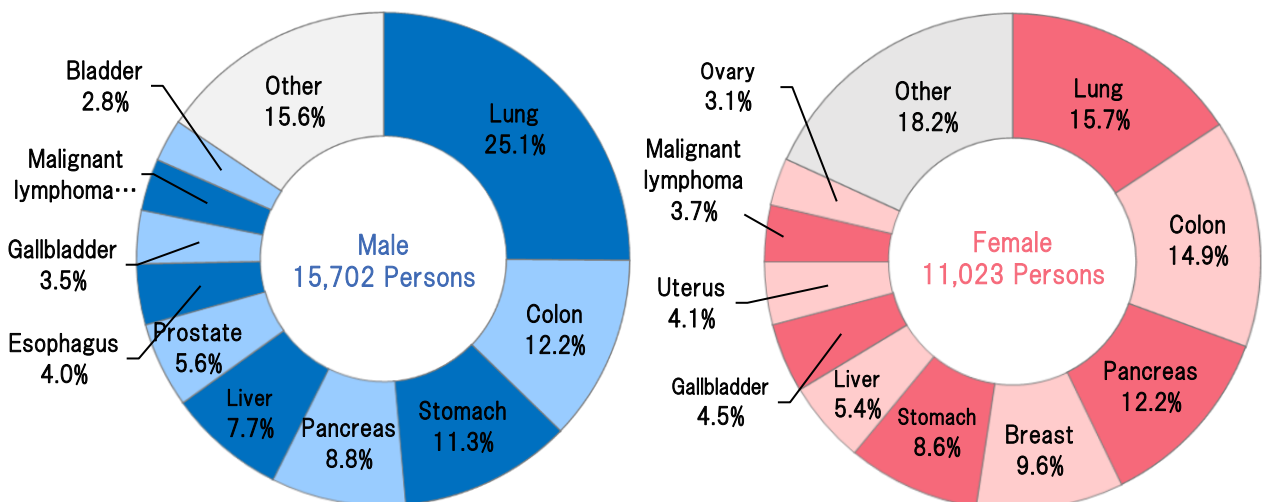

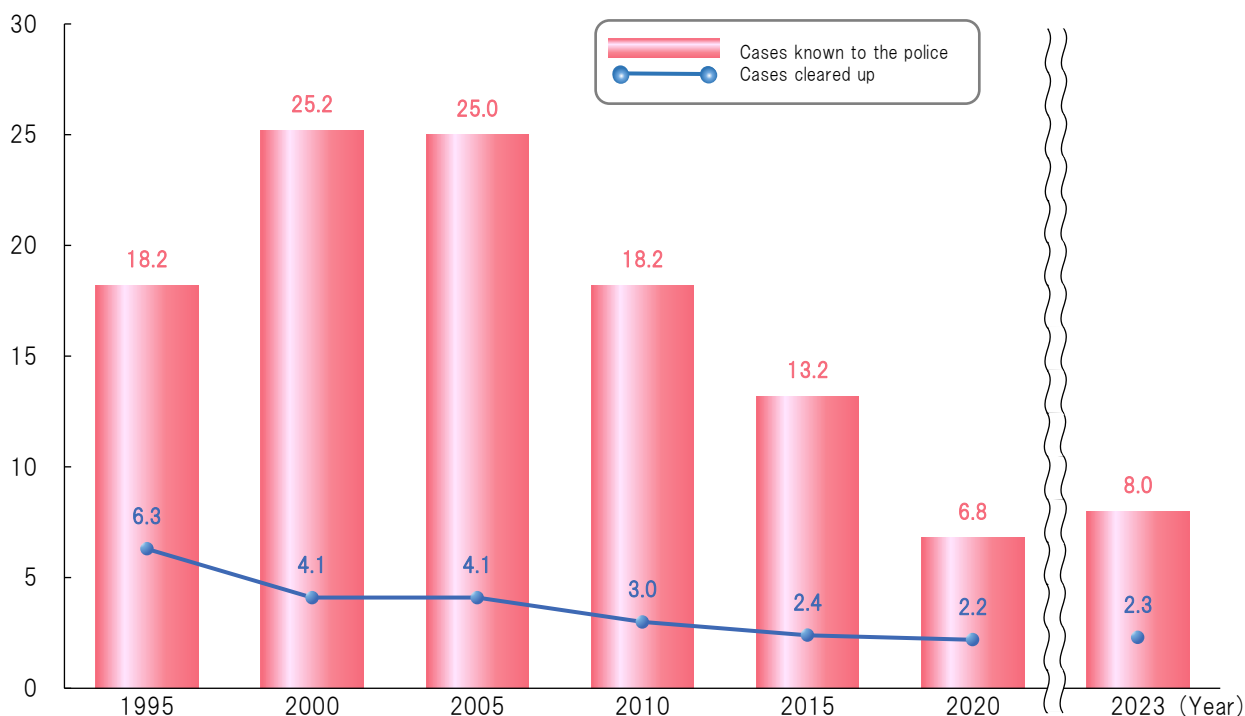

