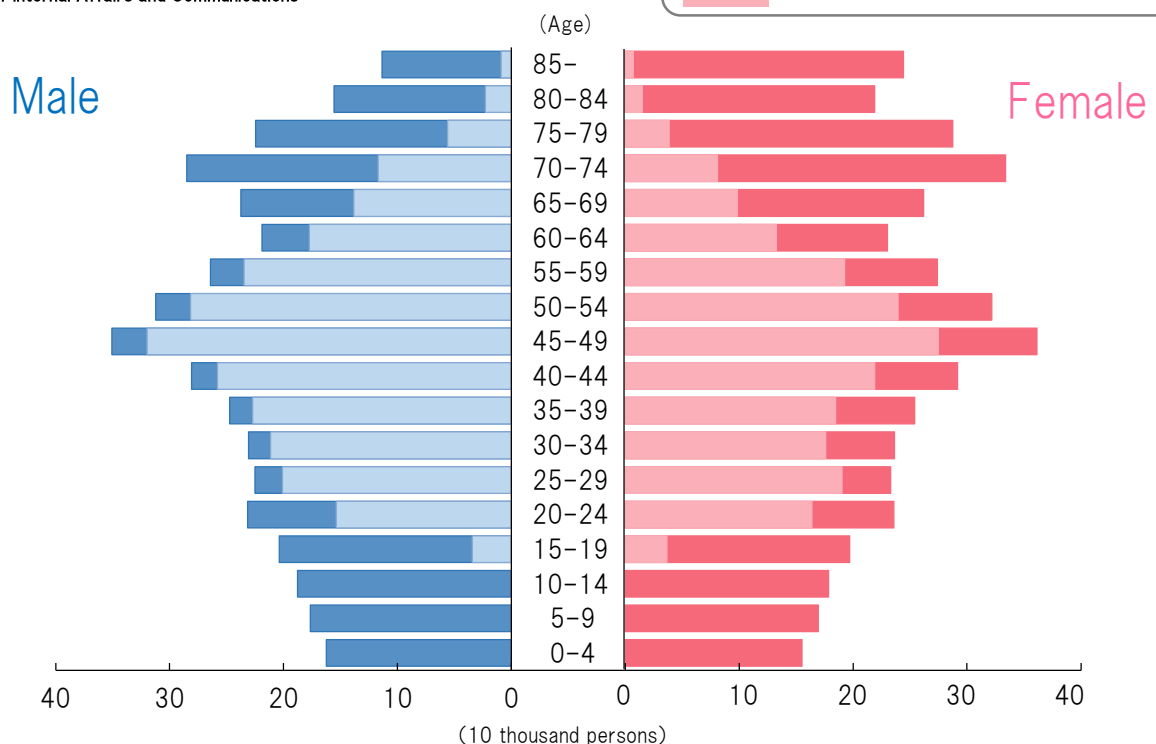
Notes

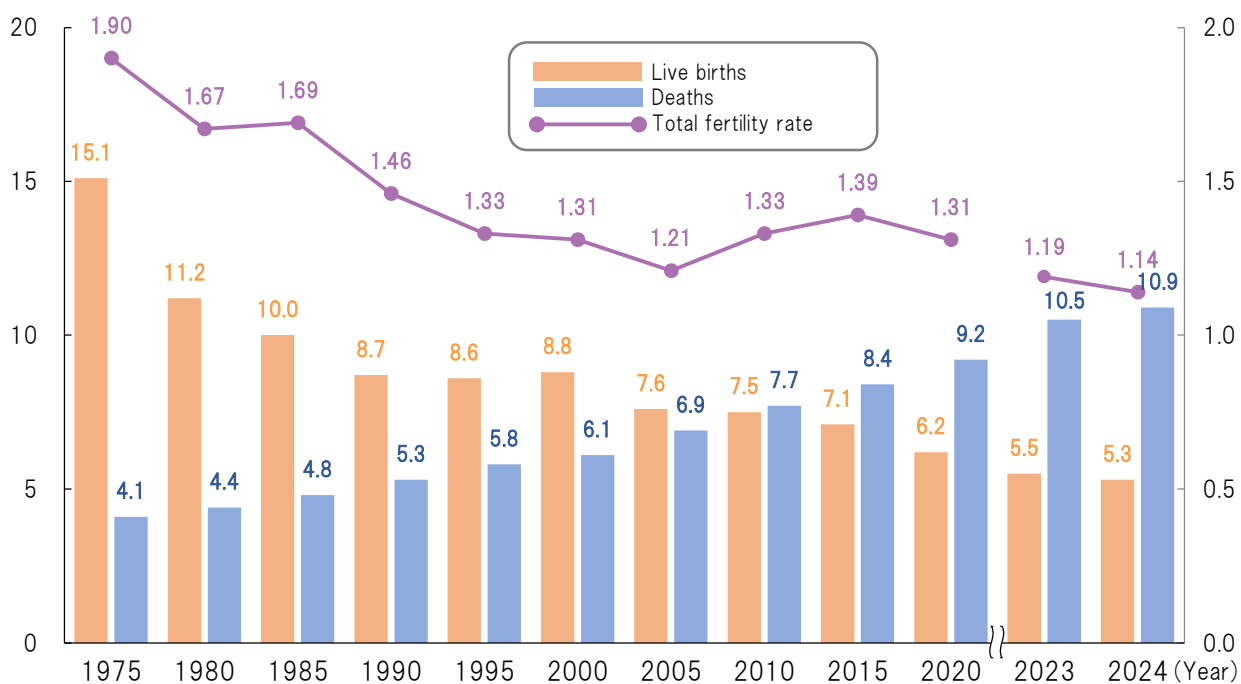

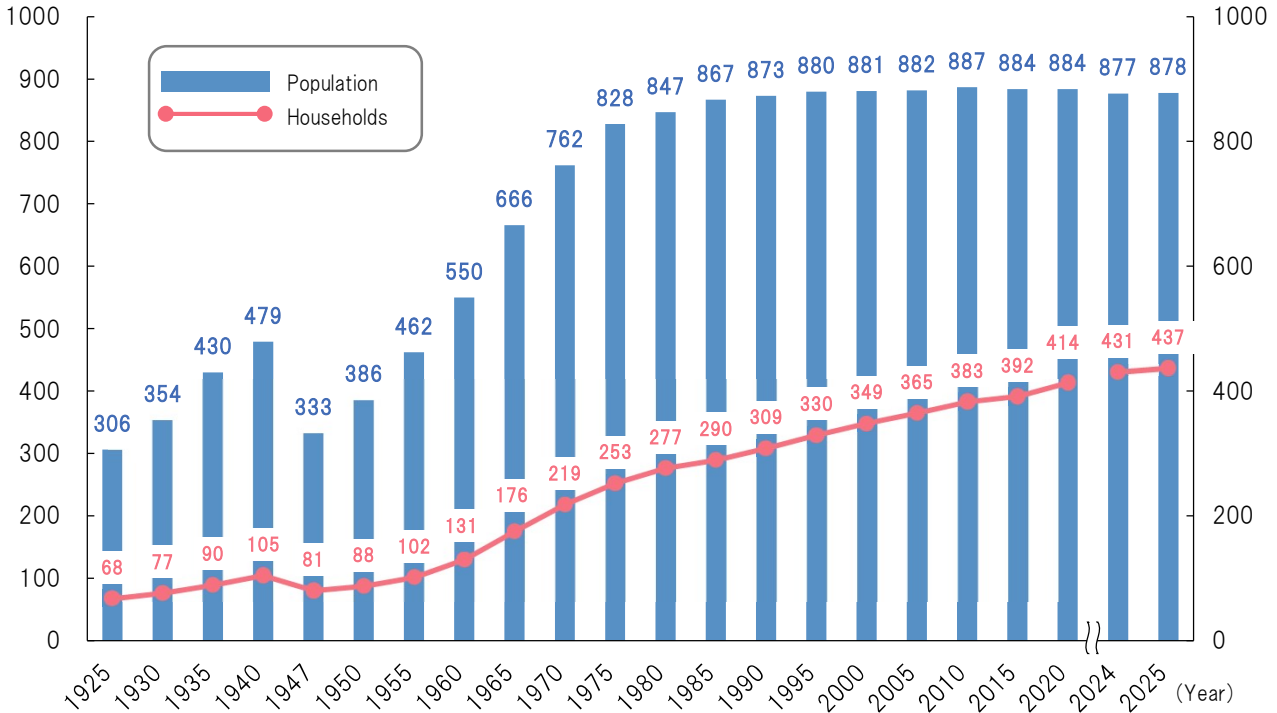

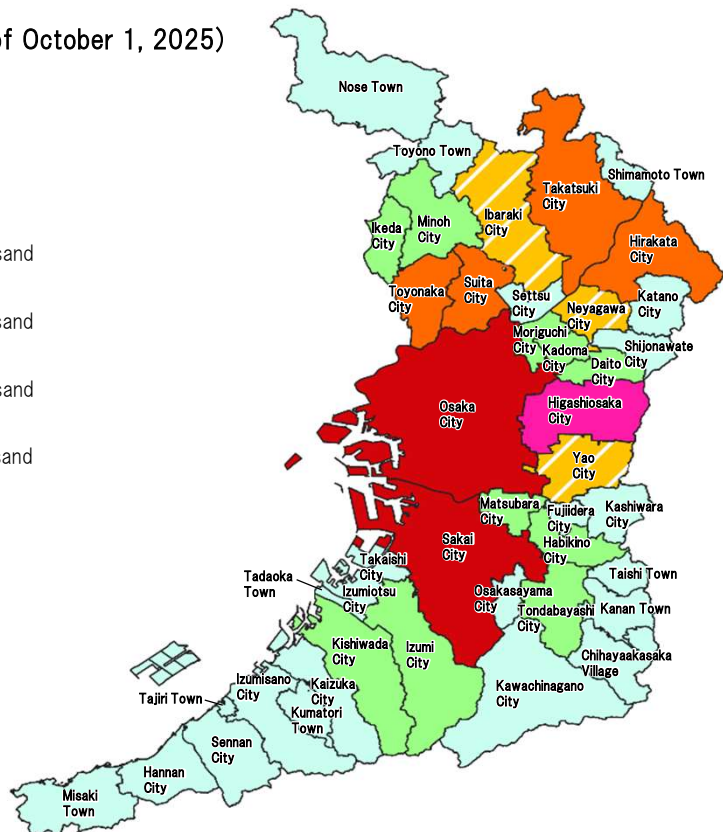
Regional Population in Osaka (As of October 1, 2025)

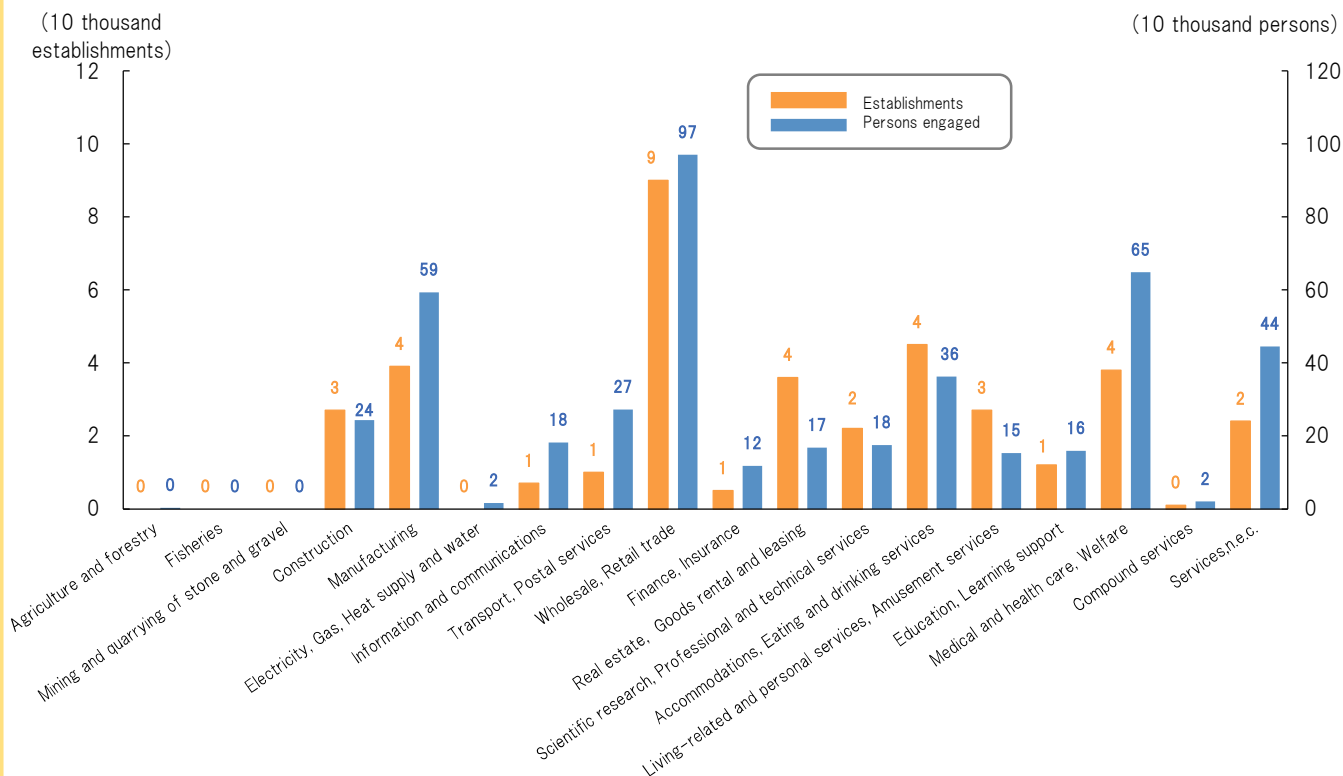

Privately-Owned Establishments and Persons Engaged by Industry Category (As of June 1, 2021)

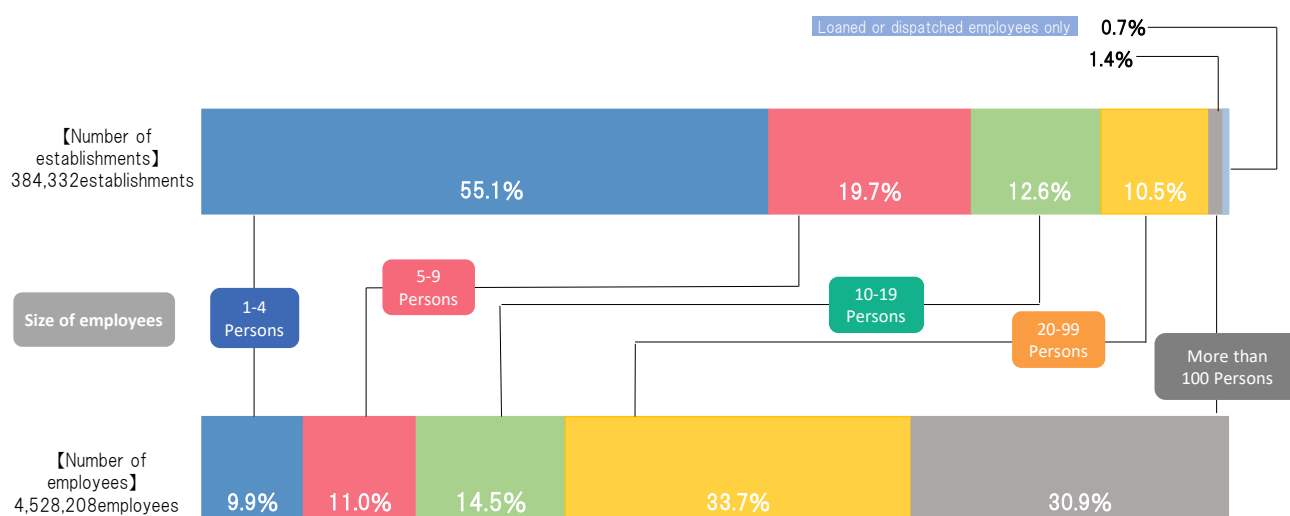

Composition Ratio of Number of Privately-Owned Establishments and Persons Engaged, by Size of Engaged People (As of June 1, 2021)