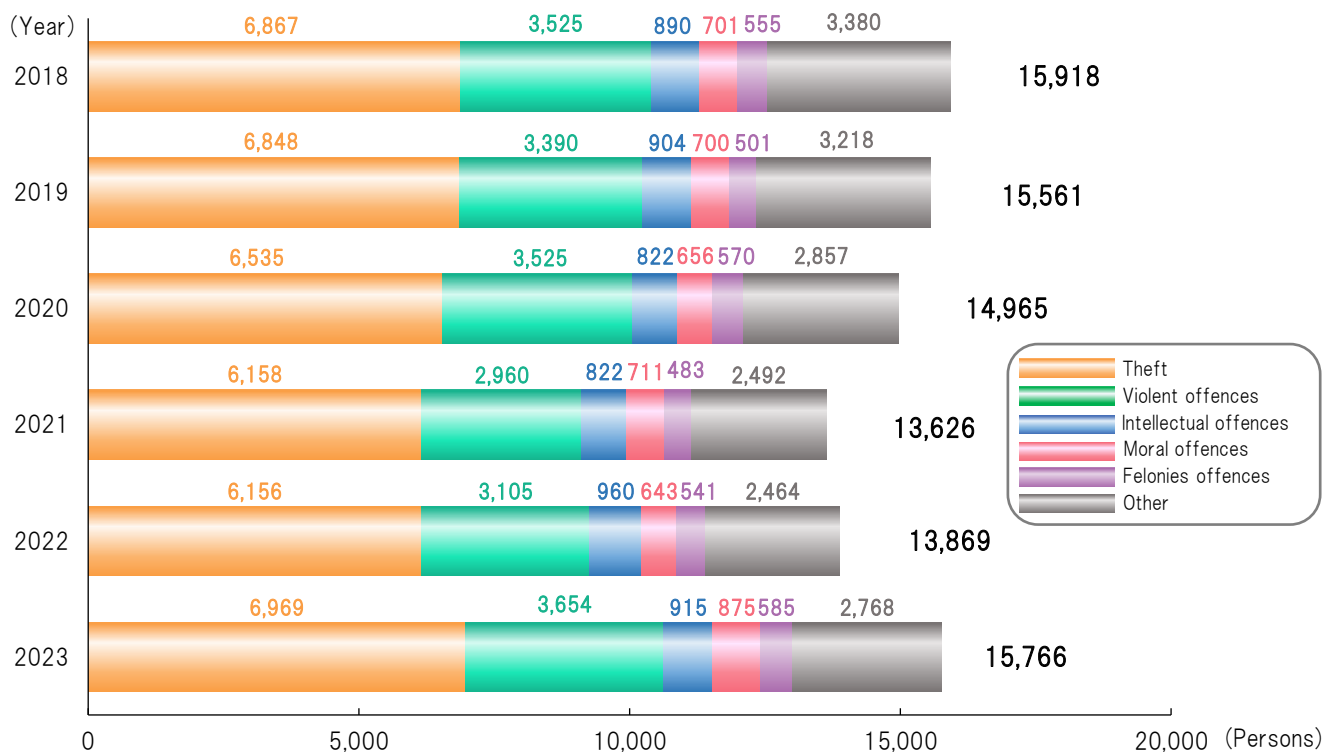