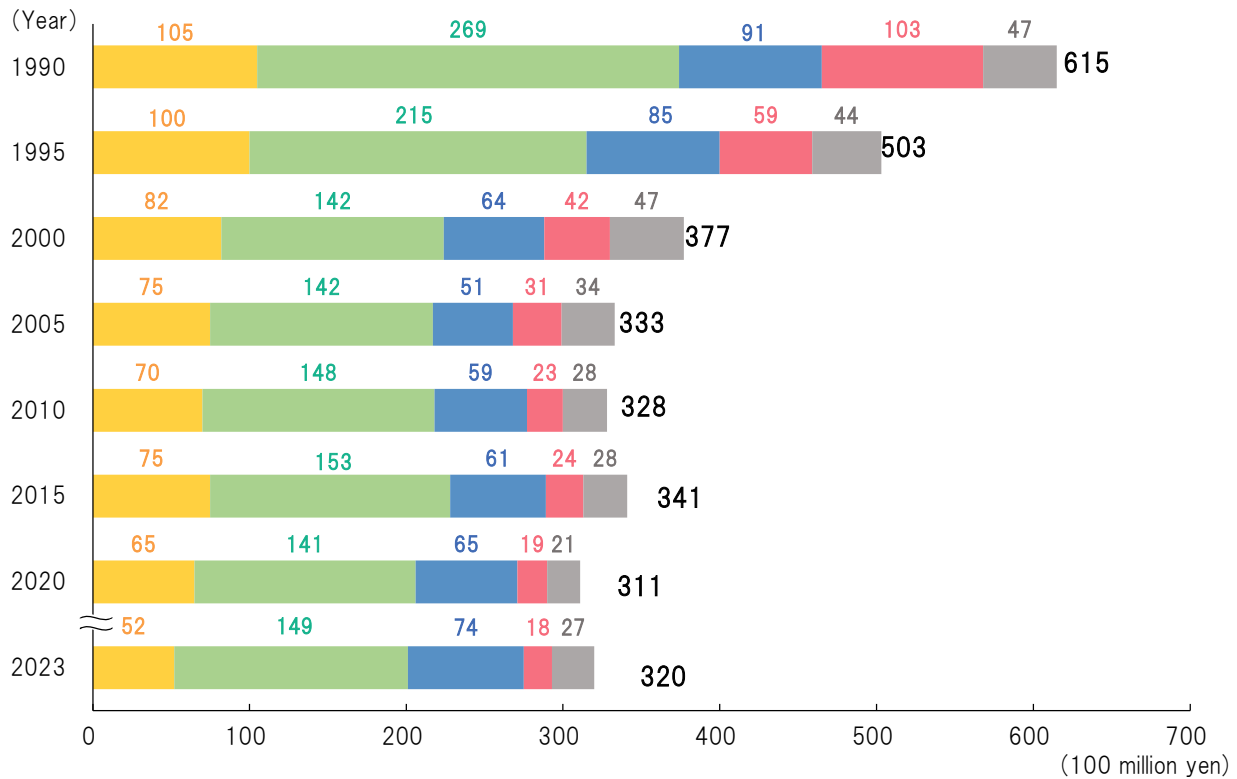

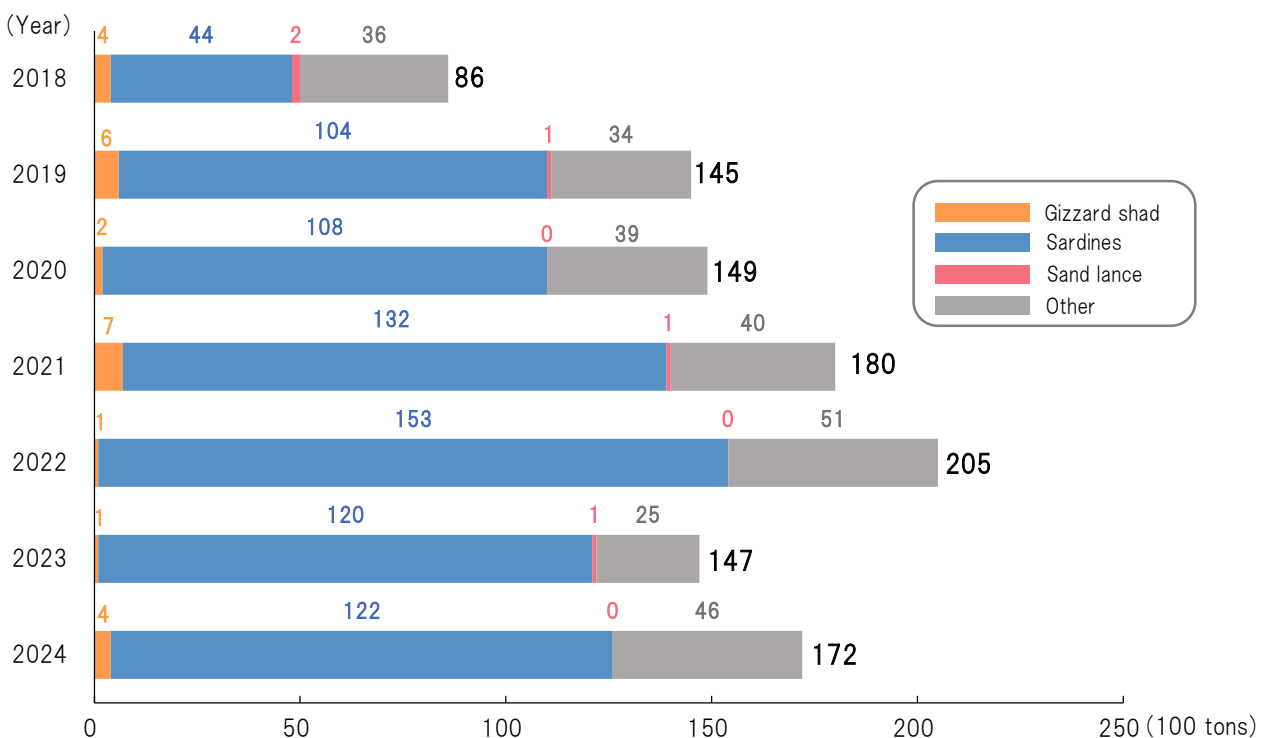

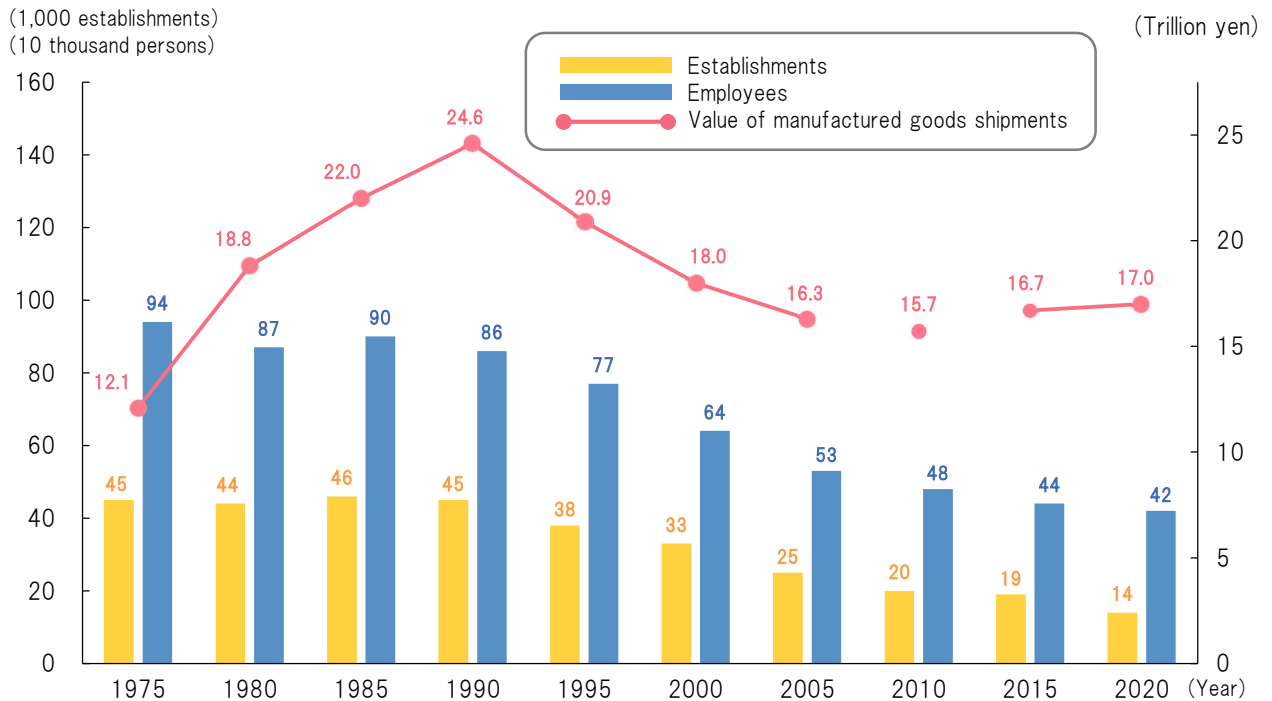

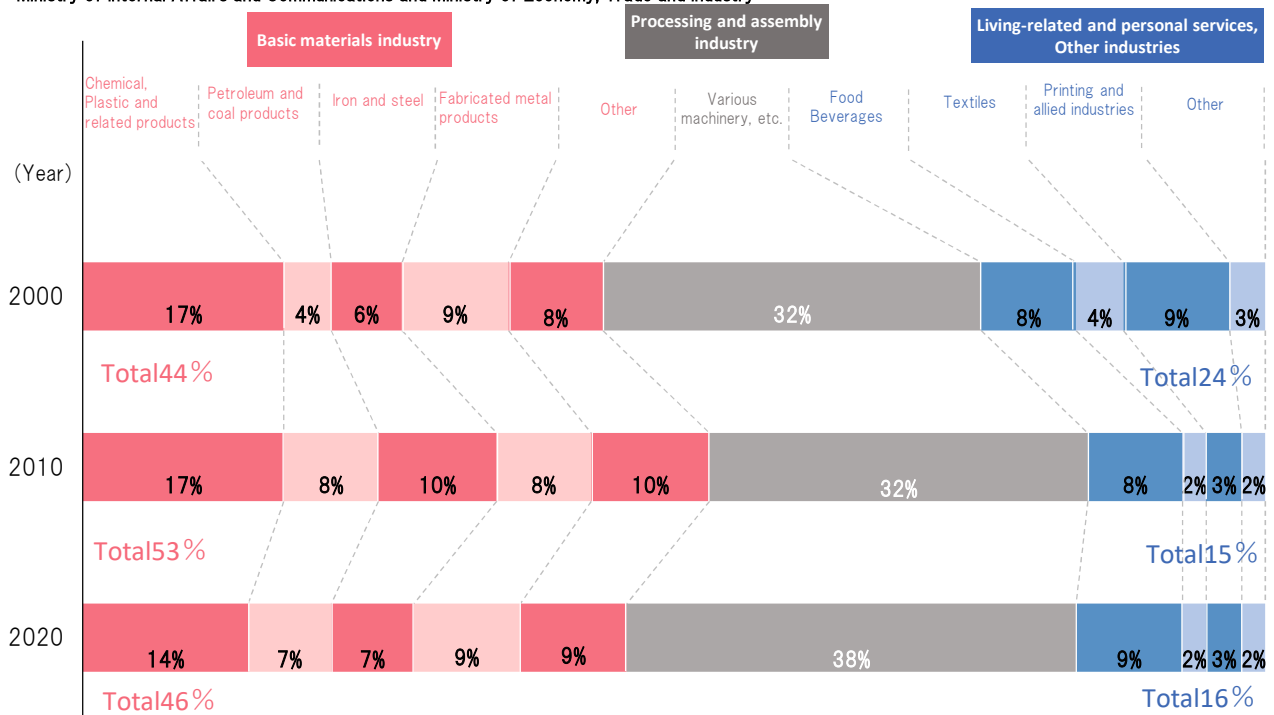

Composition Ratio of Value of Manufactured Goods Shipments by Industry (Four or More Employees)

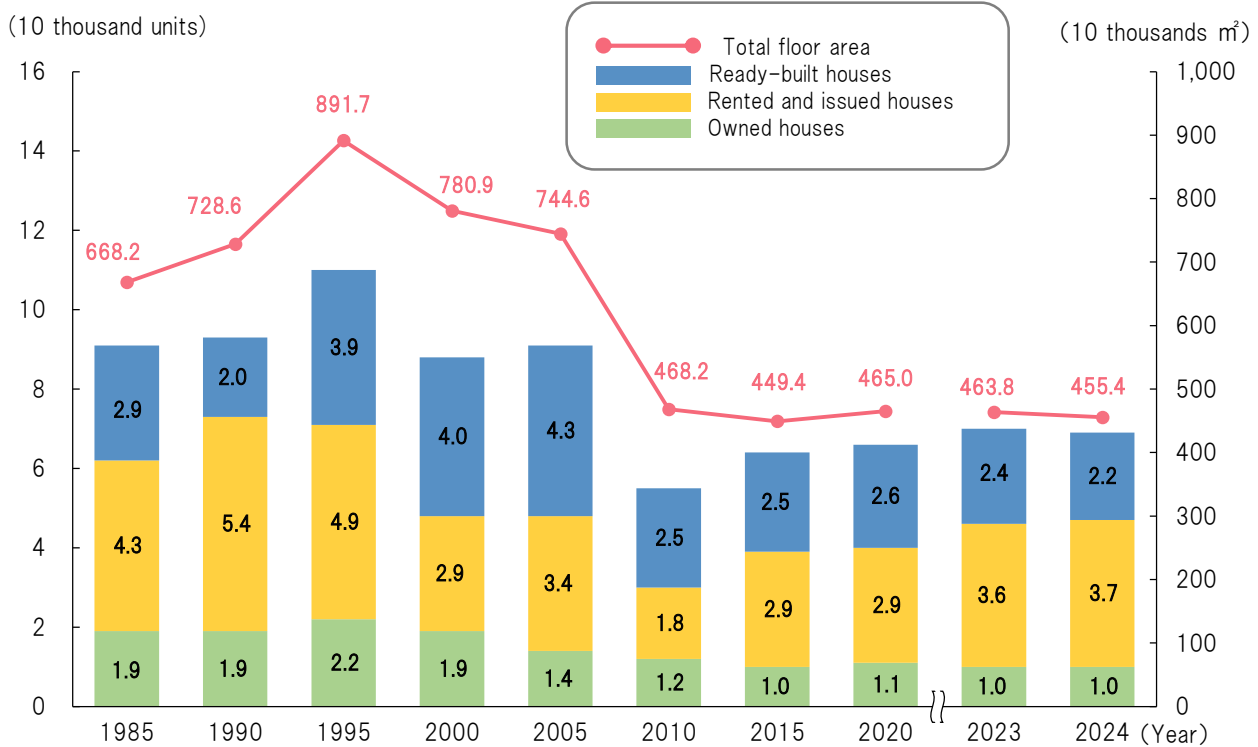

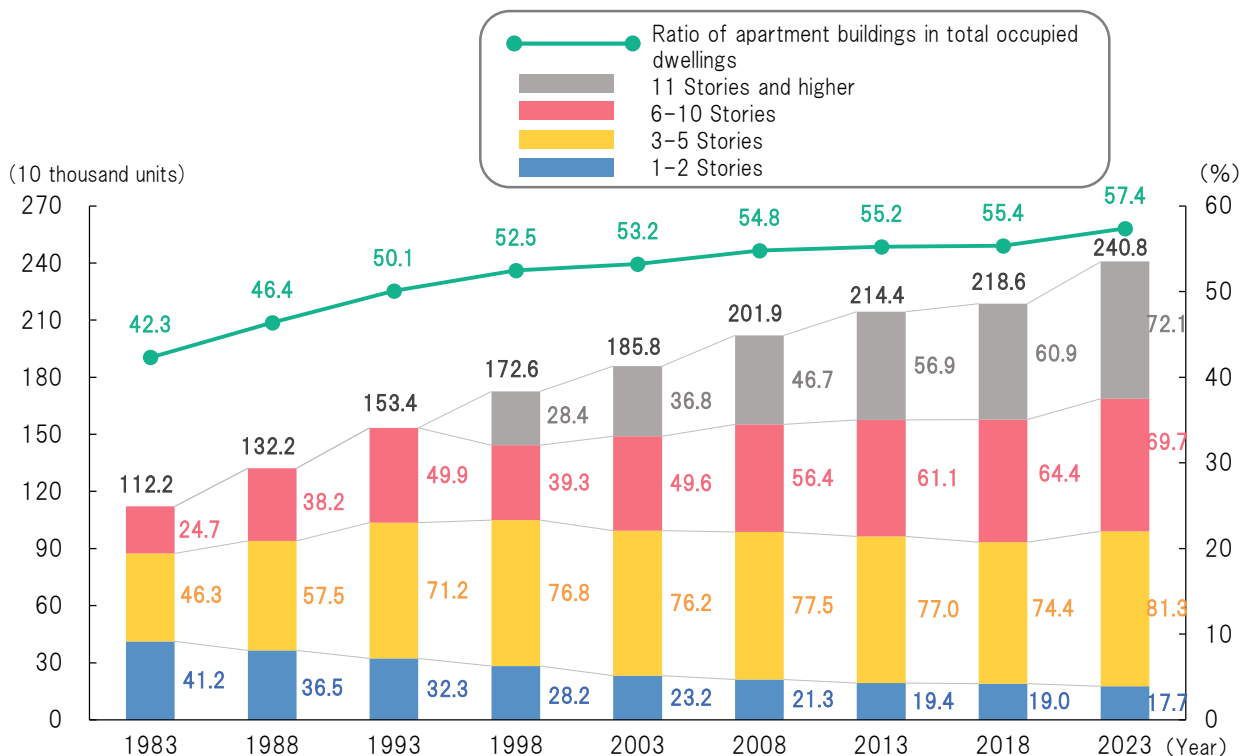

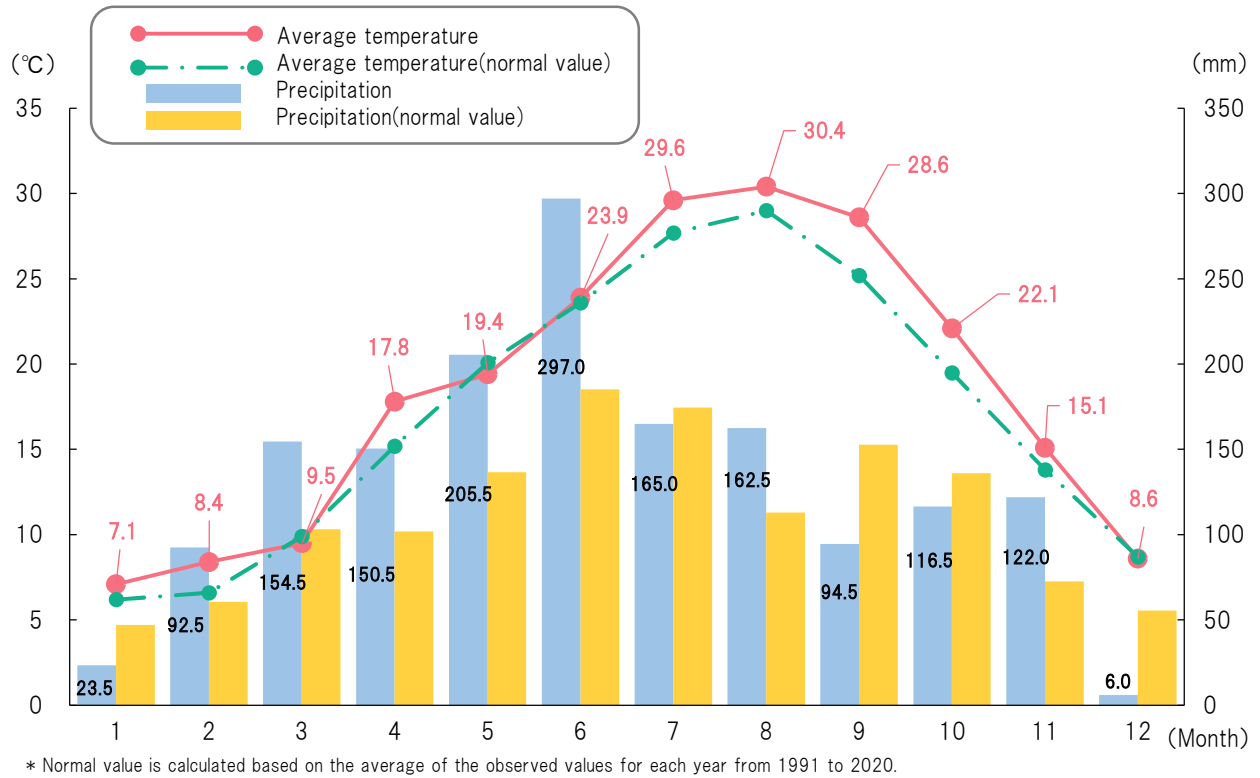

Average Temperature and Precipitation (2024 and Normal year)

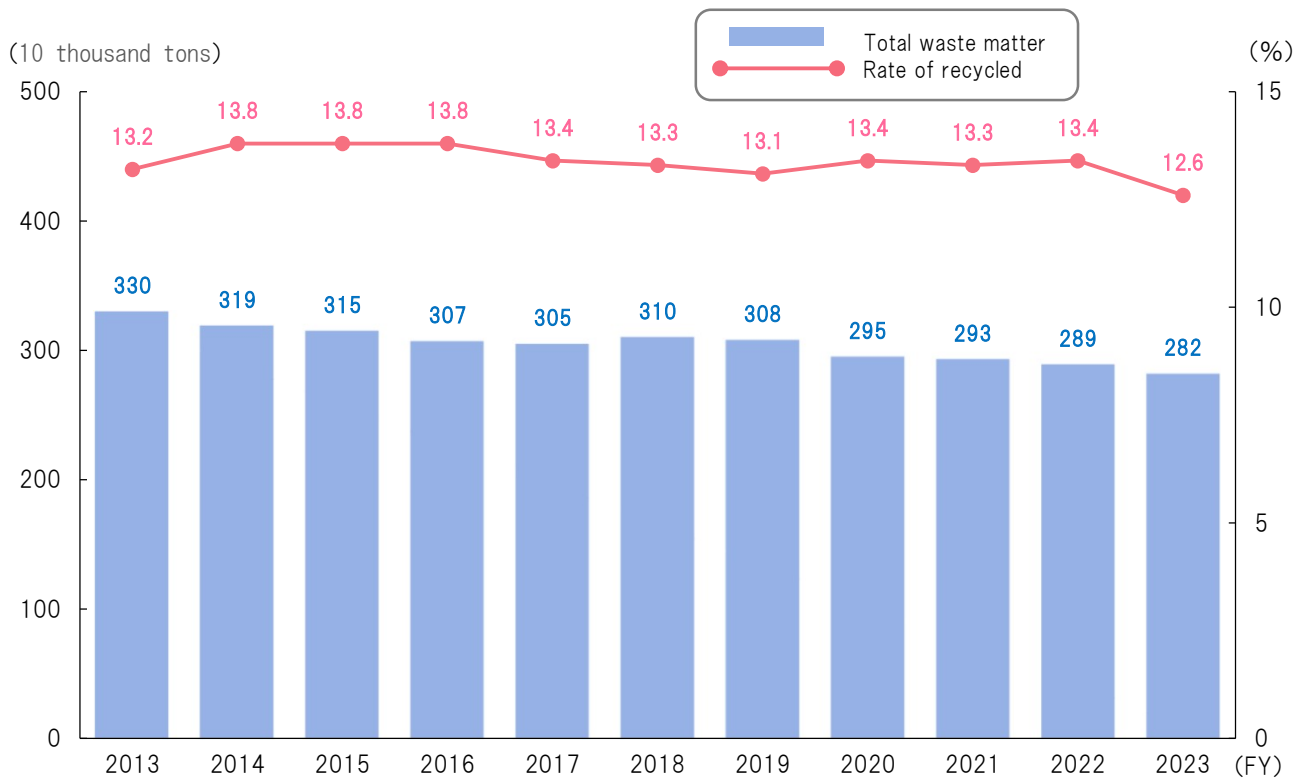

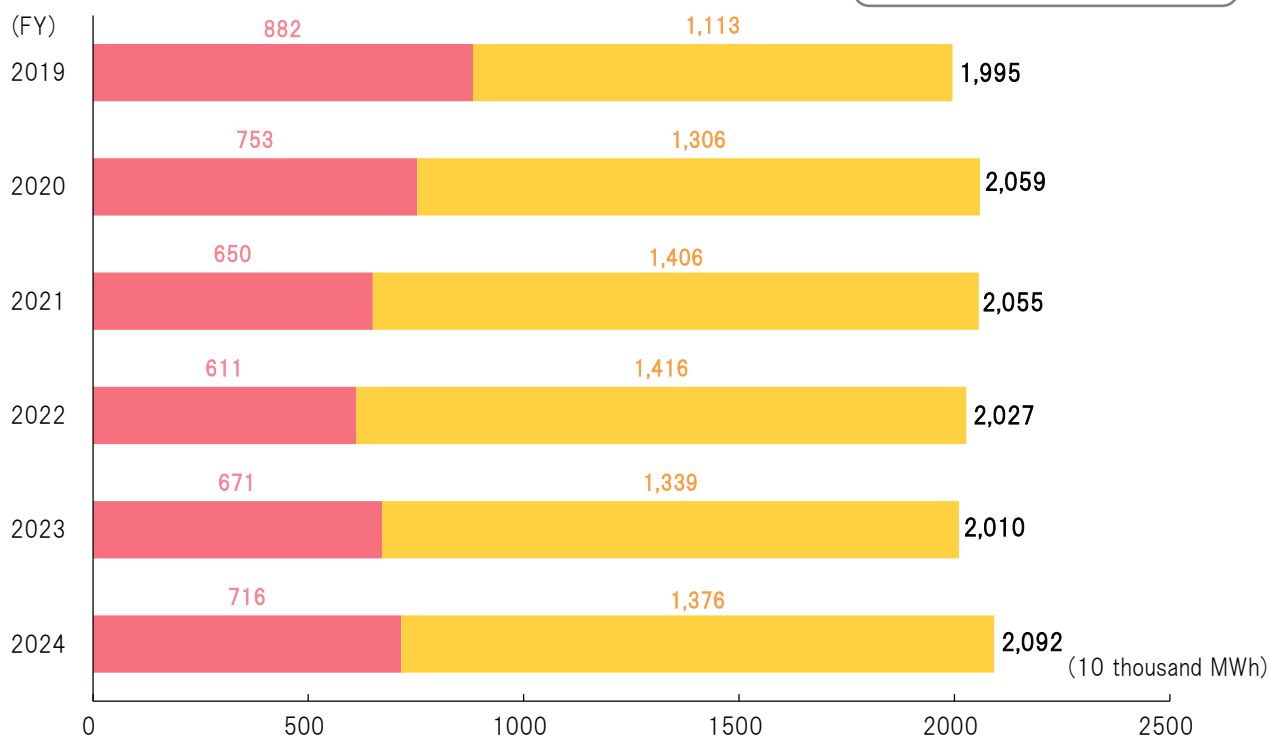
Total Amount of Waste Disposal and Rate of Recycle