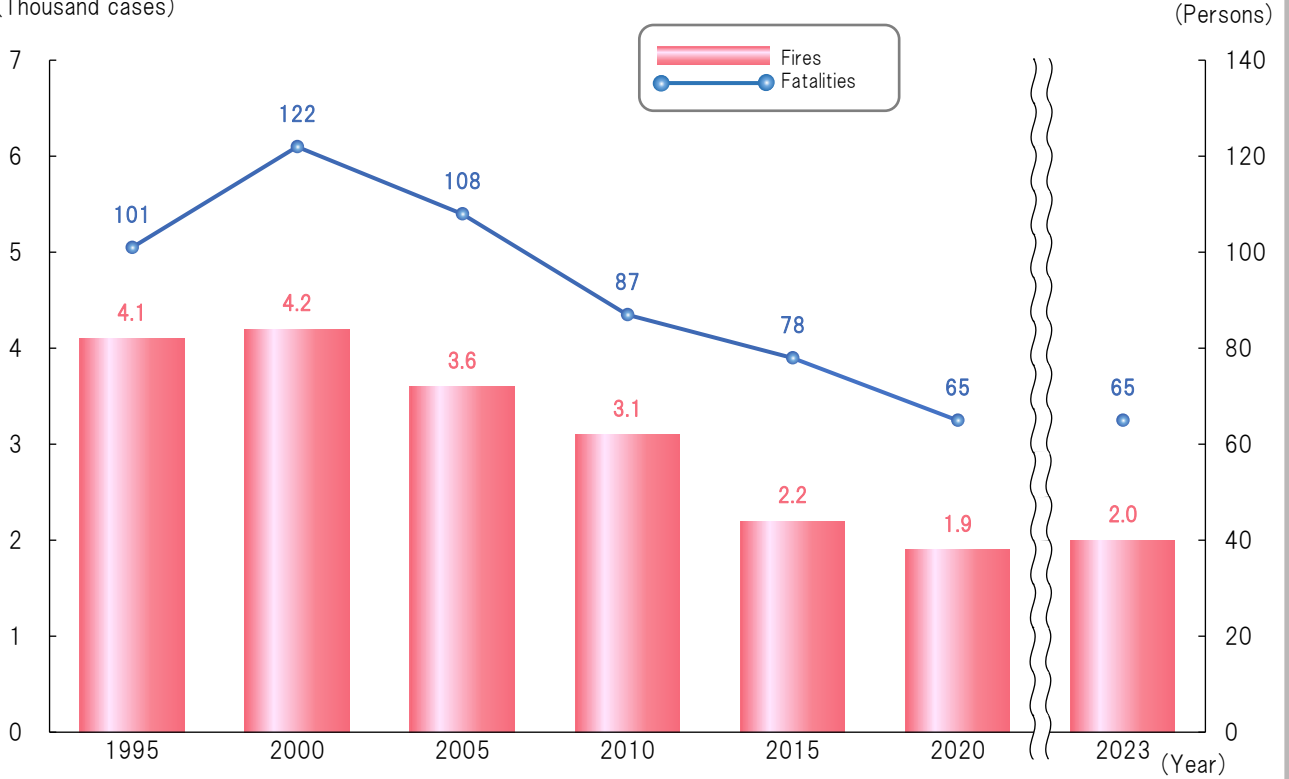

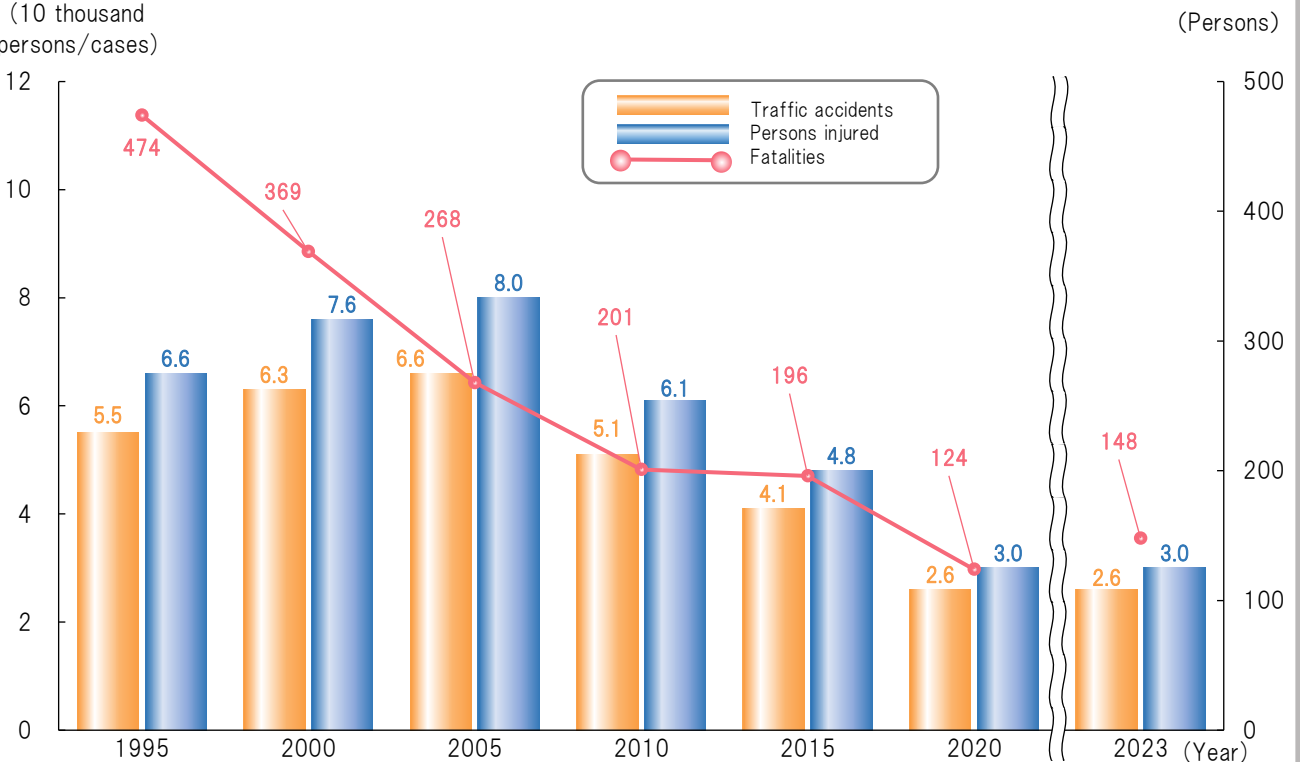