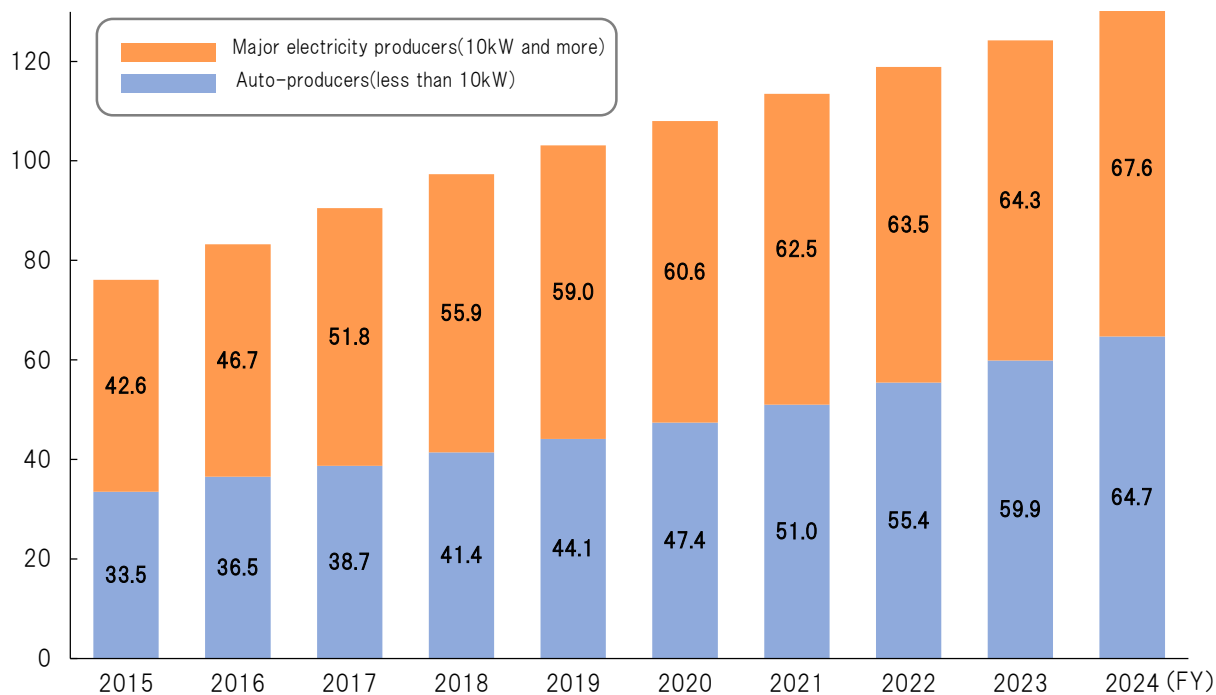

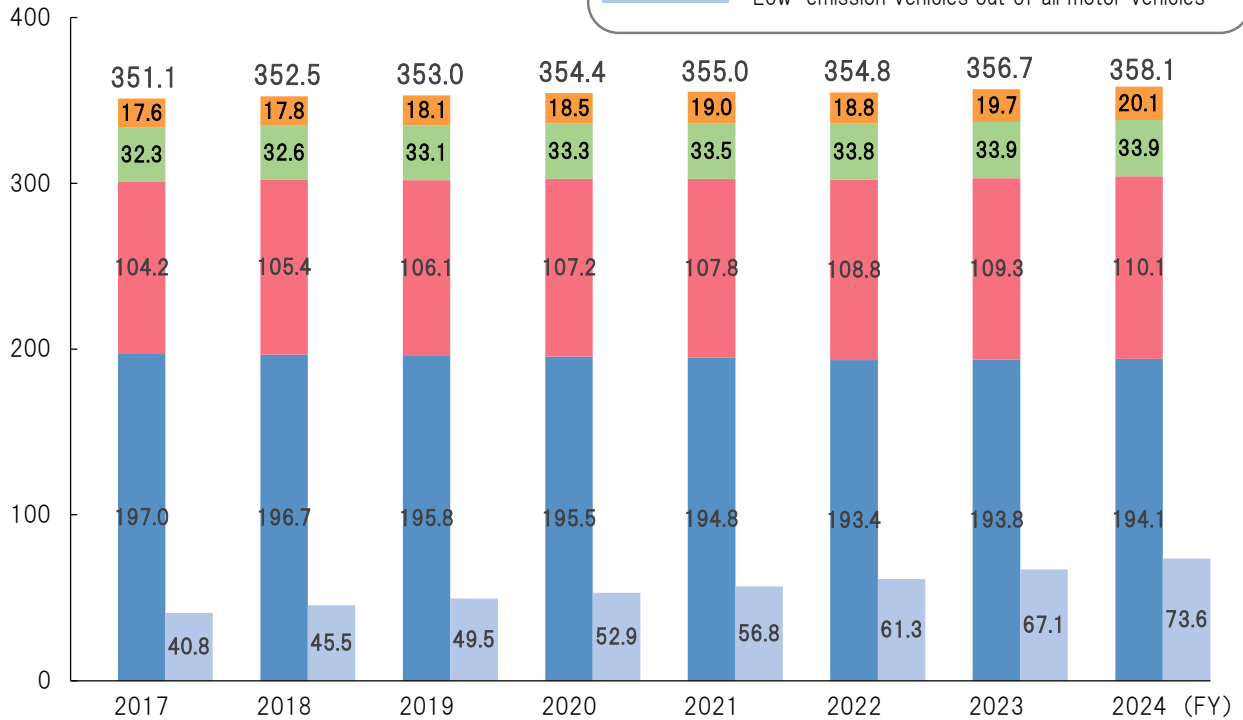

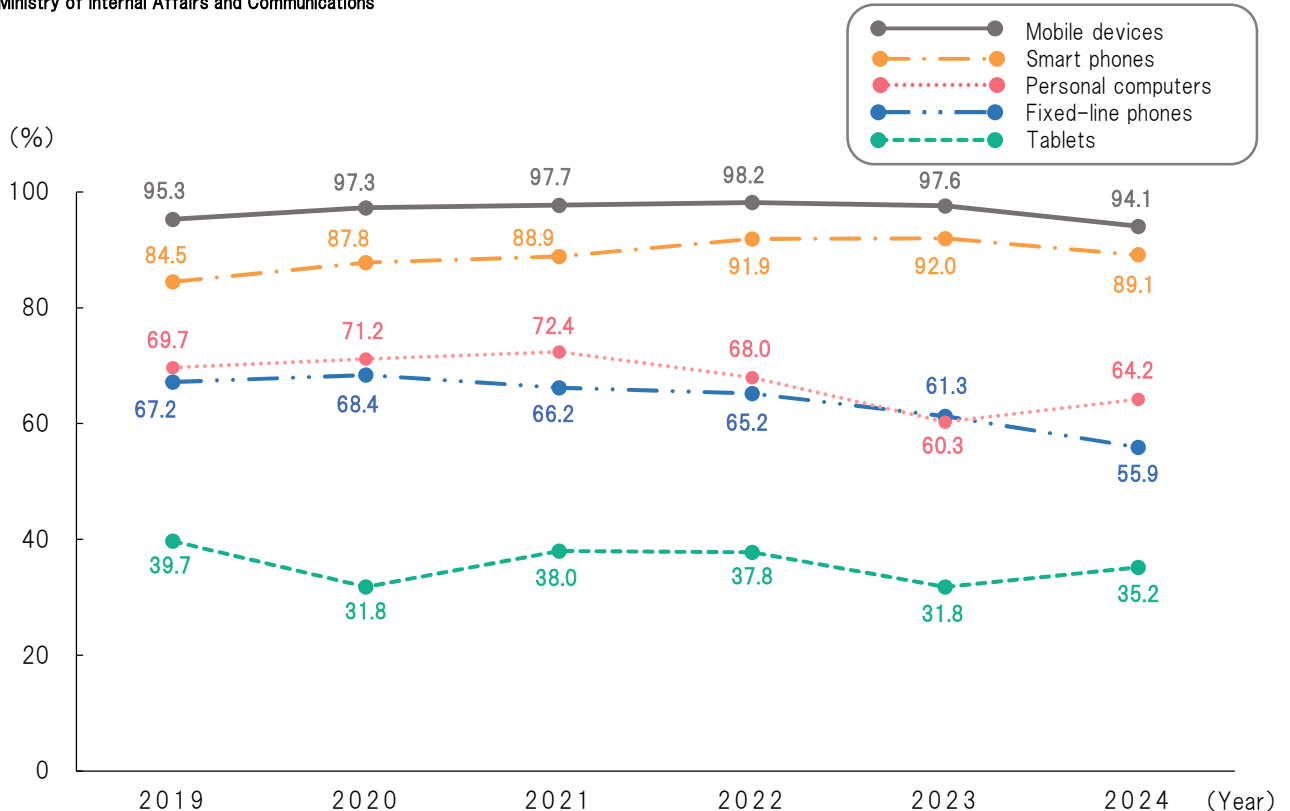

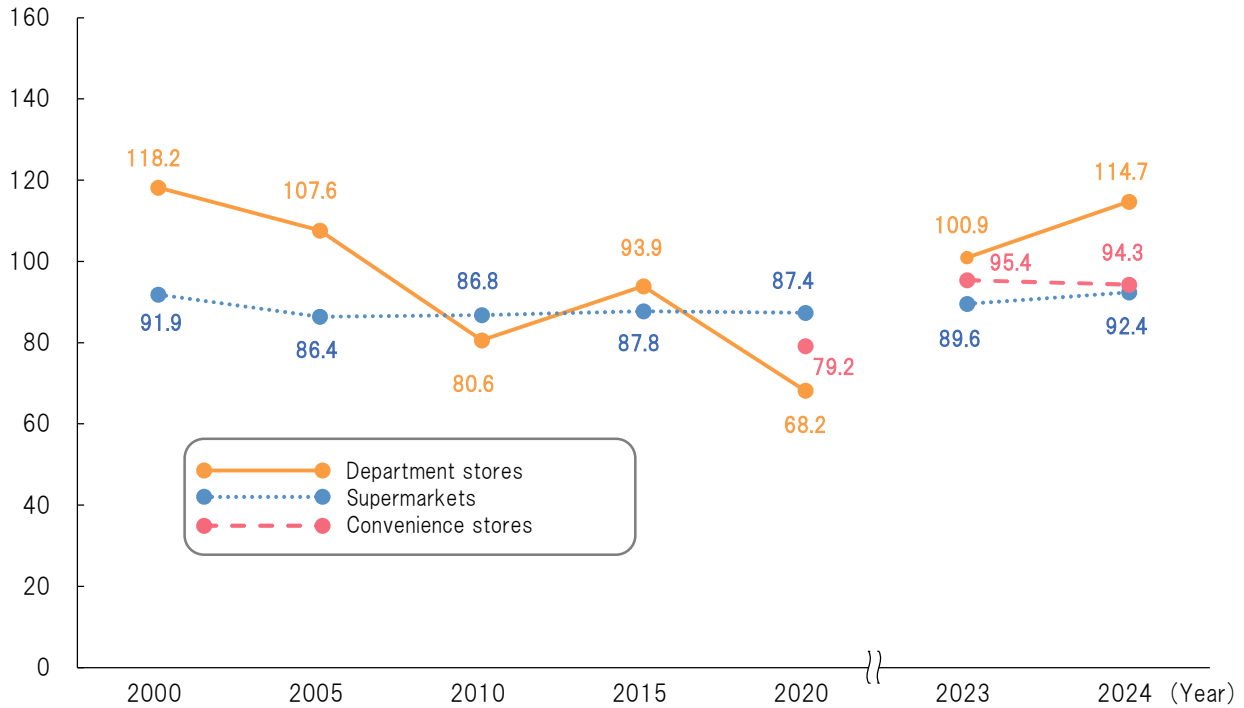

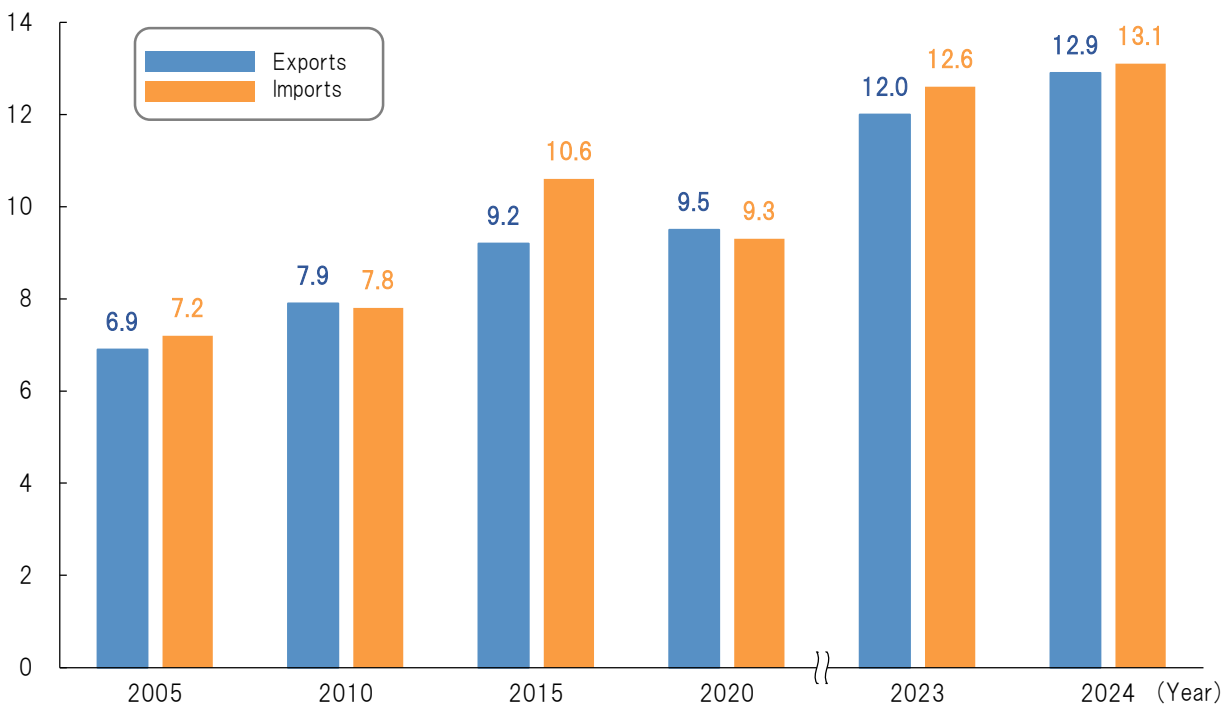

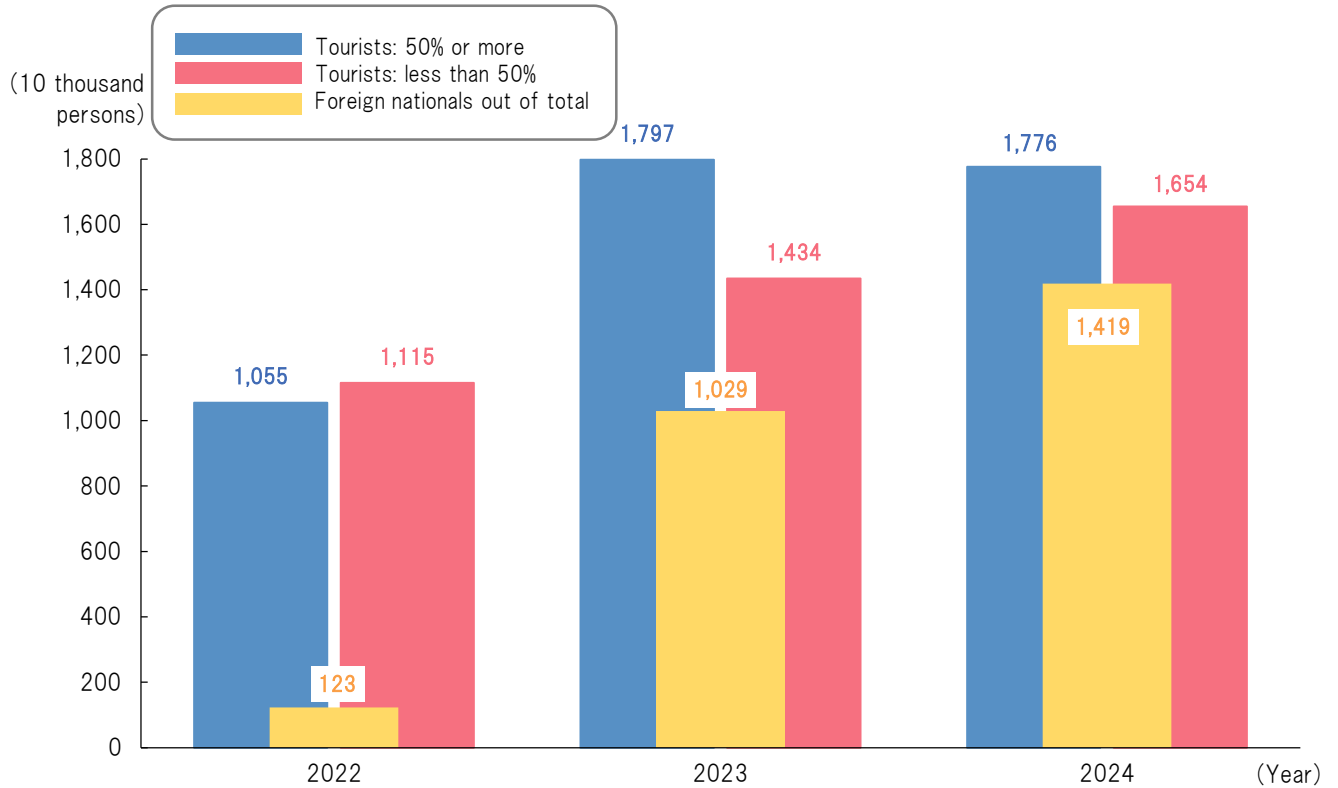

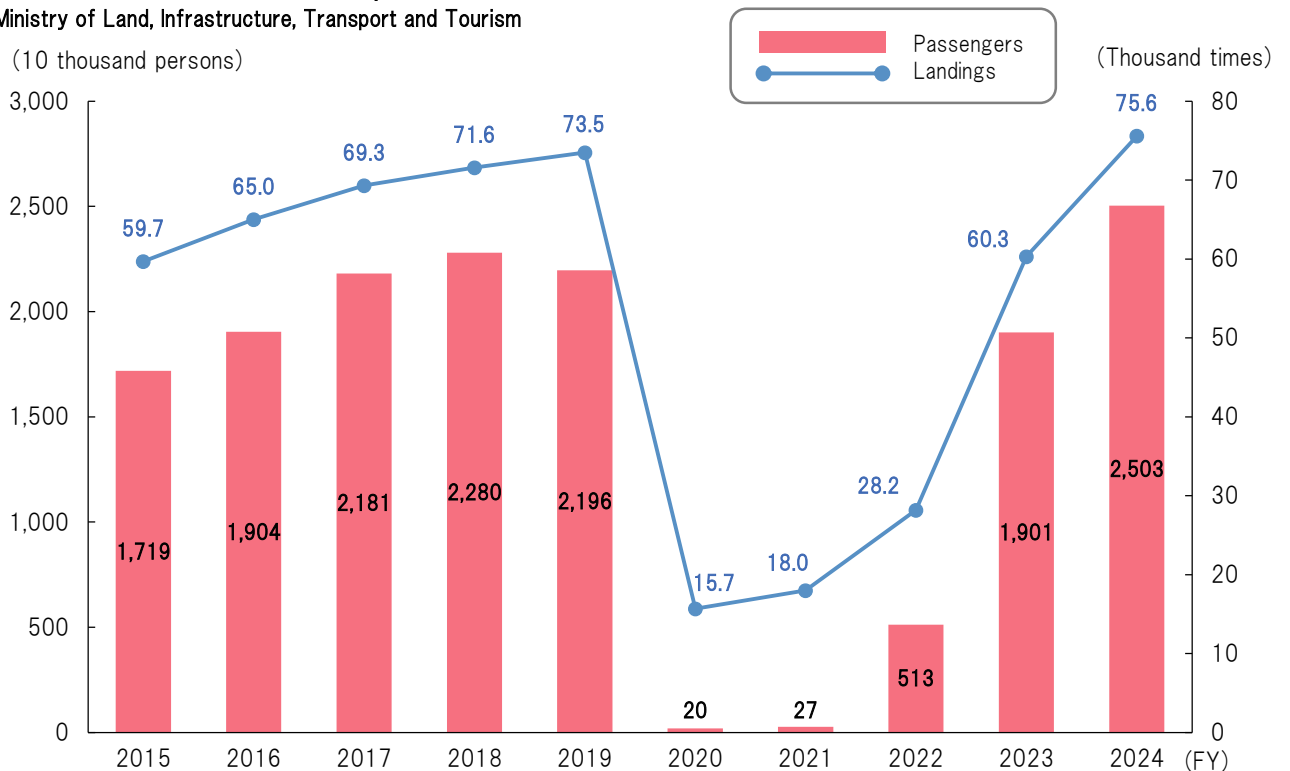

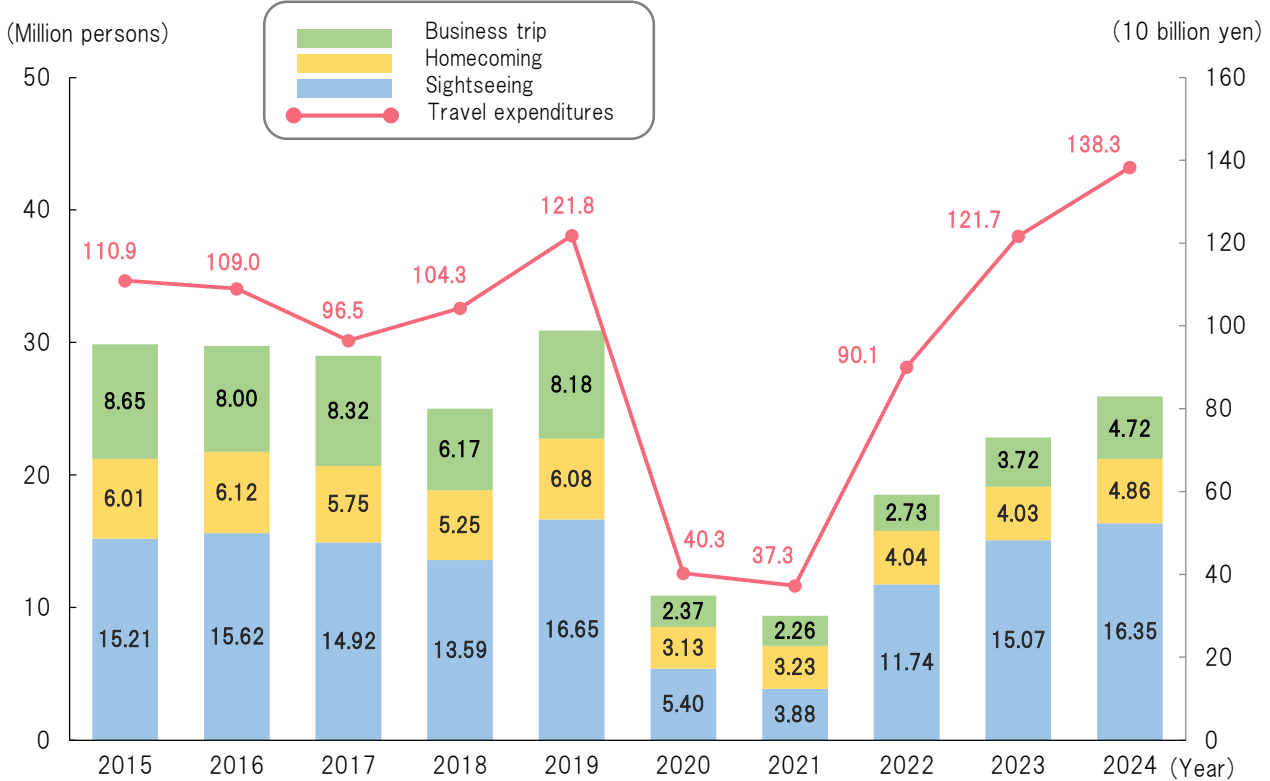

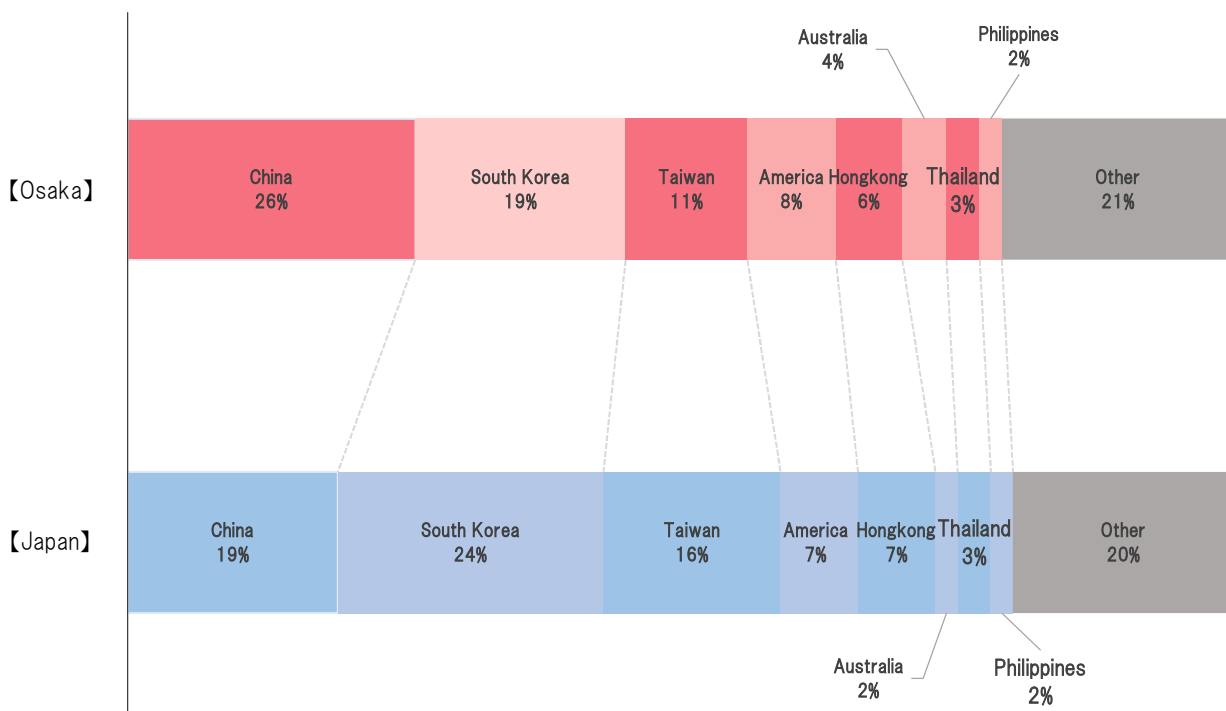
Number of Travelers by Purpose and Travel Expenditures (Domestic Travels)

Visitor Arrivals by Nationality (2024)

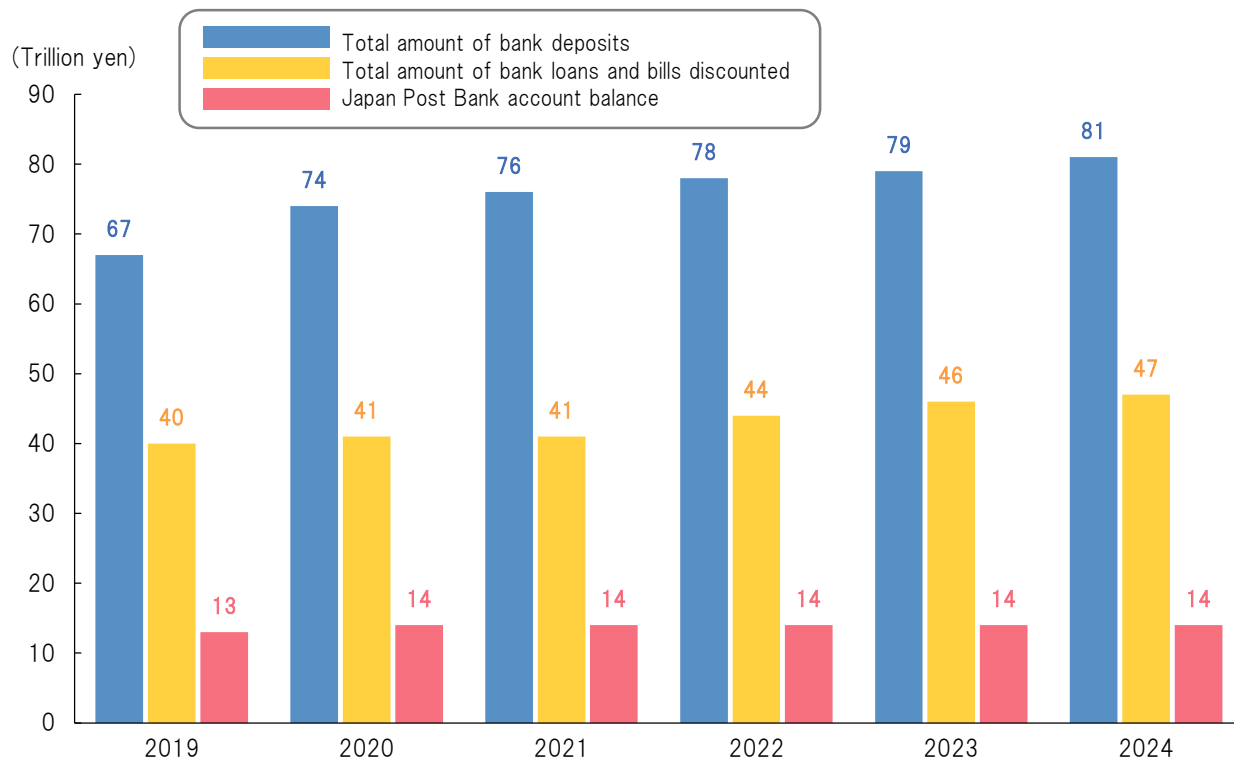

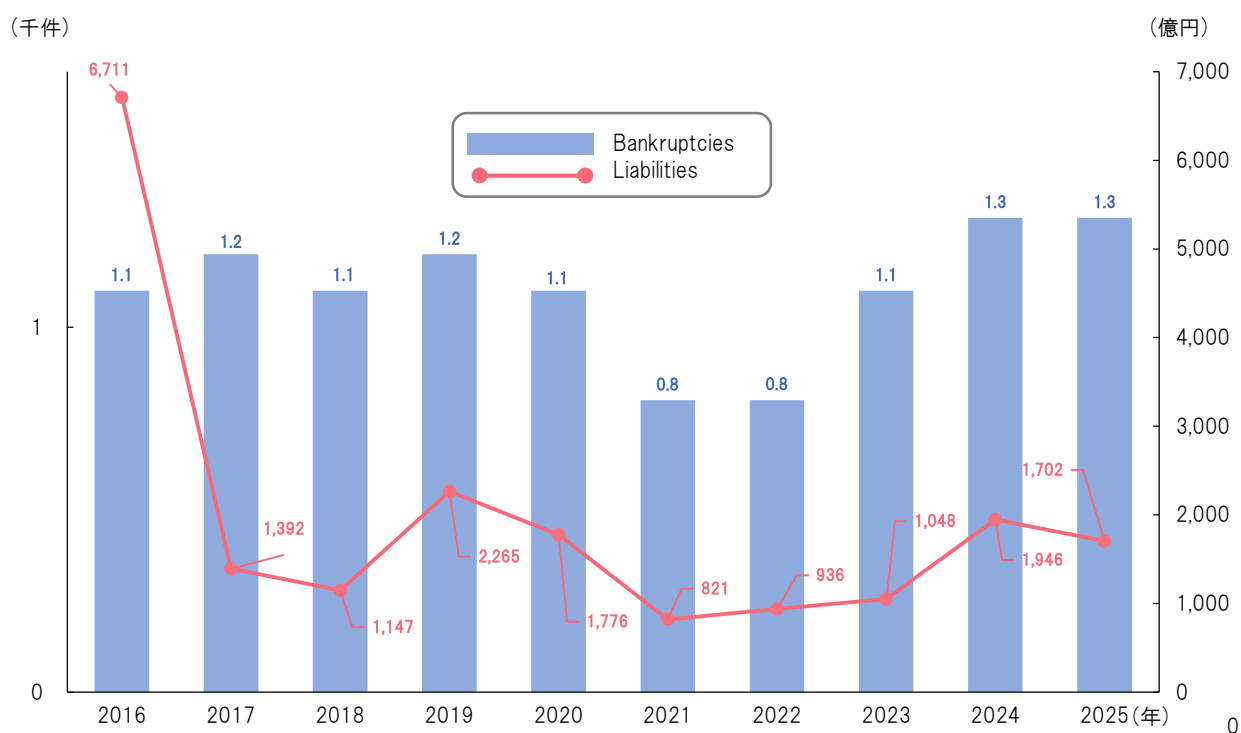

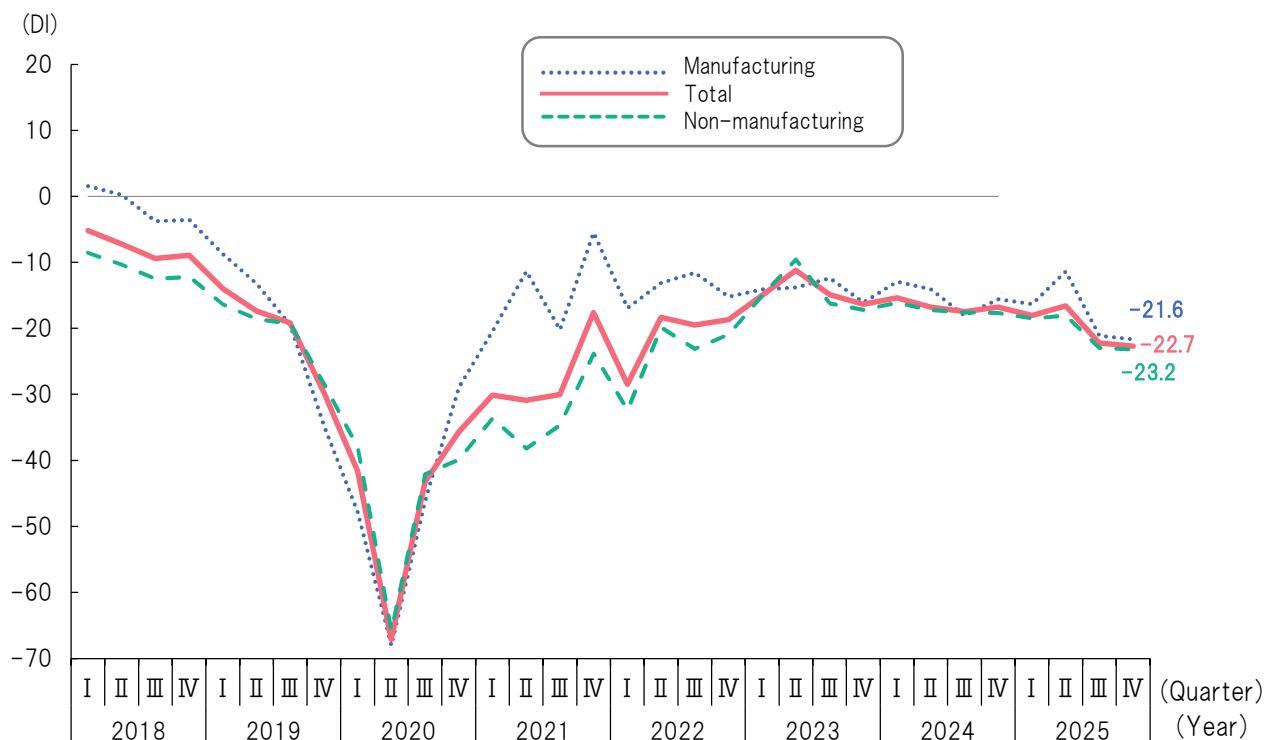

Diffusion Index of Business Conditions (Period-Over-Period, Seasonally Adjusted, By Manufacturer or Non-Manufacturer)

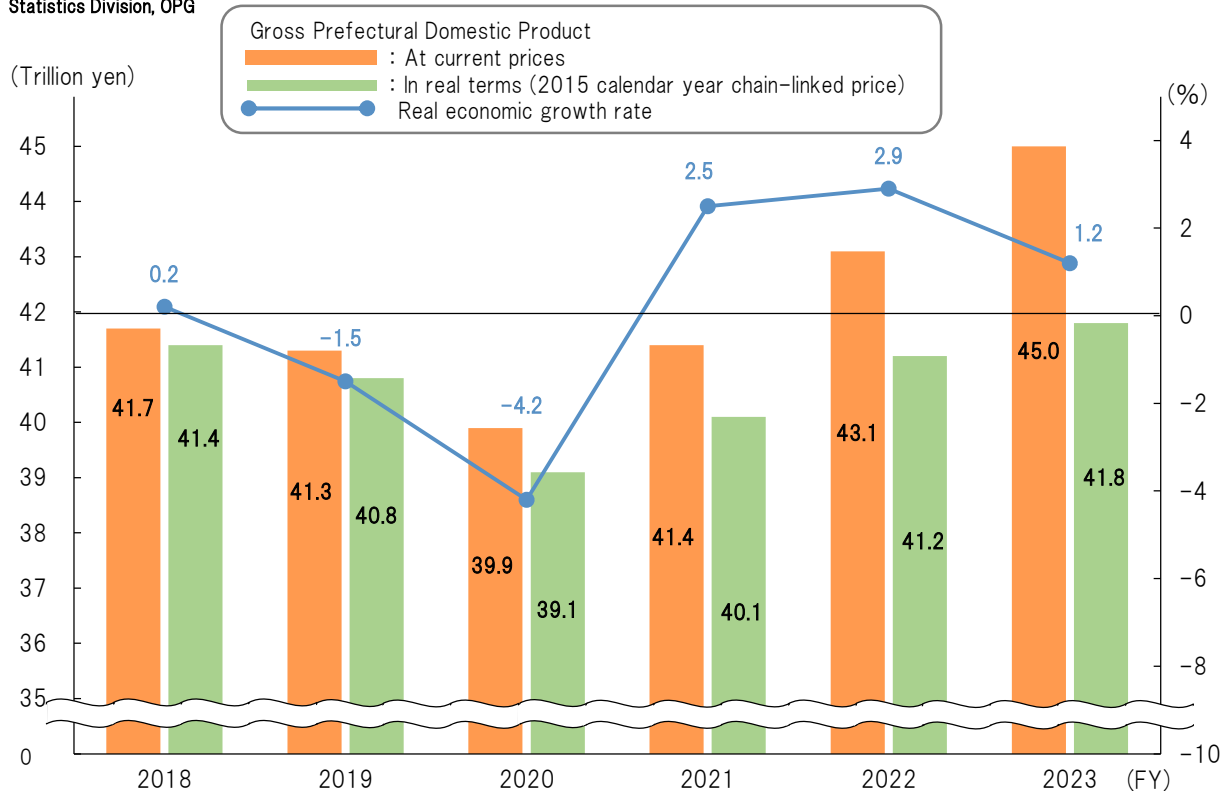

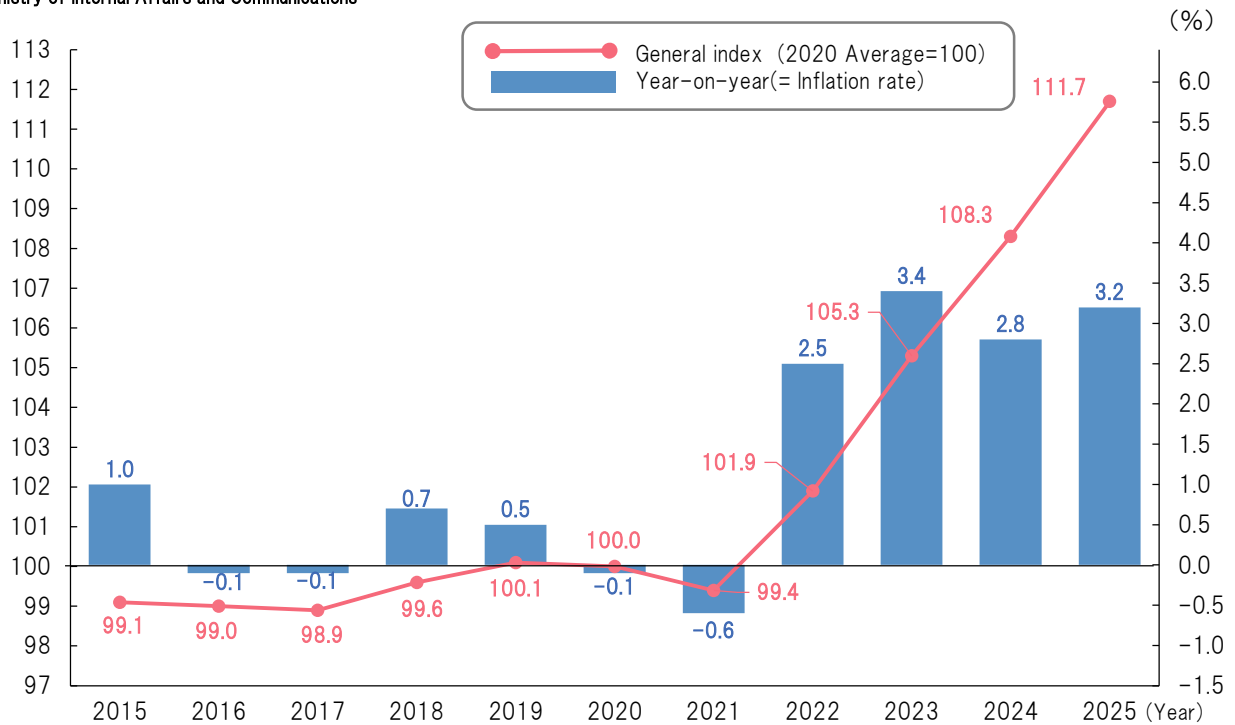

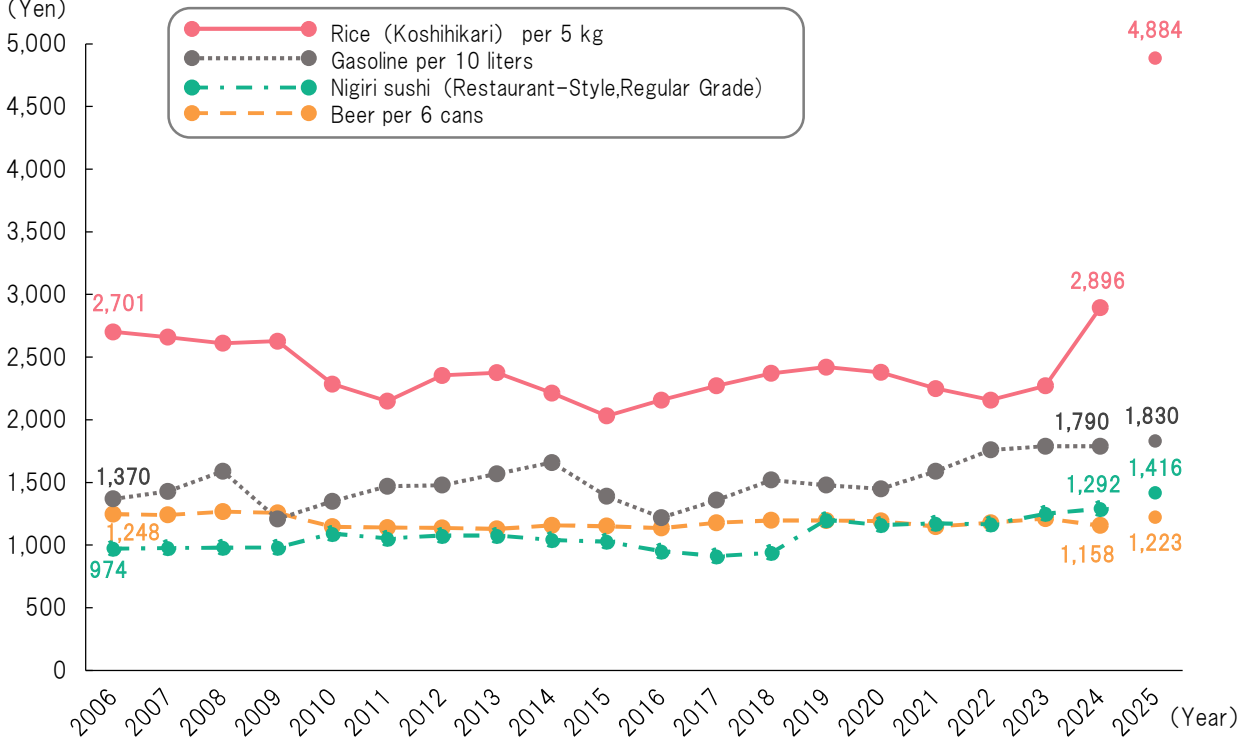

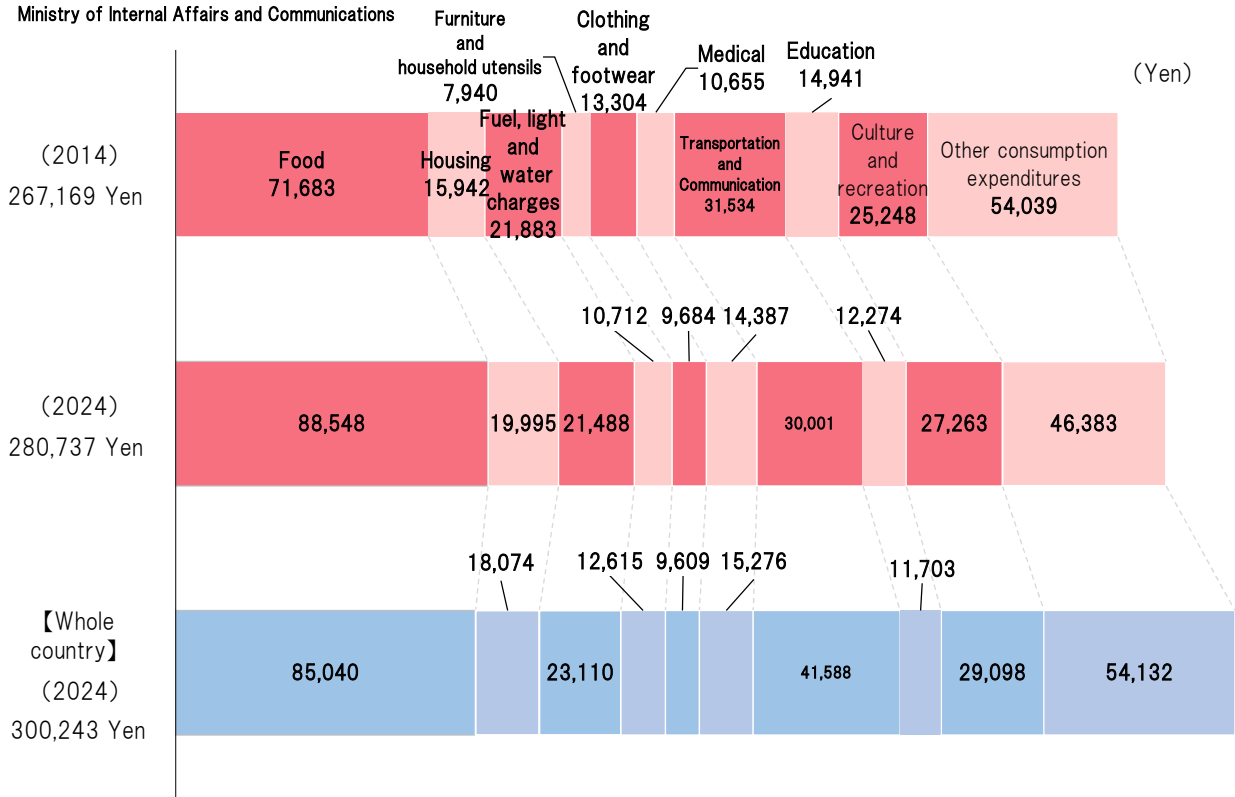

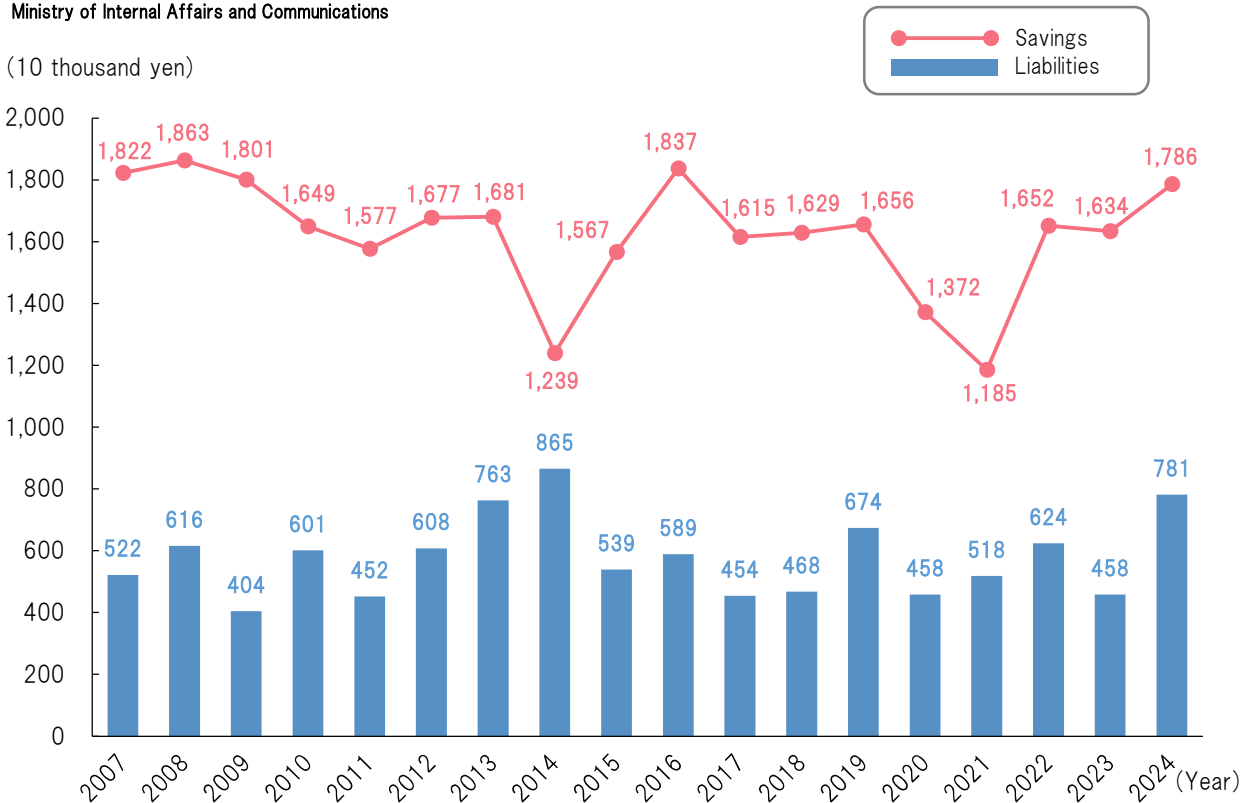


Amounts of Savings and Liabilities Held per Household

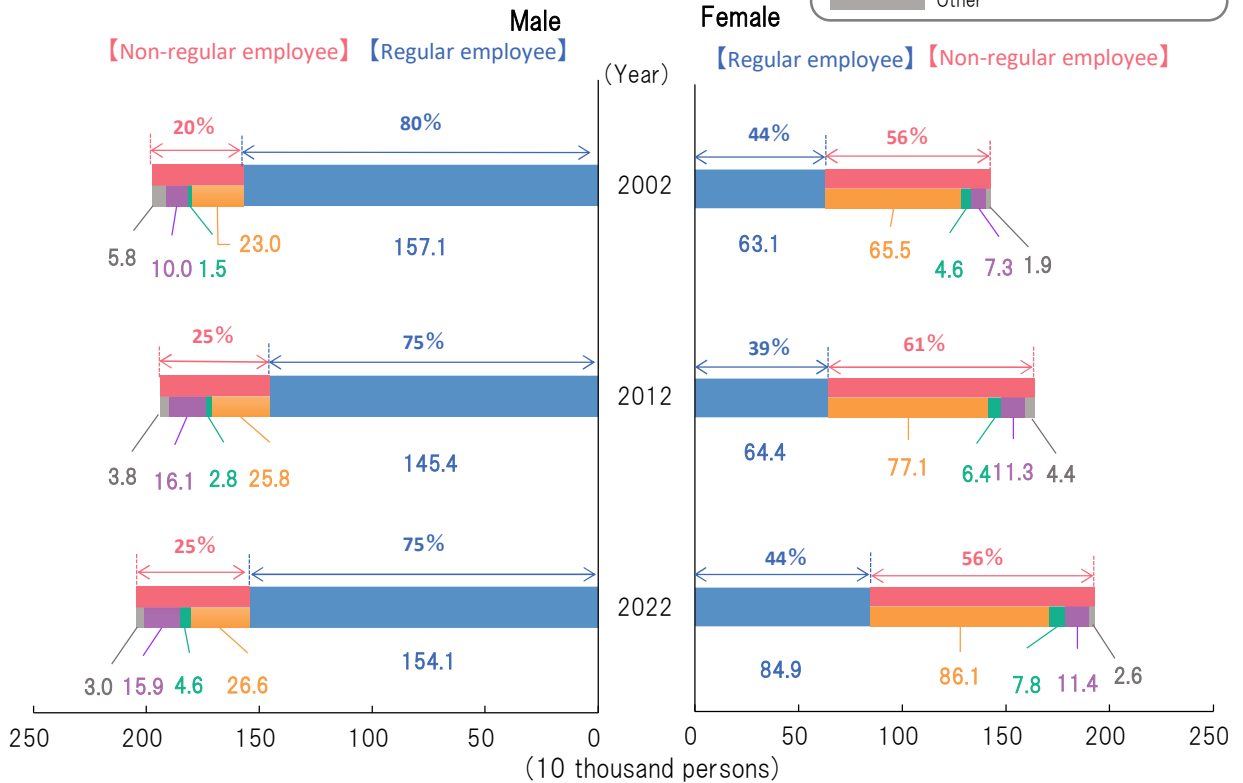
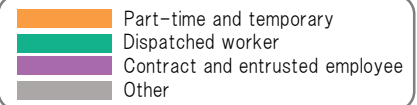

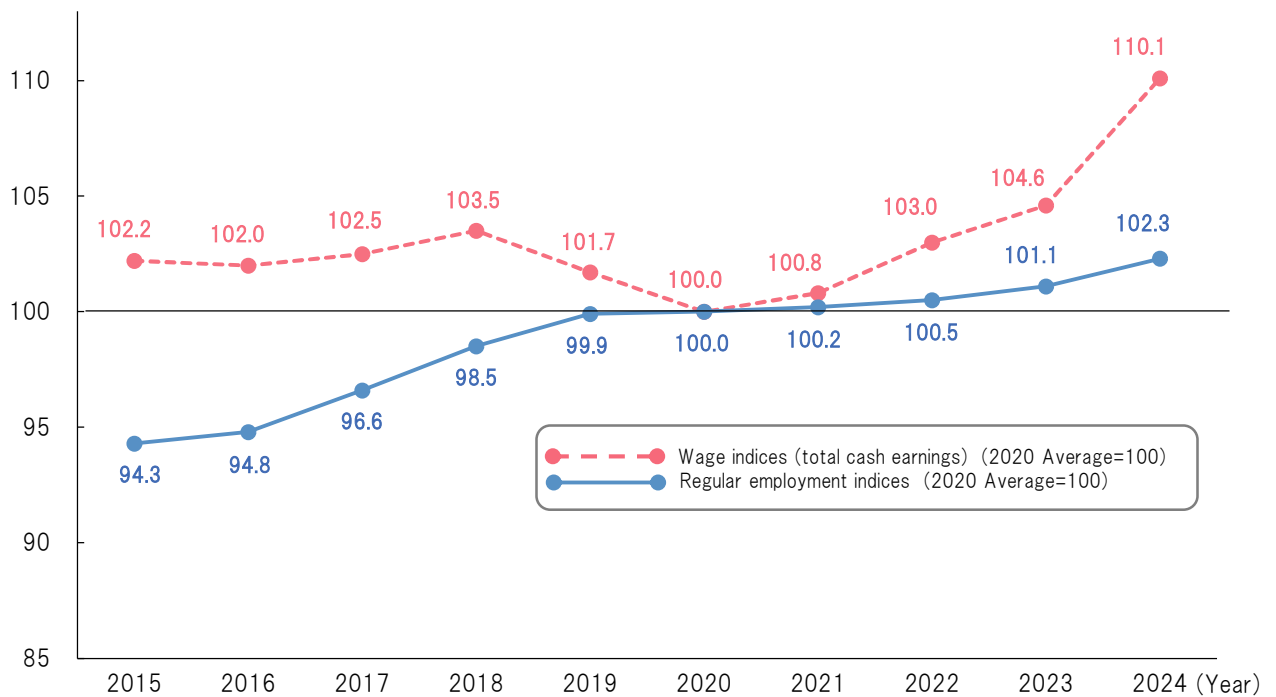

Wage Indices and Regular Employment Indices (Establishments with Five-or-More-Person)

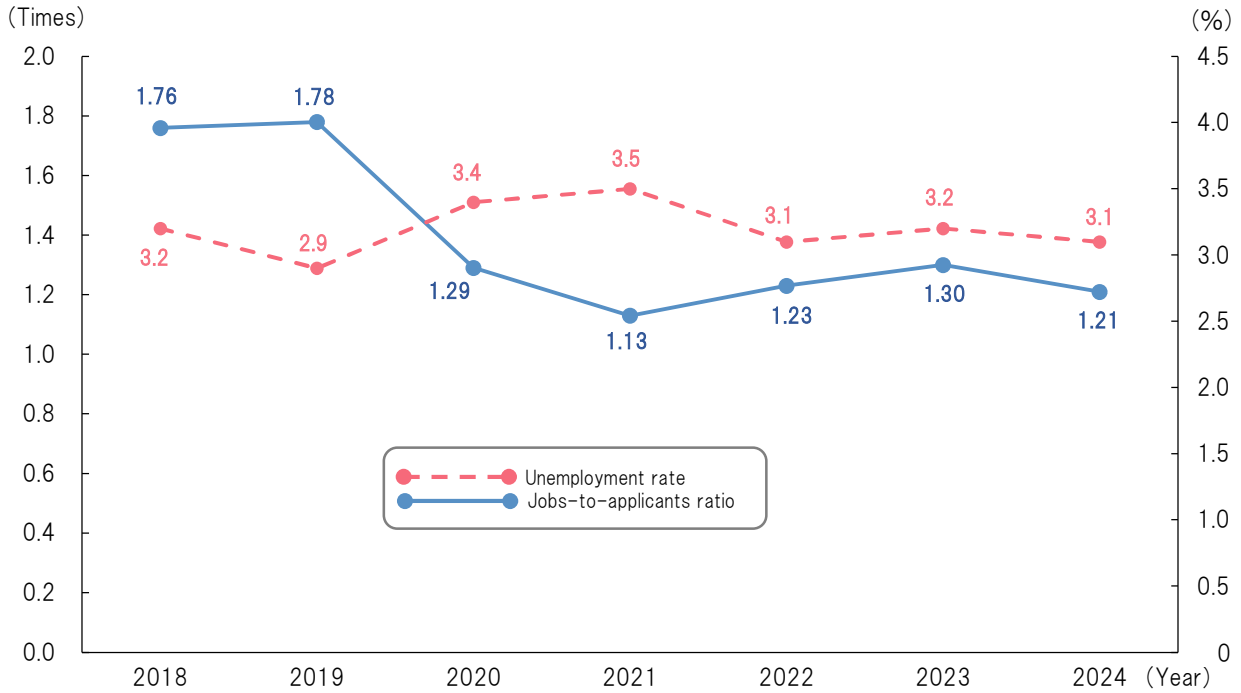

Unemployment Rate and Active Job Openings-to-Applicants Ratio

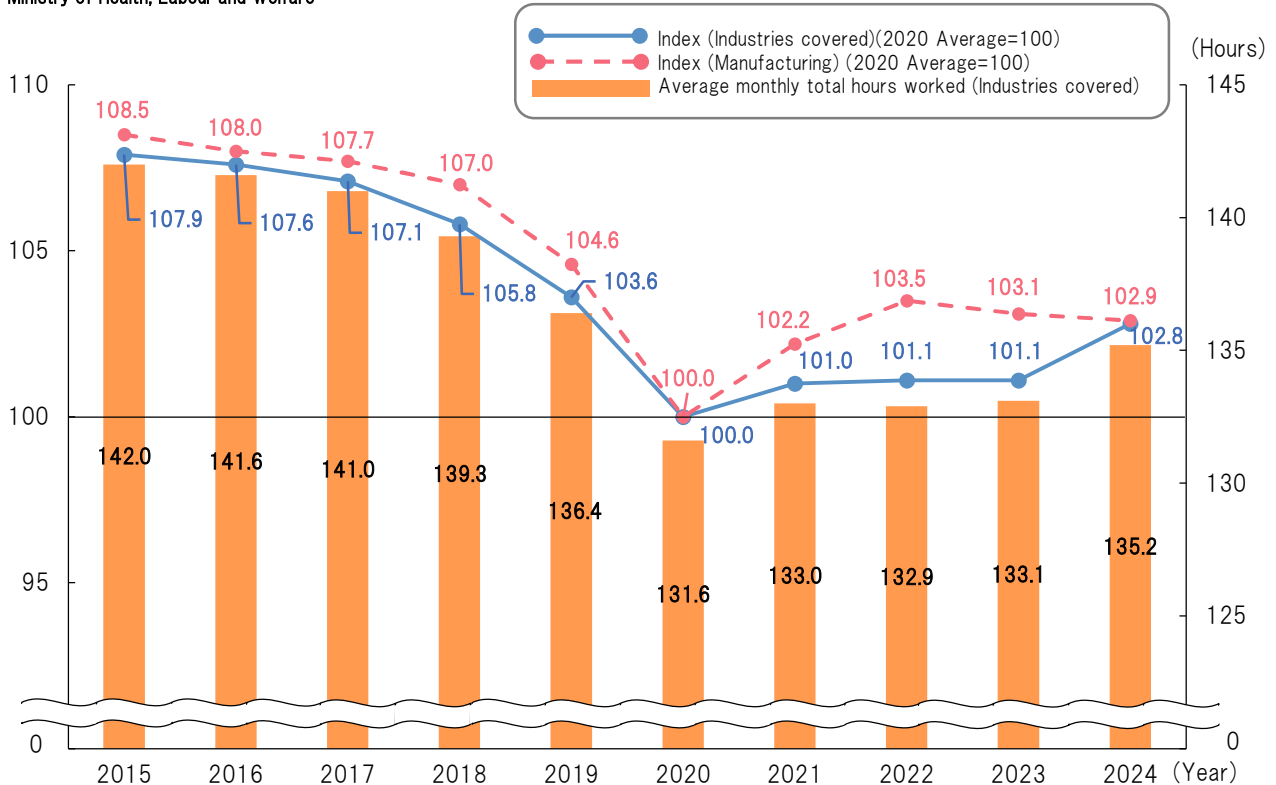

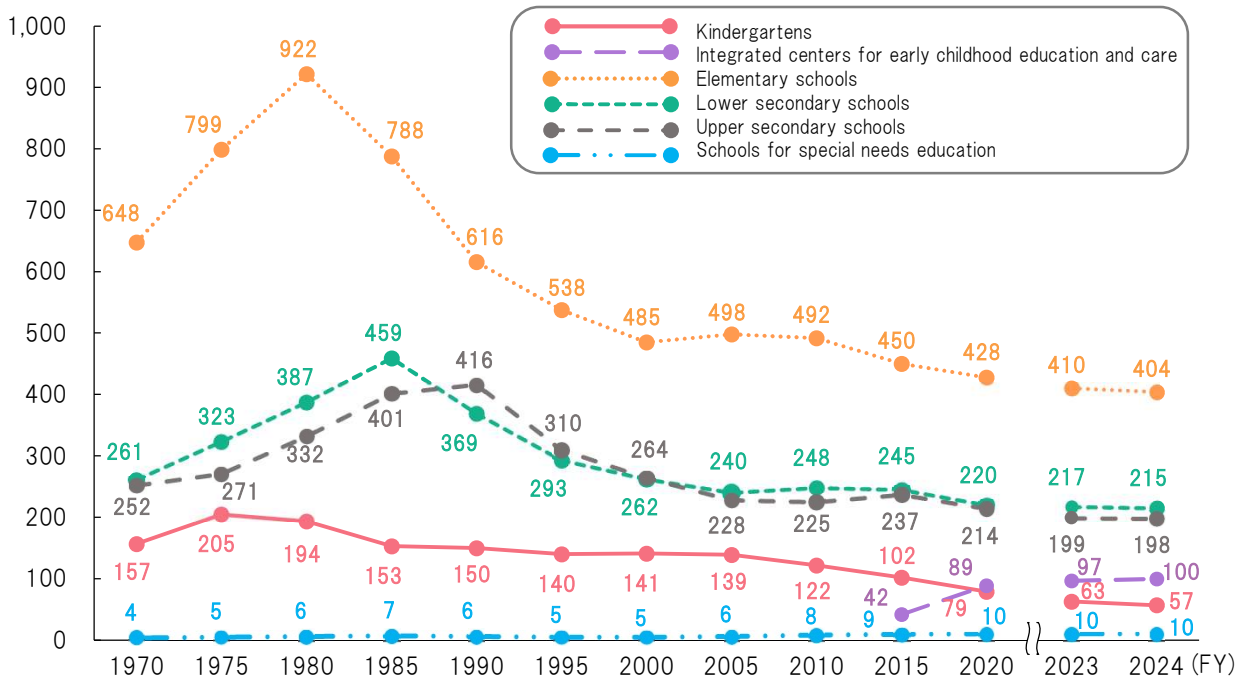

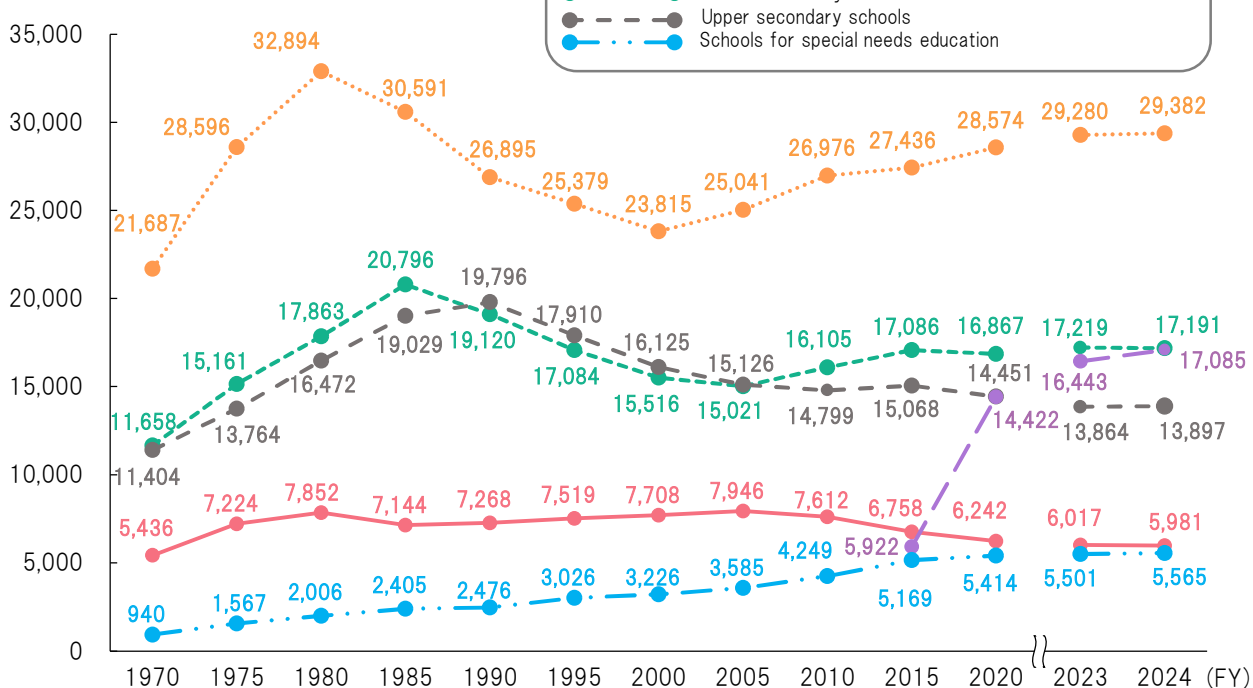

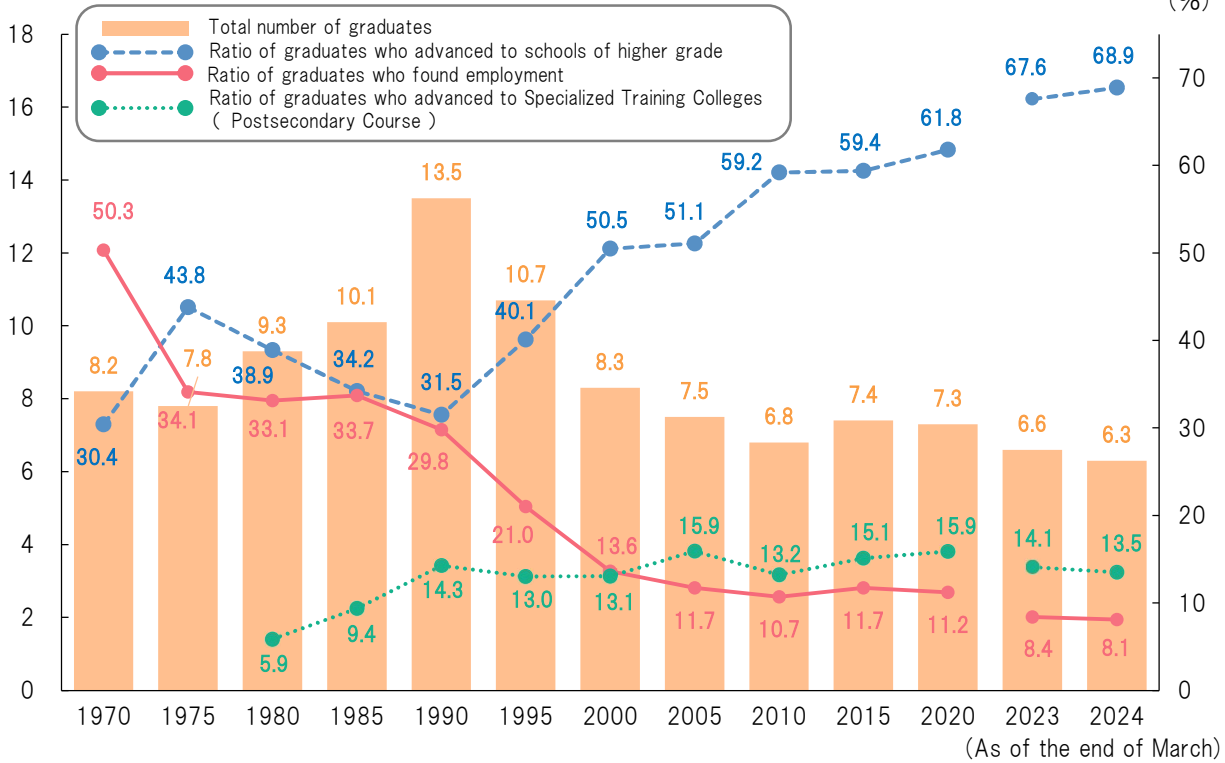

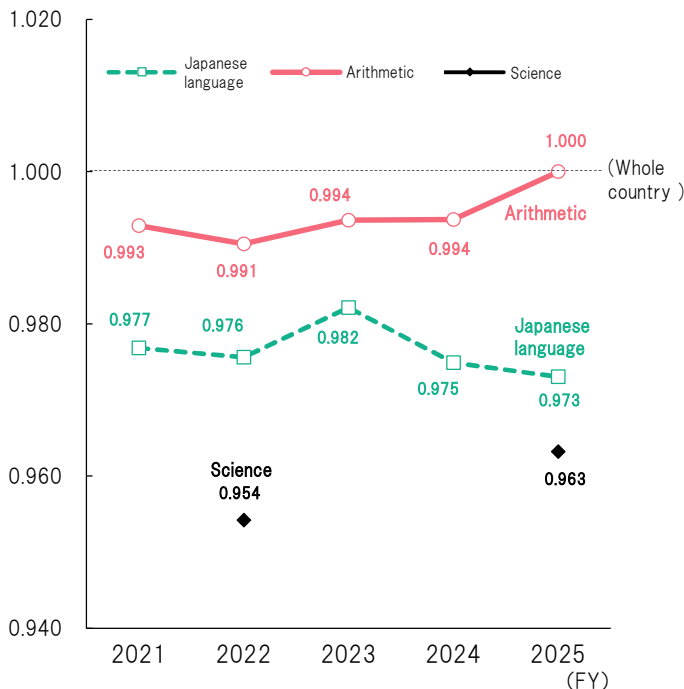

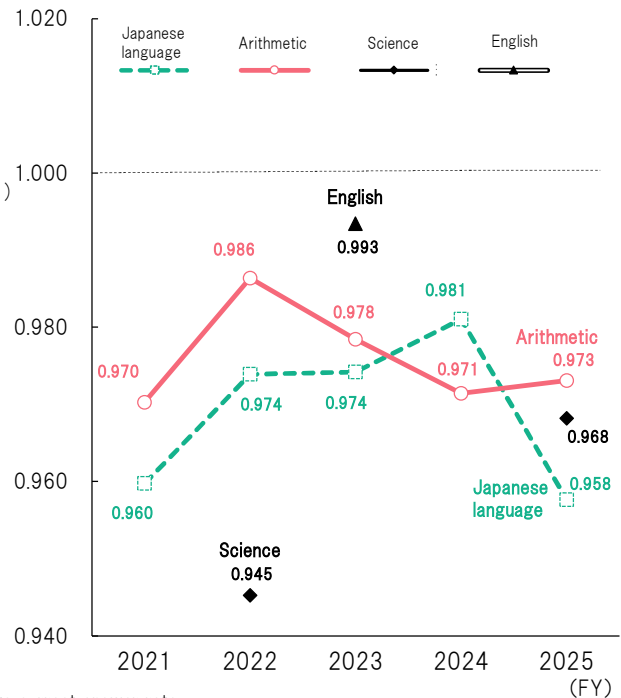

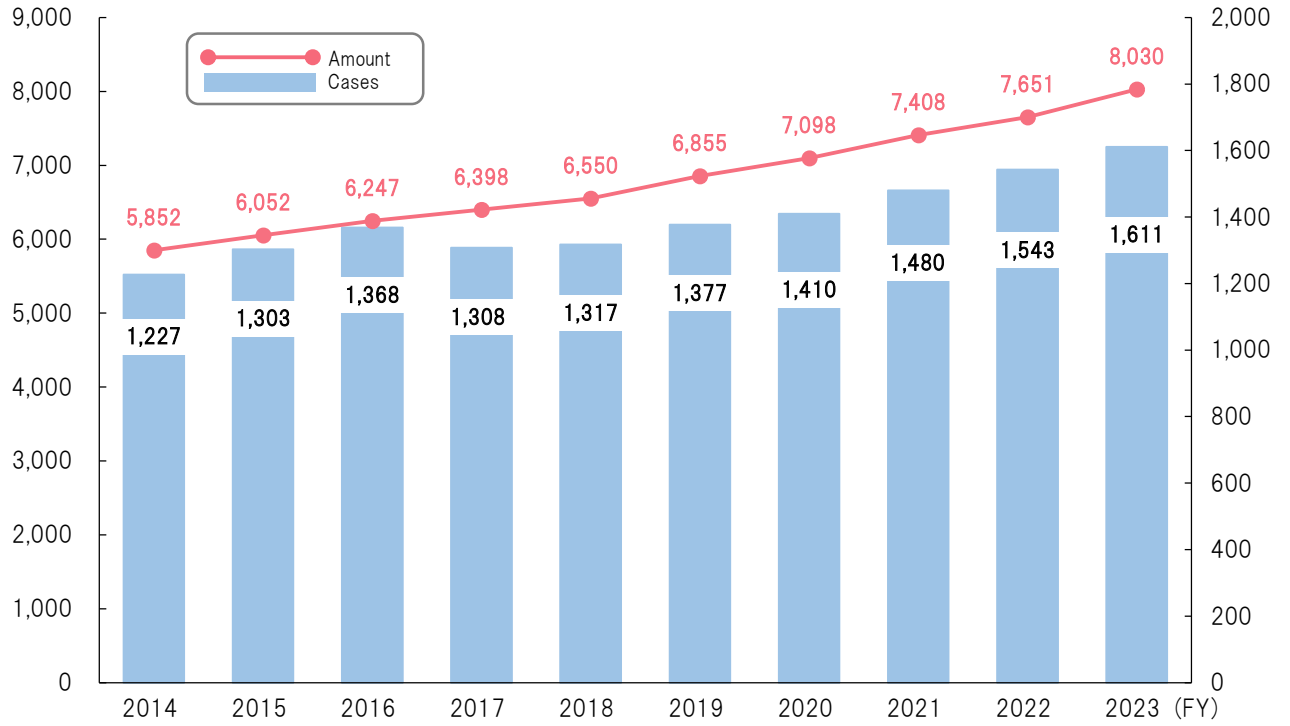

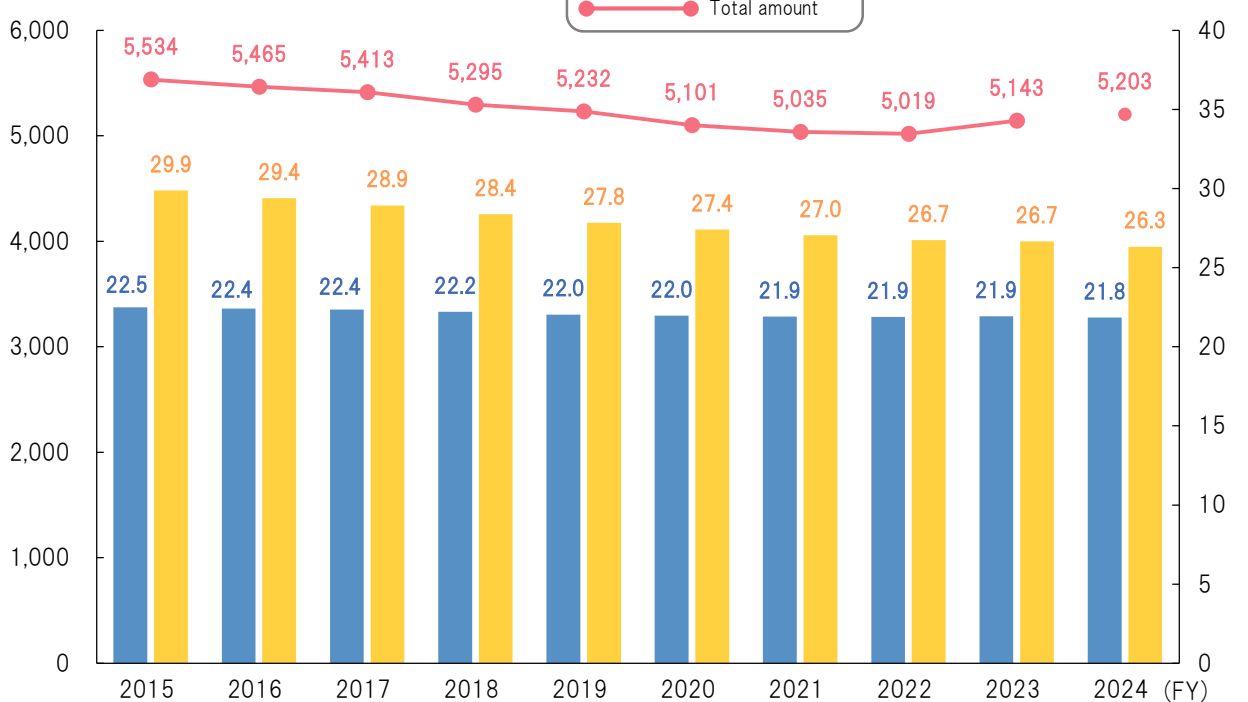
Number of Households and Persons Receiving Public Livelihood Assistance, Total Amount of Received Aid.

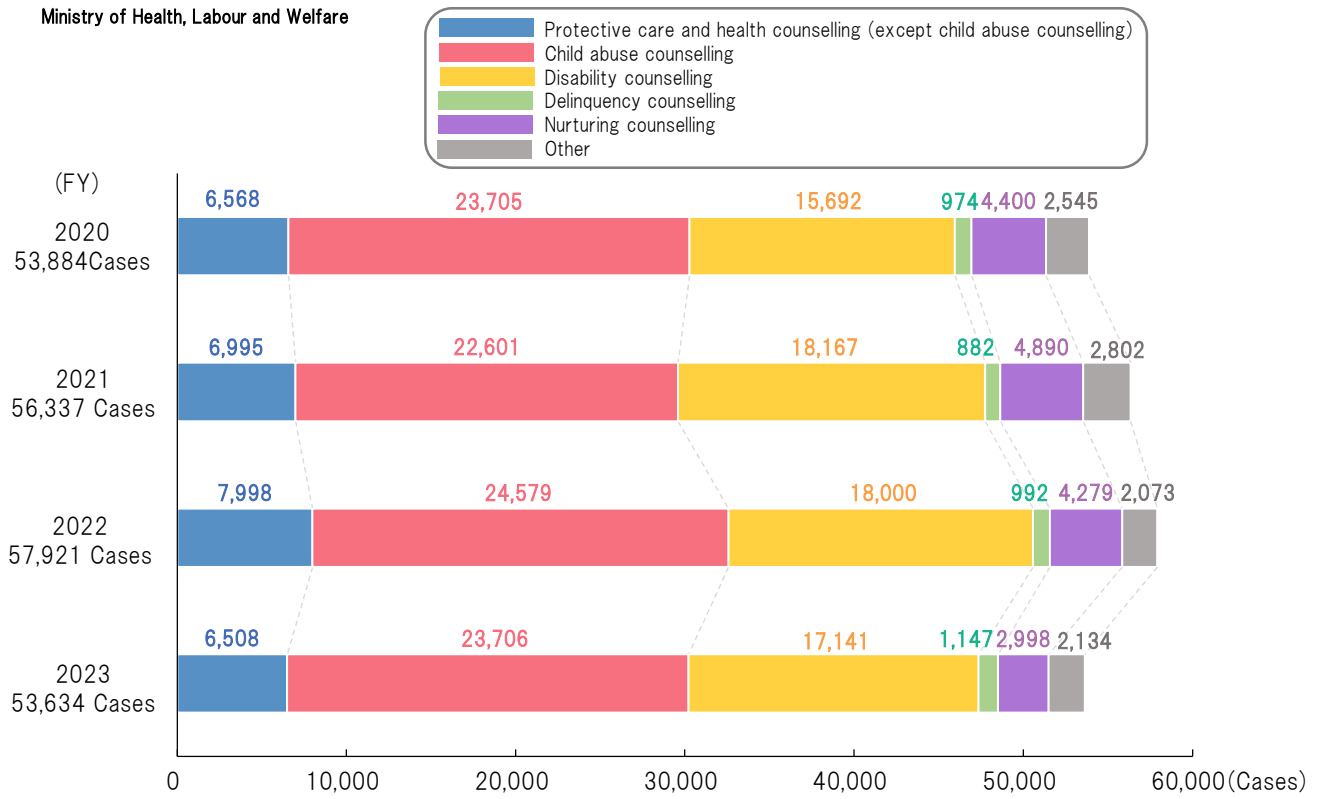

Number of Counselling Cases Handled at Child Guidance Centers

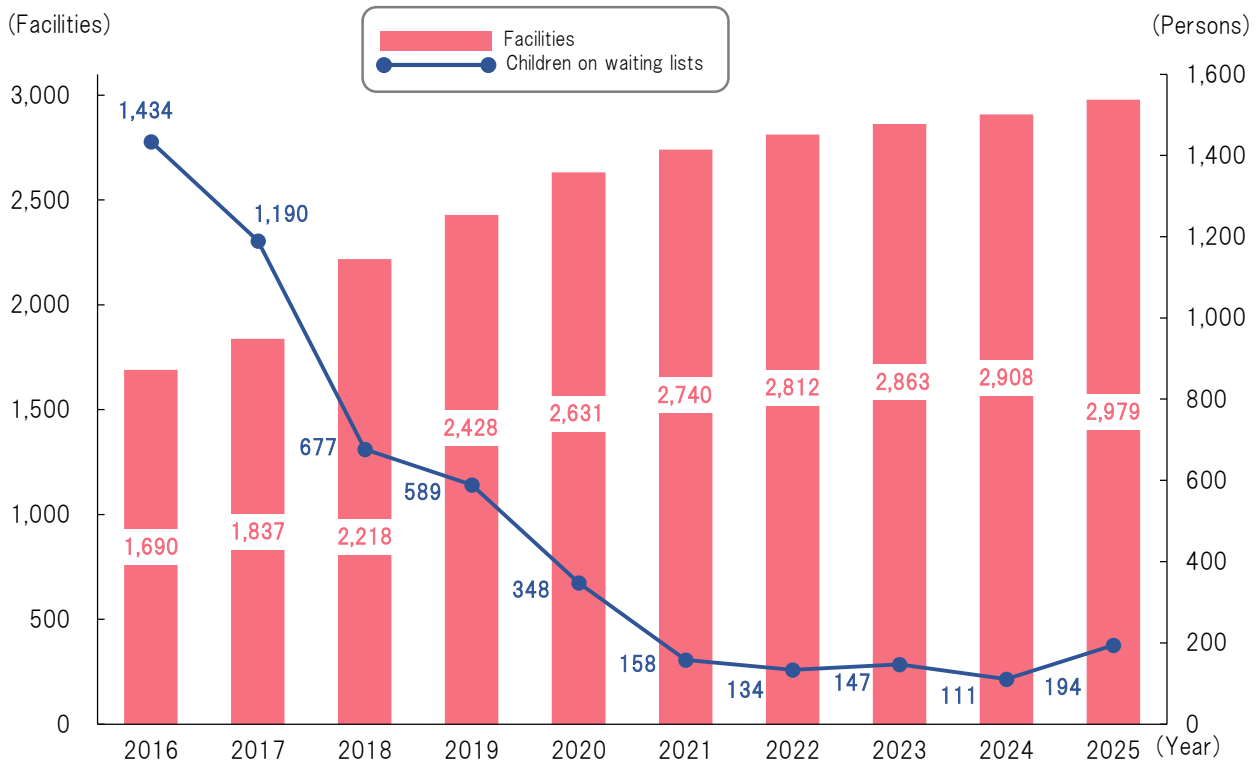

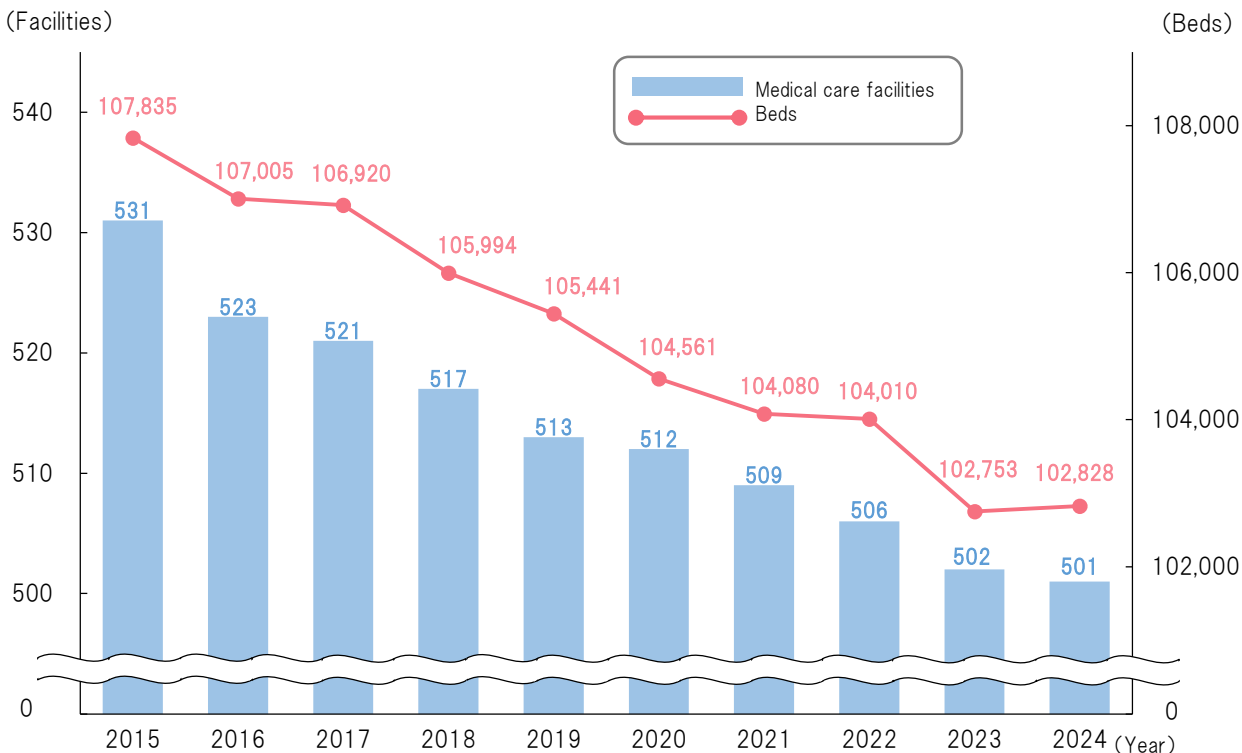

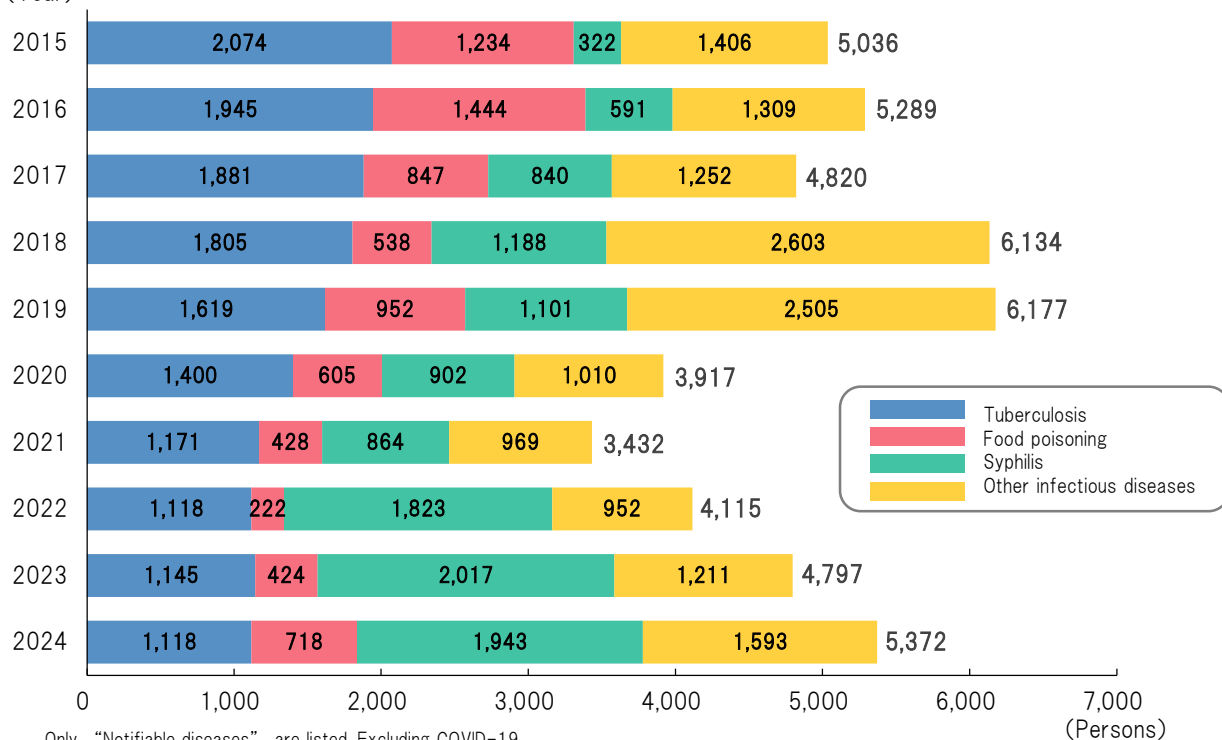

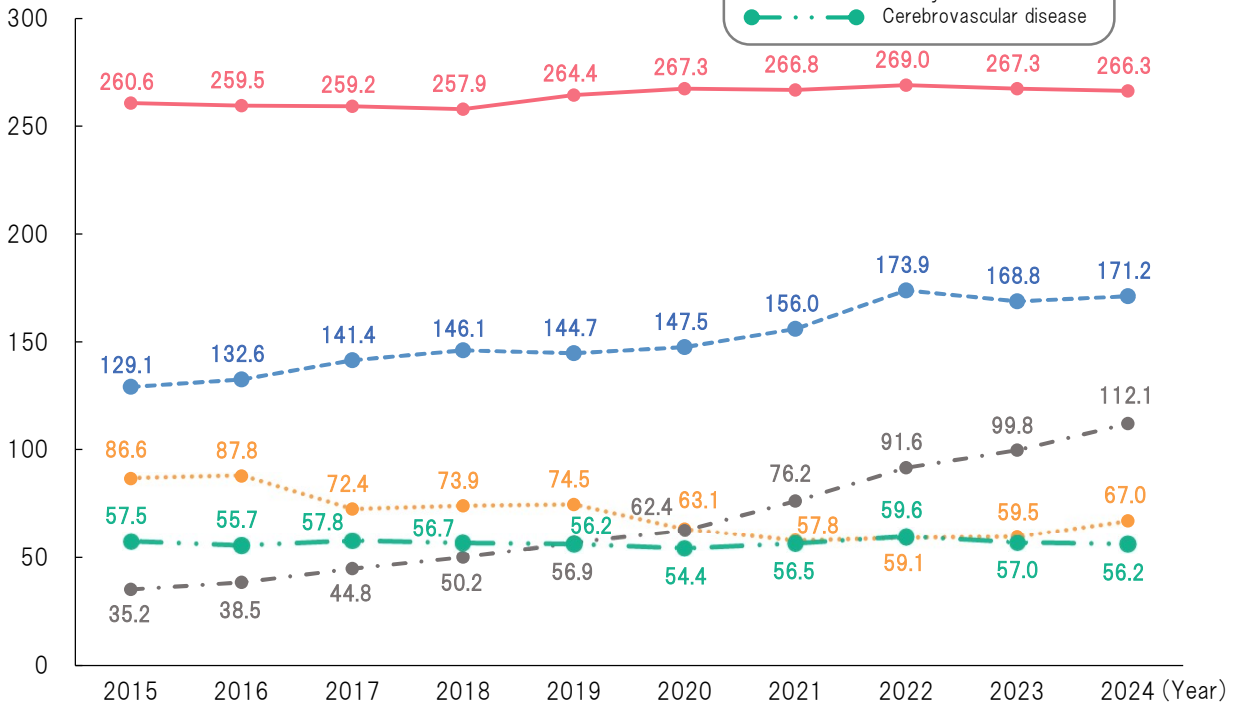

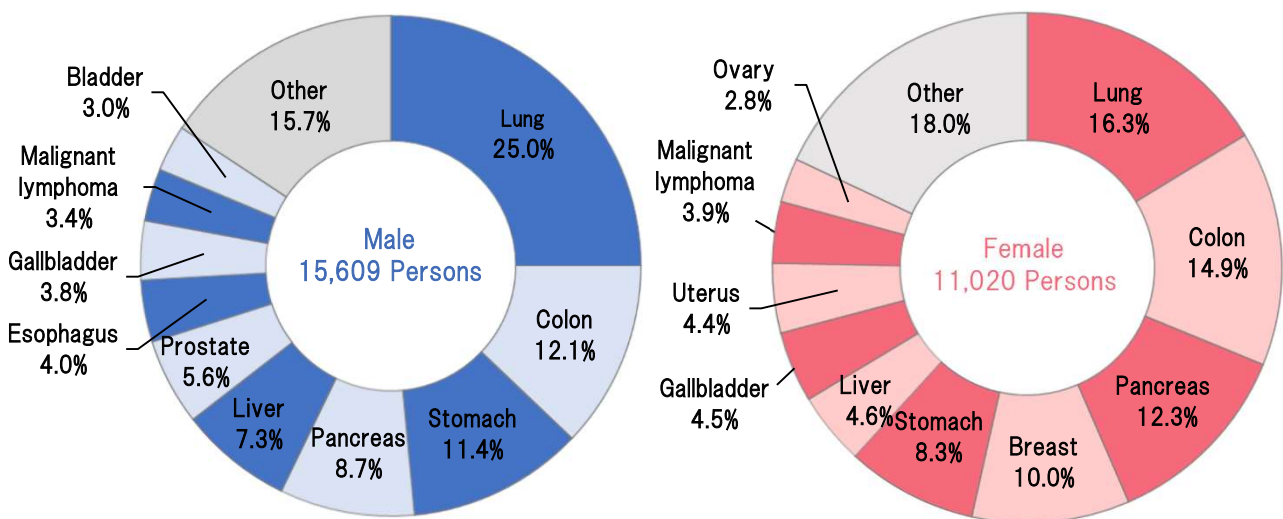

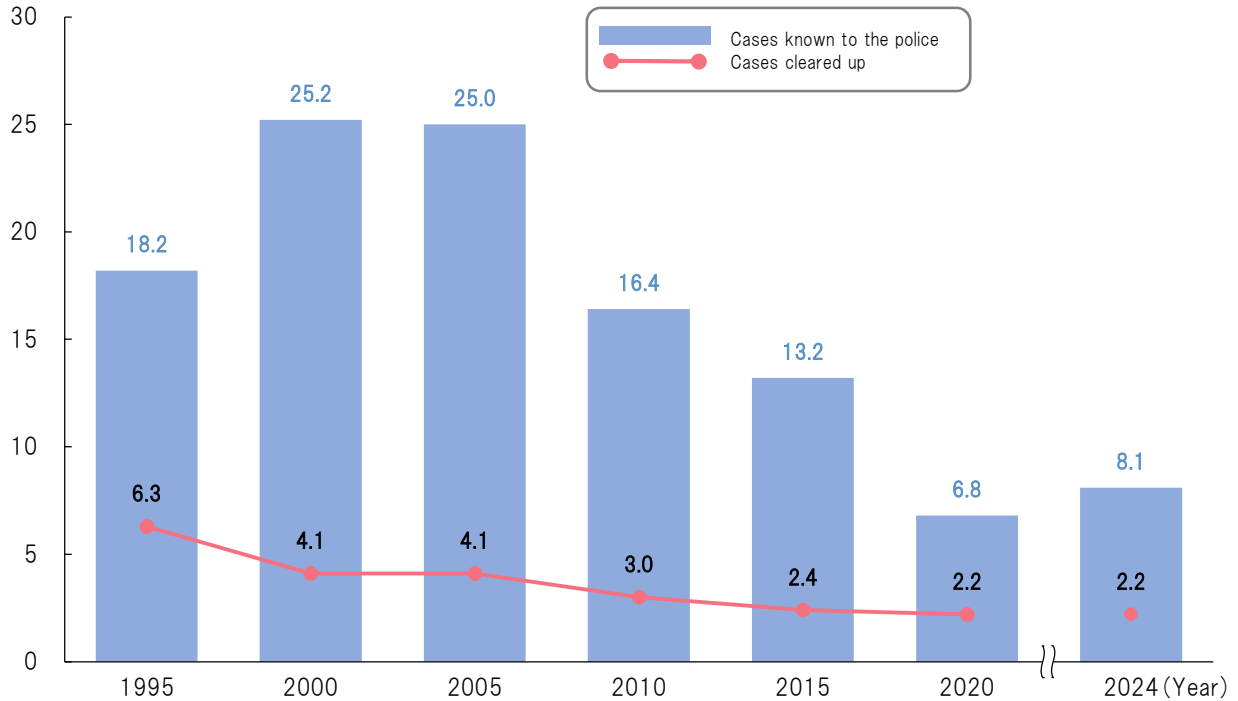

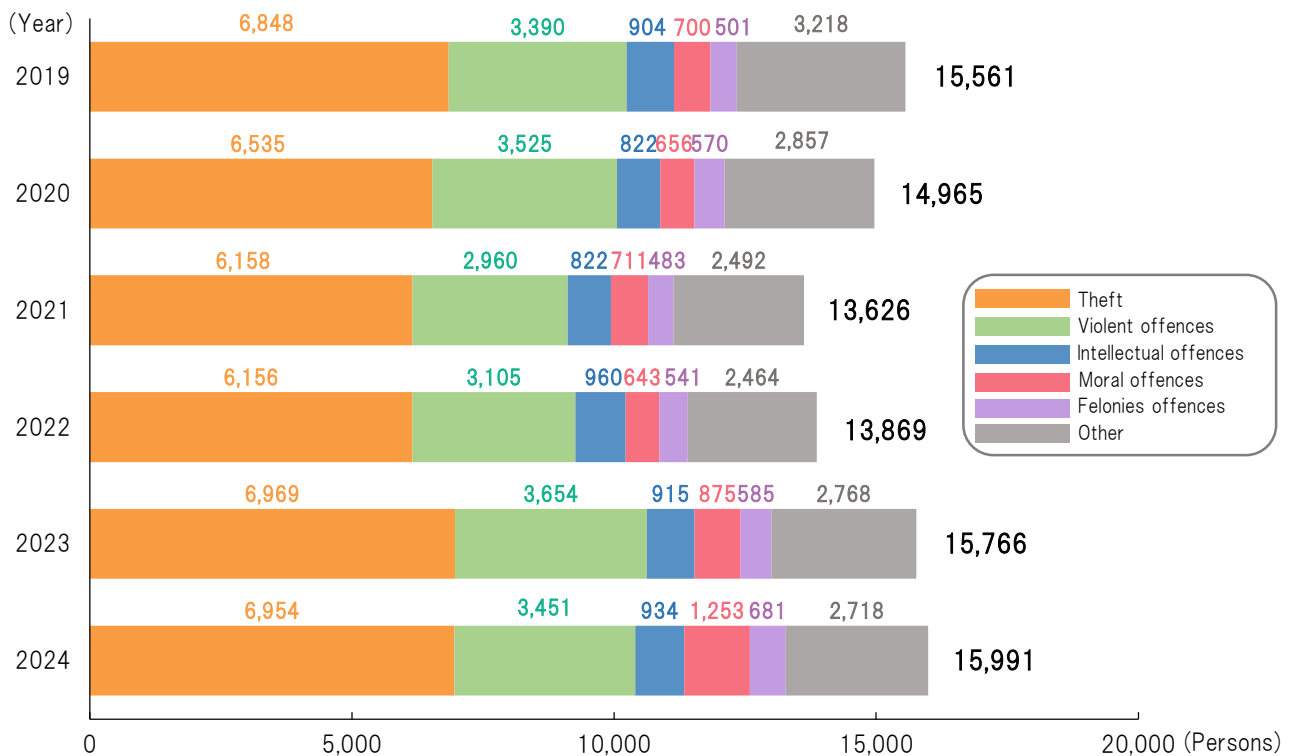

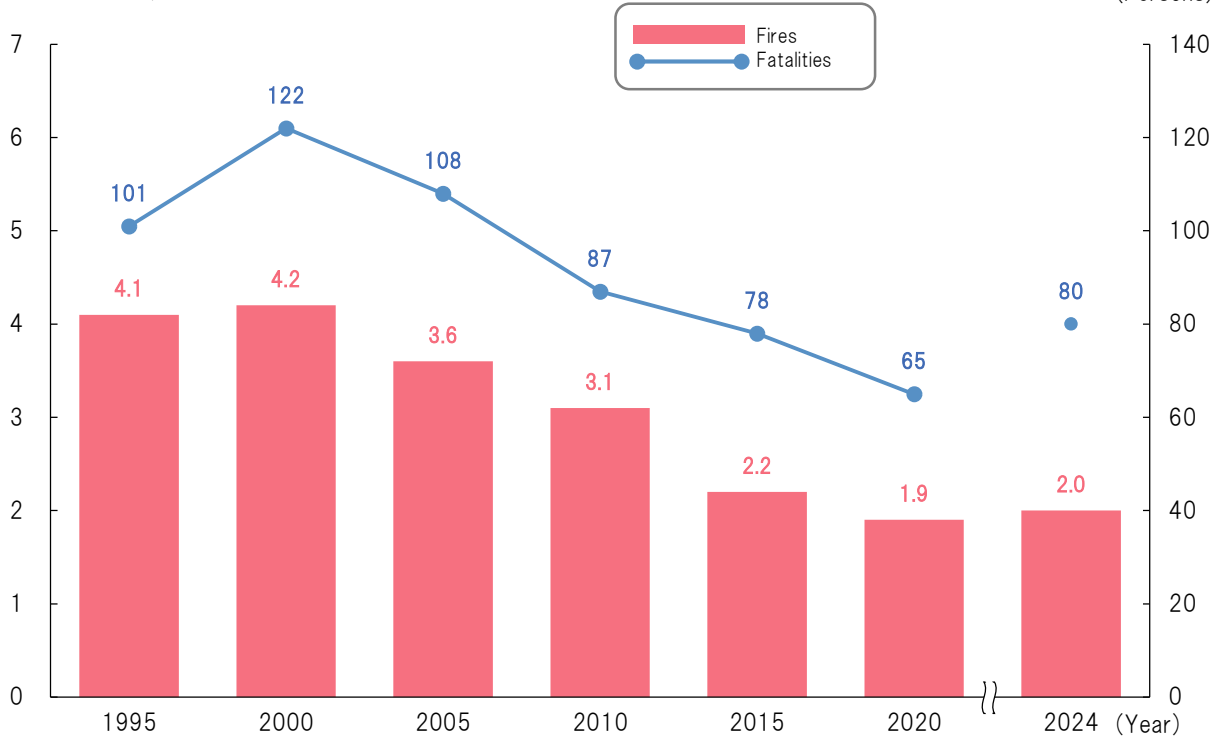

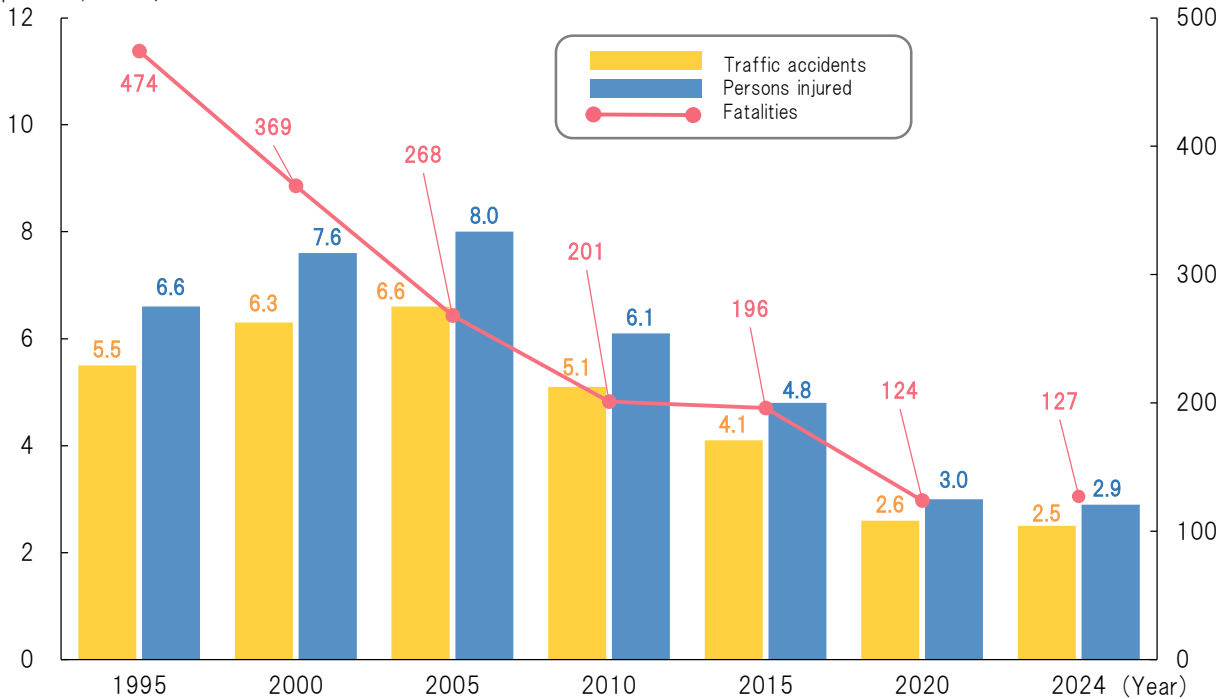
